RACE COMMENTS	
<b>Race 1</b>	<b>PIAKO TRACTORS 3YO (1400 metres)</b>
<b>TOGA PARTY</b> (E Nicholas) – Slow to begin after being fractious in its barrier stall.	
<b>PARADING</b> (M McNab) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.	
<b>ANGELINA LAURO</b> (A Calder) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.	
<b>STELLA ECLIPSE</b> (E Leighton) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.	

**HASSITALL** (V Colgan) – Over-raced in the middle stages. Held up rounding the final bend.

**KING KHAN** (K Asano) – Held up rounding the final bend until shifting outwards passing the 150 metres. Stewards questioned K Asano regarding the riding tactics he had adopted rounding the final bend when persisting for a run to the inside of CASPER which never developed. K Asano explained that after being unable to improve wider when CASPER and PARADING had both commenced to tire, he had elected to improve into a marginal run to the inside of CASPER as he believed the gelding was laying out. After the run had failed to eventuate he had to then restrain his mount behind the heels of CASPER before improving to the outside of that runner. K Asano's explanation was noted.

**Race 2** | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1400 metres)**

**J Kamaruddin** (CANNSEA CLEARLY) – Issued with a warning after weighing in 0.25 kgs under the weight that he weighed out at.

**Race 3** | **AT COOK CONTRACTING 1230**

**OUTBACK OPAL** (L Satherley) – Reared as the start was effected losing ground. Stewards withheld payment until connections were satisfied that the reason for OUTBACK OPAL being slow to begin had been of its own accord and not attributed to the barrier attendant assisting it.

**COQUETTE** (E McCall) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

**SO SURREAL** (R Elliot) – Lost the right hind plate during the running.

**MADI'S DREAM** (D Danis) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

**Race 4** | **HYNDS PIPES 1230**

**RABBIT** (C Barnes) – Commenced to over-race in the early and middle stages when being restrained. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormality.

**MIGHTY CASTLE** (E McCall) – Hampered shortly after the start losing ground.

**GO YOU GOOD THING** (E Leighton) – Began awkwardly. Raced in restricted room for a distance entering the final straight. Rider E Leighton weighed in 0.2 kgs underweight before it was discovered that the surcingles had been omitted when saddling.

**GREASE LIGHTNING** (T Newman) – Slow to begin. Contacted entering the final straight.

**D Cherry** (GO YOU GOOD THING) – Admitted a breach of neglectful saddling in that he omitted the surcingles from GO YOU GOOD THING with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a fine of \$100.

**Race 5** | **RYDGES ROTORUA 1400**

**LOFTY** (K Hercock) – Slow to begin.

**MELILOT** (V Colgan) – Began awkwardly. Raced keenly when being restrained to obtain cover passing the 1300 metres.

**MR GIBSON** (S McKay) – Had to shift inwards passing the 150 metres to obtain clear running.

**Race 6** | **HAVE YOUR FUNCTION AT ARAWA PARK 1400**

**MIDNITE INVASION** (J Kamaruddin) – Slow to begin.

**PALATINATE** (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly. Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 500 metres when runners either side shifted ground.

**HOLA SENORITA** (T Yanagida) – Raced in restricted room for a distance approaching the 400 metres.

**CHEERS** (K Hercock) – Raced keenly in the early to middle stages. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that after racing keenly during the running the mare had held its breath.

**CAPALDI** (R Elliot) – When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions.

**Race 7**

**HOLIDAY INN 1950**

**HARD DONE** (J Riddell) – Slow to begin. Commenced to over-race in the early to middle stages.

**LA FAVORITA** (E McCall) – Began awkwardly.

**TAKEITEASY** (E Leighton) – Slow to begin.

**ELLE MCMASSEY** (A Calder) – Stewards withheld payment until connections were satisfied that ELLE MCMASSEY had not been materially affected by its outside barrier not latching back fully.

**FORTUNE WINGS** (A Goindasamy) – Inconvenienced on jumping away when it's barrier gate had not latched fully.

**JUST AL** (J Kamaruddin) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

**A Goindasamy** (FORTUNE WINGS) – Issued with a warning for his whip use on a horse that was clearly winning.
