RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 HAPPY 5TH BIRTHDAY LUCAS BROSNAN (3100 metres)

IMA WONDER (H McNeill) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 375 metres. Pulled up prior to jumping the final two fences.

ELUSIVE ACE (J Seivwright) – Pulled up prior to jumping the final two fences.

BANKS ROAD (E Farr) – Slow to begin.

RITESAIDZED (N Downs) – Jumped indifferently throughout.

ARGYLL (B Donoghue) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 250 metres, losing momentum.

N Downs (RITESAIDZED) – Reminded of his obligations in that he must consider retiring his mounts from the race when they are not competitive.

B Donoghue (ARGYLL) – Fined \$200 by the Judicial Committee after committing a wrongful act after weighing out in that he changed his boots and added spurs, weighing in 0.5kg overweight.

Race 2 NATURPHOS LIQUID FERTILISER HURDLE (3100 metres)

MAGIC CANNON (B Donoghue) – Contacted the front of its barrier stall forcing it open slightly early and as a result began awkwardly. Stewards were satisfied that MAGIC CANNON had not gained any advantage. Knuckled on landing after jumping the fence near the 950 metres. Lost the off-hind plate during the running.

OUR CRAFTSMAN (E Farr) – Misjudged the second fence.

OXYMORON (J Seivwright) – Pulled up prior to jumping the final three fences. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination including an endoscopic examination which failed to reveal any abnormality.

SUMMER WARRIOR (N Downs) – Pulled up prior to jumping the final two fences. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination including an endoscopic examination which revealed significant mucopus in the trachea.

RAUCOUS (D Parker) – Hit the fence near the 375 metres, losing momentum. Misjudged the fence near the 250 metres. Hit the final fence.

WINDY HEIGHT (G Walsh) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 250 metres.

N Downs (SUMMER WARRIOR) – Reminded of his obligations in that he must consider retiring his mounts from the race when they are not competitive.

Race 3 SIR SLICK THE PEOPLE'S CHAMPION (1600 metres)

ROCTHEPARTY (A Calder) – Began awkwardly then veered out sharply shortly after the start.

WELL I NEVER (H Schofer) – Began awkwardly.

CHAKANA (M McNab) - Raced ungenerously near the 1500 metres hampering NOUGAT.

NOUGAT (S Weatherley) – Hampered near the 1500 metres.

BLACK CHEETAH (J Fawcett) – When questioned regarding performance rider J Fawcett could offer no excuse.

J Fawcett (BLACK CHEETAH) – Admitted a charge in that she used her whip excessively prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.

Race 4 PIAKO RURAL SERVICES STEEPLECHASE (3500 metres)

EION (D Parker) – Slow to begin. Misjudged the fence near the 650 metres.

NO TIP (S Phelan) – Misjudged the first fence and fell, dislodging the rider. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found no obvious abnormality. Rider S Phelan was cleared by the course Doctor and was found to be uninjured.

TE KAHU (M Roustoby) – Jumped indifferently throughout.

NOTABADROOSTER (E Farr) – Improved onto heels when jumping the 9th fence and was hampered.

EL DISPARO (B Donoghue) – Misjudged the final fence and fell, dislodging the rider. Rider B Donoghue was transported to hospital for further assessment with a suspected shoulder injury. B Donoghue will be required to provide a medical certificate prior to riding next. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to have blood in both nostrils and after undergoing an endoscopic examination was found to have no blood in the trachea.

LEICA WARRIOR (G Walsh) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to have a small wound on the right fore pastern and pulled a shoe.

Following the race, connections of the 3rd placed horse LEICA WARRIOR wished to view Stewards footage, electing not to proceed with a protest.

Race 5 J. SWAP CONTRACTORS TE AROHA CUP (2200 metres)

ELLE D'BERRY (A Scott) – Began awkwardly.

LOVETTORLEAVEIT (N Smith) - Slow to begin.

LOCHARBURN (S Malki) - Slow to begin.

COLIN OSCOPY (L Phelan) – Lay out under pressure in the final straight.

RISING RANSOM (B Yuill) – Rider relaxed ride from 75 metres and was subsequently beaten for 4th position.

B Yuill (RISING RANSOM) – Admitted a charge in that he failed to ride his mount out over the final 75 metres when there was a reasonable chance of finishing 4^{th.} After considering submissions the Judicial Committee suspended B Yuill's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 27 June up to and including racing on Sunday 11 July, 2 national amateur riding days.

Race 6 UNDERGROUND TAKEAWAYS SEPTIC TANK SERVICES 2200

OCEANTOOCEAN (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly then crowded. Raced keenly in the early stages.

FORTUNE WINGS (A Goindasamy) – Raced keenly when being restrained.

A Goindasamy (FORTUNE WINGS) – Reminded of his obligation with regards to his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

MR BAZAMOUR (C Grylls) – Slow to begin.

KIRRA LAD (S Weatherley) – Restrained at the start from a wide barrier.

Race 8 SILVER FERN FARMS TE AROHA/WAITOA 1400

LOFTY (E Nicholas) – Slow to begin.

ATTACK OF THE MAK (C Barnes) – Slow to begin.

PACHECO (R Elliot) – Hampered near the 400 metres when LE CHAMOSSAIRE shifted out when struck with the whip before being immediately corrected by its rider. A Goindasamy was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.
