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**RACE COMMENTS:**

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>HAPPY 5<sup>TH</sup> BIRTHDAY LUCAS BROSNAN (3100 metres)</b>
<p><b>IMA WONDER</b> (H McNeill) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 375 metres. Pulled up prior to jumping the final two fences.</p> <p><b>ELUSIVE ACE</b> (J Seivwright) – Pulled up prior to jumping the final two fences.</p> <p><b>BANKS ROAD</b> (E Farr) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>RITESAIDZED</b> (N Downs) – Jumped indifferently throughout.</p> <p><b>ARGYLL</b> (B Donoghue) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 250 metres, losing momentum.</p> <p><b>N Downs</b> (RITESAIDZED) – Reminded of his obligations in that he must consider retiring his mounts from the race when they are not competitive.</p> <p><b>B Donoghue</b> (ARGYLL) – Fined \$200 by the Judicial Committee after committing a wrongful act after weighing out in that he changed his boots and added spurs, weighing in 0.5kg overweight.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>NATURPHOS LIQUID FERTILISER HURDLE (3100 metres)</b>
<p><b>MAGIC CANNON</b> (B Donoghue) – Contacted the front of its barrier stall forcing it open slightly early and as a result began awkwardly. Stewards were satisfied that MAGIC CANNON had not gained any advantage. Knuckled on landing after jumping the fence near the 950 metres. Lost the off-hind plate during the running.</p> <p><b>OUR CRAFTSMAN</b> (E Farr) – Misjudged the second fence.</p> <p><b>OXYMORON</b> (J Seivwright) – Pulled up prior to jumping the final three fences. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination including an endoscopic examination which failed to reveal any abnormality.</p> <p><b>SUMMER WARRIOR</b> (N Downs) – Pulled up prior to jumping the final two fences. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination including an endoscopic examination which revealed significant mucopus in the trachea.</p> <p><b>RAUCOUS</b> (D Parker) – Hit the fence near the 375 metres, losing momentum. Misjudged the fence near the 250 metres. Hit the final fence.</p> <p><b>WINDY HEIGHT</b> (G Walsh) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 250 metres.</p> <p><b>N Downs</b> (SUMMER WARRIOR) – Reminded of his obligations in that he must consider retiring his mounts from the race when they are not competitive.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>SIR SLICK THE PEOPLE’S CHAMPION (1600 metres)</b>
<p><b>ROCTHEPARTY</b> (A Calder) – Began awkwardly then veered out sharply shortly after the start.</p> <p><b>WELL I NEVER</b> (H Schofer) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>CHAKANA</b> (M McNab) – Raced ungenerously near the 1500 metres hampering NOUGAT.</p> <p><b>NOUGAT</b> (S Weatherley) – Hampered near the 1500 metres.</p> <p><b>BLACK CHEETAH</b> (J Fawcett) – When questioned regarding performance rider J Fawcett could offer no excuse.</p>	

<b>J Fawcett</b> (BLACK CHEETAH) – Admitted a charge in that she used her whip excessively prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>PIAKO RURAL SERVICES STEEPLECHASE (3500 metres)</b>
<p><b>EION</b> (D Parker) – Slow to begin. Misjudged the fence near the 650 metres.</p> <p><b>NO TIP</b> (S Phelan) – Misjudged the first fence and fell, dislodging the rider. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found no obvious abnormality. Rider S Phelan was cleared by the course Doctor and was found to be uninjured.</p> <p><b>TE KAHU</b> (M Roustoby) – Jumped indifferently throughout.</p> <p><b>NOTABADROOSTER</b> (E Farr) – Improved onto heels when jumping the 9<sup>th</sup> fence and was hampered.</p> <p><b>EL DISPARO</b> (B Donoghue) – Misjudged the final fence and fell, dislodging the rider. Rider B Donoghue was transported to hospital for further assessment with a suspected shoulder injury. B Donoghue will be required to provide a medical certificate prior to riding next. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to have blood in both nostrils and after undergoing an endoscopic examination was found to have no blood in the trachea.</p> <p><b>LEICA WARRIOR</b> (G Walsh) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to have a small wound on the right fore pastern and pulled a shoe.</p> <p>Following the race, connections of the 3<sup>rd</sup> placed horse LEICA WARRIOR wished to view Stewards footage, electing not to proceed with a protest.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>J. SWAP CONTRACTORS TE AROHA CUP (2200 metres)</b>
<p><b>ELLE D'BERRY</b> (A Scott) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>LOVETTORLEAVEIT</b> (N Smith) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>LOCHARBURN</b> (S Malki) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>COLIN OSCOPY</b> (L Phelan) – Lay out under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p><b>RISING RANSOM</b> (B Yuill) – Rider relaxed ride from 75 metres and was subsequently beaten for 4<sup>th</sup> position.</p> <p><b>B Yuill</b> (RISING RANSOM) – Admitted a charge in that he failed to ride his mount out over the final 75 metres when there was a reasonable chance of finishing 4<sup>th</sup>. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee suspended B Yuill's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 27 June up to and including racing on Sunday 11 July, 2 national amateur riding days.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>UNDERGROUND TAKEAWAYS SEPTIC TANK SERVICES 2200</b>
<p><b>OCEANTOOCEAN</b> (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly then crowded. Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p><b>FORTUNE WINGS</b> (A Goindasamy) – Raced keenly when being restrained.</p> <p><b>A Goindasamy</b> (FORTUNE WINGS) – Reminded of his obligation with regards to his whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p>	

<b>Race 7</b>	<b>TE AROHA PLUMBING AND DRAINAGE 1600</b>
<b>MR BAZAMOUR</b> (C Grylls) – Slow to begin.  <b>KIRRA LAD</b> (S Weatherley) – Restrained at the start from a wide barrier.	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>SILVER FERN FARMS TE AROHA/WAITOA 1400</b>
<b>LOFTY</b> (E Nicholas) – Slow to begin.  <b>ATTACK OF THE MAK</b> (C Barnes) – Slow to begin.  <b>PACHECO</b> (R Elliot) – Hampered near the 400 metres when LE CHAMOSSAIRE shifted out when struck with the whip before being immediately corrected by its rider. A Goindasamy was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.
