Race 3 AONGATETE AVOJECTS HANDICAP (1200 metres)

BRING IT ON (S Spratt) – Trainer Mr C Isdale reported to Stewards, upon return to his stable, BRING IT ON, underwent a veterinary examination which found the gelding to have an infected sole. C Isdale's veterinarian confirmed the infection was the cause of the lameness to the near fore. BRING IT ON has now undergone treatment for the infection.

Race 4 BULK LINES LIMITED HANDICAP (2100 metres)

RISING REWARD (T Newman) – Trainer Mr N Bishara advised Stewards, RISING REWARD, had blood tests taken on Tuesday 29 June, which revealed the filly to be showing signs of tying up. N Bishara further advised RISING REWARD has now been sent for a spell.

Race 6 ZEST HANDICAP (1400 metres)

THUNDER (E McCall) – Trainer Mr B Autridge advised Stewards, although satisfied with the post-race condition of THUNDER, puts the disappointing performance down to the track conditions. B Autridge further advised it is his intention to continue on with the gelding's current preparation.

Racing Te Aroha, Sunday 27 June 2021

Race 2 NATURPHOS LIQUID FERTILISER HURDLE (3100 metres)

SUMMER WARRIOR (N Downs) – Trainer Mr D Wiles advised Stewards, after undergoing a post-race endoscopic examination which revealed the gelding to have mucopus in the trachea, SUMMER WARRIOR, has been placed on five days' worth of antibiotics. D Wiles further advised, SUMMER WARRIOR will participate in a gallop on Tuesday 6 July, and will then undergo another endoscopic examination to determine if the mucopus has cleared. If results show the trachea clear of any mucopus, D Wiles may look to nominate the gelding for Te Aroha on Sunday 11 July.

<p>LOGAN'S LOGIC (R Elliot) – Steadied from a wide barrier.</p> <p>SMUG (D Danis) – Raced in restricted room passing the 1400 metres then steadied when SWISS IDOL shifted in slightly. J Kamaruddin was advised to exercise care.</p> <p>LAGERFELD (J Riddell) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>SEVEN PAIRS (A Goindasamy) – Contacted and unbalanced passing the 250 metres. When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.</p> <p>OPTIMUM SWEET (T Newman) – Held up until passing the 100 metres.</p> <p>GLORIFIED (C Grylls) – Held up rounding the final bend before shifting outwards passing the 250 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p>VITANI (E Leighton) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.</p> <p>SHIBUYA KOSATEN (S Spratt) – Lay out rounding the final bend making contact with SEVEN PAIRS passing the 250 metres.</p>

<p>NONAAME (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p>	

CLARA BELLE (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly. Raced wide without cover for a majority of the race.

KIKI (A Calder) – Began awkwardly.

GITCHE GUMEE (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormality. Co-trainer P Williams advised that the mare would now be sent for a spell.

RISING STORM (L Allpress) – Raced wide in the early stages.

WHILE YOU'RE THERE (S Spratt) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight, then improved onto heels over the concluding stages.

MILLENNIUM DAWN (L Satherley) – When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding had failed to respond between the 1000 metres and 400 metres when amongst runners, however when obtaining clear running to the outside of runners had finished the race off well, adding that in her opinion the gelding would benefit from the addition of blinkers.

Race 3 | **CAMBRIDGE EQUINE HOSPITAL 1300**

LAKEMAN (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly then crowded and steadied. Restrained off heels near the 900 metres.

THE OTHER BROTHER (L Allpress) – Slow to begin.

RIVER OF HOPE (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly. Raced wide without cover throughout.

TELEKINETIC (L Innes) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Race 4 | **PAYNTERS' CATERING 1300**

KANTRA (H Schofer) – Began awkwardly then hampered losing ground, becoming tailed off in the early to middle stages.

DUBY (J Kamaruddin) – Began awkwardly with the rider becoming unbalanced. Had to be steadied after improving into a marginal run to the inside of IMPLICIT passing the 700 metres. Crowded near the 500 metres after improving onto heels having to be steadied.

OCEAN CRUIZER (J Riddell) – Crowded leaving the barrier.

FASONG (E Nicholas) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

JUST KATE (T Thornton) – Raced wide without cover throughout when over-racing.

THORA'S JOY (C Grylls) – Had to shift outwards entering the final straight to obtain clear running.

T Newman (IMPLICIT) – Issued with a warning for allowing her mount to shift in when not sufficiently clear of DUBY which had to be steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 700 metres.

Race 5 | **WINDSOR PARK STUD STALLIONS 1300**

LADY VADAMOS (D Danis) – Slow to begin. Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 1100 metres to the inside of MR BLUE SKY which shifted in when not fully clear. M McNab was advised to exercise care. Made the bend near the 950 metres awkwardly shifting wider on the track.

IT'S THE VIBE (H Schofer) – Commenced to buck shortly after the start losing ground. Connections were advised that the gelding would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

AFTER PARTY (K Asano) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Race 6 | **NZB INSURANCE \$10K BONUS HEAT 2 (1300 metres)**

BROOKBOURNE (B May) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Rider dropped his whip near the 400 metres. Improved onto heels passing the 150 metres having to be firmly restrained.

SERENGETI (K Hercocock) – Steadied from a wide barrier. Had to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on heels near the 900 metres. Improved onto heels having to be steadied near the 700 metres. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

ROWIN (T Thornton) – Raced wide without cover.

JAQUOLEE (T Newman) – Raced wide without cover.

BENDERMERRY (L Allpress) – Raced ungenerously through the middle stages when awkwardly placed near heels.

ENCANTADOR (E Leighton) – Jumped a shadow on the track near the 350 metres.

CHOPPER REED (S Spratt) – Jumped a shadow on the track near the 125 metres. Jumped a shadow on the track near the 25 metres with the rider becoming unbalanced.

BONNIE AND CLYDE (K Asano) – Held up rounding the final bend before shifting in passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

Race 7 | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1300 metres)**

XPLOSION (E Leighton) – Very slow to begin (10L). Trainer P Lock was advised that the mare would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

ERIDANI (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly then steadied from its wide barrier.

PENNY JANE (H Schofer) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Crowded and checked passing the 150 metres.

SHAMPAGNE DANCER (J Kamaruddin) – Raced wide without cover before improving forward in the middle stages to sit outside the leader.

MINI MINER (K Asano) – Shifted out passing the 250 metres to avoid the heels of SHAMPAGNE DANCER which was racing greenly with BELTOY shifting out and away from that runner.

BELTOY (B Rogerson) – Dictated wider passing the 250 metres.

J Kamaruddin (SHAMPAGNE DANCER) – Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he allowed his mount to shift in when not sufficiently clear of PENNY JANE which was crowded and checked passing the 150 metres. After hearing submissions, the Judicial Committee suspended J Kamaruddin's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 10 July up to and including racing on Saturday 17 July, 4 national riding days and in addition imposed a fine of \$200.

Race 8 | **THE OAKS STUD 970**

DARCI PALMER (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly.

BOLT FROM THE BLUE (L Allpress) – Shifted outwards abruptly away from OUR WONDERLAND which had shifted out slightly passing the 100 metres hampering OOGA CHAKA.

OOGA CHAKA (M McNab) – Proved difficult to load. Connections were advised a warning would be placed on the gelding's barrier manners. Hampered passing the 100 metres.

Race 9 | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (970 metres)**

JUSTABEAUTY (K Asano) – Began awkwardly making contact with DOVES BAY.

LIGHTNING MISS (K Hercock) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which confirmed the filly to have bled. Connections were advised that the filly would now be subject to the mandatory 2 month stand down from training, 3 month stand down from racing or trialing with a veterinary clearance being required prior to racing or trialing next.

MISS FENDT (B Rogerson) – Eased down from near the 600 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the mare had felt indifferent in its action. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormality. Co-trainer G Rogerson advised that he would be considering the racing future of the mare.

Race 10 | **NORWEGIAN PARK 970**

SAMIRA (L Allpress) – Slow to begin (3L). When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no excuse.

MONKEY KING (E Leighton) – Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after.

FLYPAST (H Schofer) – Reared as the start was effected losing ground (5L). Co-trainer G Rogerson was advised that a warning would be placed against the gelding's barrier manners.

CIVIL UNREST (J Riddell) – Raced wide without cover.

PHOENIX IKKI (L Satherley) – Raced wide without cover.

SHANG CHI (C Grylls) – Raced ungenerously when being placed in restricted room for a distance approaching the 750 metres. Raced wide without cover.

GEE STRING (K Hercock) – Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

ROW OF EIGHTS (A Goindasamy) – Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

JAMESON (R Elliot) – Returned to the enclosure with blood present in a nostril. Underwent a subsequent post-race veterinary examination including an endoscopic examination which could find no abnormality.

L Satherley (PHOENIX IKKI) – Issued with a warning for permitting her mount to shift in when not sufficiently clear of SHANG CHI which had to be steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 750 metres.
