<b>MAKE TIME</b> (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly losing ground.	
<b>JAKAMA JILL</b> (S Collett) – Began awkwardly.	

<p><b>ANN TALE</b> (C Lammas) – Slow to begin</p> <p><b>LIMENTIS</b> (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>PAPENHUYZEN</b> (T Thornton) – Raced wide without cover.</p> <p><b>SIZZLER</b> (C Burdan) – Raced in restricted room passing the 600 metres.</p> <p><b>CERYs</b> (A Calder) – Briefly held up early in the final straight.</p> <p><b>A Goindasamy</b> – Issued with a warning for the use of his whip on ARATAI when out of contention.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>Visit the Avondale Sunday Markets (1100 metres)</b>
<p><b>ALL BLACK BOURBON</b> (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly and then was crowded. Commenced to over-race in the early stages for a distance.</p> <p><b>UNCLE TERRY</b> (T Newman) – Crowded when leaving the barriers. Held up passing the 350 metres having to shift out to obtain clear running.</p> <p><b>ATOM ANT</b> (M Kareem) – Began awkwardly. Crowded losing ground 900 metres.</p> <p><b>BURTON</b> (S Spratt) – Crowded and hampered leaving the barriers by NITRO which had shifted in and away from LITTLE STEVIE.</p> <p><b>ZOLTAN</b> (T Yanagida) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied passing the 900 metres shifting out and crowding ATOM ANT which lost ground and continued to race ungenerously having to be steadied off heels near the 800 metres.</p> <p><b>RUBYSHOWOFF</b> (T Thornton) – Had to be firmly restrained off heels passing the 800 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>Conference Centre – Marshall Stand (1100 metres)</b>
<p><b>CRITICS CHOICE</b> (C Dell) – Crowded shortly after the start.</p> <p><b>HENRY HUDSON</b> (R Elliot) – Restrained from a wide barrier. Crowded and steadied passing the 200 metres.</p> <p><b>ANNA CECELIA</b> (S McKay) – Raced wide without cover.</p> <p><b>DIVINE DIVE</b> (A Goindasamy) – Raced in restricted room then commenced to over-race and improved on to heels approaching the 800 metres and was hampered. Shifted in passing the 200 metres inconveniencing HENRY HUDSON which had to steady. When questioned into the performance of DIVINE DIVE the rider was unable to offer any reason for the gelding's performance. DIVINE DIVE underwent a post race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.</p> <p><b>A Goindasamy</b> – Issued with a warning in that he allowed DIVINE DIVE to shift in when not fully clear of HENRY HUDSON which had to shift ground inwards to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres.</p> <p><b>ERIDANI</b> (D Johnson) – Raced in restricted room approaching the 300 metres to the inside of TINY TERROR which lay in and continued to lay in for the remainder of the race.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>AJC Members (1100 metres)</b>

<p><b>MAKABAR</b> (R Beemud) – Began awkwardly. Held up early in the final straight and then had to be steadied and shift out across heels passing the 300 metres.</p> <p><b>KEEP IT REAL</b> (E Nicholas) – Began awkwardly and steadied off heels shortly after.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>AJC on Facebook (1200 metres)</b>
<p><b>STAR FLASH</b> (C Burdan) – Was removed from the barriers to undergo a veterinary examination and was cleared fit to race.</p> <p><b>REDWOOD TIGER</b> (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly. Underwent a veterinary examination after being eased down in the final straight which revealed no abnormalities.</p> <p><b>ROBROCKS</b> (J Riddell) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>SHOCKING PENNY</b> (S McKay) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>JIMMY FROM MAYO</b> (D Johnson) – Restrained from a wide barrier.</p> <p><b>RIBZZ</b> (S Collett) – Restrained from a wide barrier.</p> <p><b>STAR RISE</b> (C Lammas) - Commenced to over-race when being steadied becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of GAS MONKEY which shifted in when not fully clear shortly after the start.</p> <p><b>PROSPEROUS</b> (M Kareem) – Steadied near the 1000 metres when placed in restricted room to the inside of STAR RISE.</p> <p><b>KISS AN ANGEL</b> (T Thornton) – When questioned into the performance of the favourite the rider advised that the filly was unable to handle today's track conditions and it is intended to freshen the filly.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>Westbrook Wines (1400 metres)</b>
<p><b>DAY DREAMER</b> (A Goindasamy) – Crowded and badly hampered when leaving the barriers and then commenced to race ungenerously for a distance.</p> <p><b>CAPTAIN REG</b> (T Thornton) – Crowded and badly hampered when leaving the barriers.</p> <p><b>DAAD</b> (T Newman) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>RELIABULL</b> (S Collett) – Restrained soon after leaving the barriers then commenced to over-race for a distance.</p> <p><b>ARLINGTON GOLD</b> (R Oliver) – Lay in passing the 400 metres contacting and crowding CHOUX A STAR and continued to lay in for the remainder of the race.</p> <p><b>CHOUX A STAR</b> (S Spratt) – Contacted and crowded passing the 400 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>Beckett Real Estate (1400 metres)</b>
<p><b>RISING RENOWN</b> (A Calder) – Removed from the barriers after becoming fractious and was declared a late scratching at 3.40pm acting on veterinary advice.</p> <p><b>IMA WONDER</b> (L Satherley) – Steadied when in restricted room on jumping away. Held up for a distance prior to entering the final straight. Hampered over the concluding stages.</p> <p><b>PRINCE SOLARI</b> (T Thornton) – Slow to begin then hampered losing ground.</p>	

**HUSK** (M Kareem) – Contacted and unbalanced losing ground at the start.

**CHUR CHING** (T Newman) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

**LEITRIM LAD** (S Spratt) – Lay in across the heels of HOLA SENORITA which had shifted out slightly near the 50 metres.

**INSIDE STORY** (R Elliot) – Shifted out abruptly despite the efforts of its rider hampering IMA WONDER over the concluding stages.

Following the race the rider of the 2<sup>nd</sup> placed horse IMA WONDER viewed footage with Stewards electing not to proceed with a protest.

**THE BUFFER** (S Collett) – Slow to begin.

**SHEBRINGSMERUBIES** (J Kamaruddin) – Began awkwardly. Briefly steadied 200 metres when SWEET CLEMENTINE shifted out to obtain clear running.

**AZABEAT** (T Newman) – Lay in approaching the 1300 metres making contact with ANATOW which became unbalanced.

**ANATOW** (S Spratt) – Contacted and unbalanced 1300 metres. Crowded 900 metres.

**E Nicholas** (EACH WAY) – Was to spoken to after allowing EACH WAY to improve into a marginal run to the inside of MR BIG causing crowding to AZABEAT and ANATOW near the 900 metres.

**M Hashizume** (SWEET CLEMENTINE) – Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift out passing the 200 metres when not clear of SHEBRINGSMERUBIES which briefly steadied.

**AZABEAT** (T Newman) – Crowded 900 metres. Crowded and steadied over concluding stages.

**A Calder** (MY CALLISTO) – Issued with a warning after allowing MY CALLISTO to shift in over the concluding stages when not clear of AZABEAT which steadied. Contributing was outwards movement by MR BIG.
