RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 WELCOME BACK TO HAWKE'S BAY RACING 2YO (800 Metres)

R Elliot (BOOMER HILL) – Unable to make the carded weight for BOOMER HILL and was fined \$250. R Elliot was replaced by S Weatherley.

AUTOBAHN (C Lammas) – Did not race in the advertised blinkers with co-trainer E Browne advising these had been removed with the National Racing Bureau within the required timeframe, which was verified, but had not been

processed. Slow away.

KALUANUI (R Oliver) – Slow away.

GOLDEN HUE (J Parkes) – Crowded shortly after the start when LACED WITH GOLD was taken in by ROHANISA (L Hemi). L Hemi was advised to exercise greater care.

LACED WITH GOLD (C Grylls) -Hung outwards rounding the final turn and in the straight.

SORRIDA (L Allpress) – Inclined to hang outwards and race greenly in the final straight then having to be checked to avoid the heels of AUTOBAHN (C Lammas) passing the 200 metres after shifting outwards away from KALUANUI (R Oliver), which was also inclined to shift away from PLATINUM STAR (K Asano) when that runner was shifting outwards to obtain clear running. K Asano was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground. Contributing with some inwards movement was AUTOBAHN.

REBEL RIOT (R Myers) – Required post-race veterinary treatment after pulling up poorly, having suffered from the thumps.

Race 2 BOSTOCK NZ SPRING CARNIVAL MAIDEN (2100 Metres)

SANLORENZO (C Johnson) – Slow away.

BUDDY PERFECT (S Weatherley) – Slow away.

RAUCOUS (J Riddell) – Slow away.

THE ANARCHIST (T Allan) - Hampered start.

BRAWLER (J Parkes) – Hampered start.

DUNDEE STREET (R Myers) - Steadied off heels near the finish.

Race 3 WINDSOR PARK PLATE RACEDAY 3 OCTOBER (2100 Metres)

MISHKA (C Lammas) - Jumped away awkwardly then having to be steadied when crowded.

VITTACHI (J Parkes) - Lay in under pressure early in the straight, having to be corrected.

T Thornton (OTIS) – Spoken to regarding her whip use prior to 100 metres.

Race 4 LIVAMOL CLASSIC RACEDAY 17 OCTOBER MAIDEN (1200 Metres)

The start was delayed approximately 5 minutes when FLEURISSIMO required farrier attention behind the barrier.

FLEURISSIMO (D Johnson) - Required farrier attention behind the barriers. Raced ungenerously after having to be steadied away from the heels of VIKING near the 950 metres, going back on to KING KAIDE, which was checked. Blundered passing the 300 metres. When questioned D Johnson advised the filly travelled well in the early stages until faltering near the 300 metres. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to receive any obviously abnormality. Connections were advised to report progress over coming days.

NO ROCK NO POP (L Hemi) – Contacted leaving the barriers. Hampered near the 950 metres when FLEURISSIMO shifted outwards.

ORIENTAL BAY (R Myers) – Hampered leaving the barriers when TANOSHI jumped outwards abruptly

TANOSHI (R Elliot) - Jumped away awkwardly.

EMPOWER (S McKay) – Crowded leaving the barriers.

KING KAIDE (T Thornton) – Checked to avoid heels near the 950 metres, losing ground.

TANGODANZER (S Weatherley) - Lay in having to be steadied away from heels approaching the 200 metres.

Race 5 BOOK NOW FOR CHRISTMAS AT THE RACES MAIDEN (1200 Metres)

RED 'N' SURF (C Johnson) – Slow away.

ANTIGUA (J Parkes) – Over-raced for a distance going into the first turn near the 900 metres.

IF ONLY I KNEW (C Burdan) - Raced three wide without cover.

LINCOLN TOWN (K Asano) - Inconvenienced near the 300 metres when RED INFERNO shifted out abruptly. S Weatherley was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

RED INFERNO (S Weatherley) – Inclined to hang. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had not felt overly comfortable in the left hand way of going and may be better suited over more ground.

PARISIAN POPPY (R Myers) – Blundered near the 300 metres.

Race 6 POWER FARMING HAWKE'S BAY MAIDEN (1650 Metres)

DERECHO (S Macnab) - Steadied when crowded shortly after the start.

THE BOUNDER (L Satherley) - Made the bend near the 1400 metres awkwardly.

WIND CHIMES (C Lammas) – Had to be steadied to avoid the heels of CARAMEL POPCORN (R Elliot), which shifted in near the 1300 metres when not fully clear. C Lammas lost control of his whip before regather it near the 200 metres.

R Elliot (CARAMEL POPCORN) - Issued with a warning after restraining his mount and shifting into the line of WIND CHIMES when not fully clear near the 1300 metres.

E Nicholas (JUDITH GARDENIA) - Issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 7 THREE WISE BIRDS BENCHMARK R65 (1650 Metres)

COOL HAND DUKE (R Bishop) - Steadied when improving on to heels near the 1100 metres.

BRASSY BOY (L Allpress) – Lay out rounding the final turn.

M Kareem (CENTRE ATTENTION) – Spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 8 MADD FUN COMPANY BENCHMARK R65 (1650 Metres)

ALMO STREET (L Hemi) - Slow away.

MY TOMMY (S McKay) – Slow away.

PRINCE TURBO (T Thornton) - Raced three wide without cover.

JOHNNIE REDMOND (S Weatherley) - Held up for a short distance near the 400 metres.

Race 9 STELLA ARTOIS GARDEN BAR MAIDEN (1400 Metres)

CASTLE BLACK (R Beemud) – Began very awkwardly losing several lengths. Allowed his mount to improve to the inside of CUBA into restricted room near the 800 metres then had to be firmly restrained off heels for a distance. Again, attempted to improve to the inside of other runners in the straight when there was insufficient room to do so, becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of the weakening RELIABLE HUNTER passing the 100 metres. R Beemud was shown footage of his ride in the presence of the riding master and advised he is expected to ride with better judgment in future.

BOSTON STRONG BOY (J Parkes) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 10 SIGN CENTRAL MAIDEN (1400 Metres)

R Oliver spoken to regarding the use of his whip when his mount MANHATTAN GIRL proved reluctant to load.

CYNDY WINK (C Burdan) – Slow away. Rider dropped her whip shortly after the start with the mare then tailing the field for the remainder of the race.

ALTAR BOY (L Allpress) – Jumped away awkwardly and shifted inwards crowding SYBARITE on to STIRLING FALLS and JENEVER.

JENEVER (C Johnson) - Slow away and further hampered when crowded. Held up rounding the final turn. When questioned rider advised the mare had felt flat through the early and middle stages and after being held up rounding the turn had only been travelling fairly when obtaining racing room passing the 300 metres. C Johnson agreed with stewards' assessment that he should then have shown more vigour in his riding. C Johnson was advised that he must ride his mount at all times in a manner which is not left open to query. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

STIRLING FALLS (E Nicholas) – Crowded start.

FABULOUS FLEET (D Johnson) – Ducked inwards abruptly passing the 1000 metres having to be corrected by its rider and racing very ungenerously with the rider then feeling there may be something amiss, with FABULOUS FLEET losing its chance in the race. A post-race veterinary inspection was clear. Connections were advised that a warning has been placed against the racing manners of FABULOUS FLEET.

SYBARITE (S Macnab) - Held up entering the straight near the 350 metres and did not obtain clear running until near the 200 metres.

GREYSTONE (R Myers) - Shifted outwards to obtain clear running near the 200 metres then making contact with KHALFANI, which was racing tight to the inside of RED SUNDAY near the 100 metres, with those three runners coming together for a distance resulting in GREYSTONE having to be steadled over the concluding stages to avoid the heels of UNIVERSAL STARS which shifted outwards under pressure.

KHALFANI (R Elliot) - Raced in restricted room near the 100 metres.

MANHATTAN GIRL (R Oliver) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the straight.

Race 11 TARZINO TROPHY DAFFODIL RACEDAY 19 SEPTEMBER (1300 Metres)

GALLARDO (R Oliver) - Slow away.

YEAH RIGHT (C Johnson) - Slow away.

HOT SPRING PROJECT (L Innes) - Jumped away awkwardly then being further hampered when RISTRETTO shifted outwards. When questioned regarding performance, rider was unable to offer any excuse advising that the gelding had been very disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination was clear.

CRUZ RAMIREZ (L Allpress) - Raced three wide without cover until passing the 600 metres.

SHOWPIECE (D Johnson) – Rider was of the opinion the mare may prefer a firmer track but should take natural improvement from the run.

C Lammas (PLUTON) – Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 12 FAREWELL ROS STACE BENCHMARK R65 (1300 Metres)

RUIE'S CRUMPET (T Allan) - Underwent and passed a veterinary inspection prior to the start. Finished well back. Rider had no excuse.

OZIL (R Myers) - Slow away.

SMOKIN' OAK (R Oliver) - Slow away.

ONE PRIZE ONE GOAL (T Thornton) - Slow away.

YOSSARIAN (C Johnson) – Unable to obtain clear running until inside the final 100 metres.
