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RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	AQUAHOLICS PLUMBING 3YO (1300 metres)
<p>SWISS KITTY (J Kamaruddin) – Knuckled shortly after the start losing ground. Steadied to avoid heels passing the 800 metres.</p> <p>LORD PAINTON (A Goindasamy) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>DEVOTIONINMOTION (C Grylls) – Slow to begin. Hampered passing the 800 metres.</p> <p>MANDY MAY (L Satherley) – Hampered shortly after the start losing ground.</p> <p>BUTLER (H Schofer) – Slow to begin. An information was lodged with the Judicial Committee requesting a ruling as to whether BUTLER had received a fair start after it was observed to be held by a barrier attendant as the start was affected. After hearing submissions, the Judicial Committee determined BUTLER to be a runner.</p> <p>STELLA ECLIPSE (E Leighton) – Steadied to avoid the heels of GOSPODIN passing the 800 metres which shifted in when not fully clear dropping back onto SWISS KITTY which shifted outwards to avoid heels hampering DEVOTIONINMOTION. J Riddell was advised to exercise care.</p>	
Race 2	EAST ROCK HAPUKA STEAKS HANDICAP (1600 metres)
<p>QUIZ KID (E Nicholas) – Began awkwardly losing ground, unbalancing its rider. Raced keenly in the early stages before improving forward to lead.</p> <p>SIDEBAR (L Allpress) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>YAMUNA (D Johnson) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>ENGLISH GAMBLER (J Kamaruddin) – Raced keenly when being restrained in the middle stages.</p> <p>FLORAL ART (S Macnab) – Contacted by YAMUNA which shifted out passing the 750 metres becoming momentarily unbalanced. D Johnson was advised to exercise care. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had been disappointing and may have been unsuited by today's track conditions. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination including an endoscopic examination which found the mare to have inhaled dirt.</p> <p>NO LOITERING (T Abel) – Steadied after improving onto heels passing the 1300 metres. Held up until improving into a marginal run passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>TEEN TITAN (E McCall) – Briefly held up entering the final straight.</p>	
Race 3	AONGATETE AVOJECTS HANDICAP (1200 metres)
<p>SWEET HUNTER (S Weatherley) – Declared a late scratching after dislodging its rider during the preliminary and escaping riderless through the running rail being caught some distance later.</p> <p>BRING IT ON (S Spratt) – Underwent a veterinary examination at the barriers and was declared a late scratching after being found to be lame in the near front leg. The horse ambulance was deployed with there being a delay to the start of this race. Trainer C Isdale is to provide the results of a full veterinary inspection in the coming days.</p> <p>INCA WARRIOR (R Elliot) – Hampered shortly after the start losing ground.</p> <p>LONDON BOUND (M McNab) – Slow to begin.</p>	

SUSSEX (M Sanson) – Slow to begin.

HEZA LOOKER (A Goindasamy) – Raced keenly when being restrained to obtain cover in the early stages.

MEGEVE (E Leighton) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised that in her opinion the mare had failed to handle today's track conditions.

AIR CENTRE (M Hashizume) – Shied just prior to the winning post unbalancing it's rider.

Race 4 | **BULK LINES LIMITED HANDICAP (2100 metres)**

NOTHINSWEETABOUTME (E Leighton) – Buffeted shortly after the start then crowded, losing ground.

VAN BLANC (E Nicholas) – Began awkwardly then restrained behind runners shortly after the start.

LETZ'AV BUBBLES (D Johnson) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages before having to be steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 1700 metres. Then continued to over-race for a distance through the middle stages.

LOT OF ZEES (J Fillmore) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

CORK (S Weatherley) – Contacted with the rider becoming momentarily unbalanced passing the 1000 metres.

TOUCH THE CLOUDS (A Goindasamy) – Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

JUDY'S SONG (M McNab) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had failed to handle today's track conditions.

T Newman (RISING REWARD) – Issued with a warning for permitting her mount to shift in when not sufficiently clear of PROSPEROUS which shifted in crowding LETZ'AV BUBBLES which had to be steadied passing the 1700 metres.

J Fillmore (LOT OF ZEES) – Issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

E Nicholas (VAN BLANC) – Issued with a warning for using her whip above shoulder height.

RISING REWARD (T Newman) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormality.

Race 5 | **SEEKA KIWIFRUIT CUP (2100 metres)**

DIVINE DUKE (J Kamaruddin) – Slow to begin. Had to be steadied after improving onto heels passing the 1500 metres. Briefly held up entering the final straight before shifting outwards to obtain clear running passing the 350 metres.

CASSIO (C Jones) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

ALI BABA (E McCall) – Slow to begin.

RENEGADE FIGHTER (T Abel) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

JUNIOR (E Nicholas) – Shifted outwards to avoid heels passing the 1200 metres when racing keenly then improved onto the heels of TWIN SPINNER when the pace eased approaching the 1000 metres shifting back in crowding MY GIFT which had to be steadied.

MY GIFT (V Colgan) – Crowded having to be steadied passing the 1000 metres.

E Nicholas (JUNIOR) – Issued with a warning for allowing her mount to shift in near the 1000 metres crowding MY GIFT which had to be steadied. When assessing this incident Stewards took into account the pace of the race which had steadied appreciably near the 1000 metres.

Race 6 | **ZEST HANDICAP (1400 metres)**

GALLARDO (M McNab) – Slow to begin (4L), then ridden urgently to recover. Connections were advised a warning would be placed on the gelding's barrier manners. Over-raced in the middle stages making the bend near the 1000 metres awkwardly. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormality.

FIGHTING FIRE (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly then ridden urgently to recover.

TWO MADISON (J Kamaruddin) – Raced ungenerously in the early to middle stages when being restrained.

THUNDER (E McCall) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had been disappointing after failing to respond when placed under pressure in the final straight.

Race 7 | **TEAM WEALLEANS TAURANGA CLASSIC (1400 metres)**

NASHA RIVA (V Colgan) – Slow to begin.

LONDON EXPRESS (H Schofer) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

MEKELLE (S Weatherley) – Raced keenly in the early to middle stages. Inconvenienced passing the 150 metres when KATIE PERRIE shifted out when not fully clear. R Jones was advised to exercise care.

WHOSHE'S GIRL (E McCall) – Crowded and checked passing the 175 metres. Rider dropped her whip passing the 150 metres.

SUPREME HEIGHTS (L Satherley) – Held up rounding the final bend before shifting out passing the 350 metres making contact with the hindquarters of SHOSHONE which then lay in forcing SUPREME HEIGHTS inwards.

B Jones (KATIE PERRIE) – Issued with a breach of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift out near the 175 metres when not sufficiently clear of WHOSHE'S GIRL which was checked with the Judicial Committee suspending B Jones' licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 27 June up to and including racing on Wednesday 7 July, 4 national riding days.

L Satherley (SUPREME HEIGHTS) – Issued for a warning for angling her mount out passing the 350 metres making contact with SHOSHONE which became unbalanced.

Race 8 | **RHYS MISCHEFSKI, BAYLEYS WHAKATANE HANDICAP (1400 metres)**

THE REAL TEST (V Colgan) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

JAKAMA KRYSTAL (M Hashizume) – Slow to begin. Held up for a distance passing the 400 metres before improving onto heels approaching the 300 metres having to be steadied.

BANKERS CHOICE (M McNab) – Began awkwardly.

GINGER TOO (A Calder) – Held up rounding the final bend and again for a distance passing the 200 metres.

HOLA SENORITA (S Weatherley) – Held up early in the final straight.

MEDALZA (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no excuse.
