Race 4 – RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE KORAL STEEPLECHASE (4250 Metres)

WHOLETTHEFOXOUT – Trainer D Cunningham advised that after further veterinary examination which found the gelding to have significant injuries to the right foreleg, a decision had been made to euthanise the horse on welfare grounds.

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RACE COMMENTS	
Race 1	SOUTH ISLAND RACING AWARDS SEPTEMBER 17 MAIDEN HURDLE (3100m)
<p>REDESDALE (S Phelan) – Rider briefly lost his outside iron shortly after the start. Put in an awkward leap at the fence passing the 2000 metres. Weakened from the 1000 metres. Retired from the race at the 600 metres when well beaten.</p> <p>MR FAHRENHEIT (M Cropp) – Jumped the first three fences awkwardly. Rider accidentally dropped his whip near the 700 metres. Fell at the second to last fence dislodging the rider. Neither horse nor rider were injured in this incident.</p>	
Race 2	WEST FITZROY APARTMENTS MAIDEN (2000m)
<p>CASTLE BLACK (K Chowdhoo) – Began awkwardly and very slow in the early stages. A warning was placed on the gelding's barrier manners. Co-trainer M Pitman advised the stewards that it is his intention to now retire the gelding as a racing proposition from his stable.</p> <p>FORT WILLIAM (K Asano) – Rider reported that the gelding did not handle today's testing track conditions.</p> <p>T Thornton (SUMMER NIGHT) – Admitted a charge of excessive whip use prior to the 100 metres, with the Ajudicative Committee suspending her licence to ride at race meetings for 5 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on 18 August up to and including 27 August.</p> <p>B Murray (TAKEITEASY) – Admitted a charge of excessive whip use prior to the 100 metres, with the Ajudicative Committee suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 5 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on 14 August up to and including 26 August.</p>	
Race 3	RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE 0-2 WINS STEEPLECHASE (4150m)
<p>OXYMORON (M Cropp) – Weakened from the 1600 metres and was retired from the race near the 1200 metres.</p> <p>TELL ME MORE (S Phelan) – Put in an awkward leap at the fence near the 1400 metres. Retired from the race near the 700 metres prior to jumping the third last fence.</p> <p>SON OF ANNA KAY (M Gillies) – Made a poor leap at the last fence and knuckled on landing dislodging the rider who was uninjured in this incident.</p> <p>C Myers (SON OF ANNA KAY) – Admitted a breach of Rule 614(2) after presenting the gelding with the incorrect saddle cloth and was fined \$50.</p> <p>S Fannin (CARNABY) – Issued with a warning for using his whip above shoulder height.</p>	
Race 4	ELMWOOD TRADING CO MAIDEN (1600m)
<p>KING KHAN (L Allpress) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>CARDBOARD GANGSTER (J Laking) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>KENKI (E Nicholas) – Slow to begin. Had some trouble obtaining clear running rounding the final bend.</p> <p>CHOICE MOMENT (C Johnson) – Over raced in the early to middle stages.</p> <p>HIT THE DIFF (S Macnab) – Briefly placed in restricted room passing the 1100 metres when CHOICE MOMENT shifted in before being straightened by its rider.</p>	

TREKOLURE (T Jonker) – Raced wide without cover.

KHANT REID (M Gestain) – Raced wide from the 700 metres without cover.

Race 5 NAUTICAL INSURANCE DUKE OF GLOUCESTER CUP (1800m)

YOU NEVER KNOW (V Mason) – Raced wide in the early stages.

SO CALL ME (L Kennedy) – Raced wide in the middle stages.

MAGIC IVAN (B Yuill) – Had to be steadied away from heels of the runner in front passing the 1100 metres when dictated inwards by YOU NEVER KNOW which was laying inwards at this point.

Race 6 HAASE MARSHALL DRAINAGE Rating 74 (1500m)

THE GROWLER (S Toolooa) – Slow to begin.

HOLY LOCH (C Johnson) – Raced wide throughout.

SO MUCH MOUR (B Rogerson) – Over raced in the middle stages.

PEARL DAVONE (E Nicholas) – When questioned regarding the improved performance, trainer P Harris advised that after being crowded on jumping and losing ground at its last start, the mare had benefited from a front running ride and change of gear today.

ST ANDRE (J Lowry) – When asked to comment on the performance of this favoured runner, rider was of the opinion the gelding had not been comfortable in today's holding track conditions.

S Toolooa (THE GROWLER) – Reprimanded for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 7 MCMILLAN EQUINE Rating 74 (1000m)

CELINE (M Gestain) – Slow to begin. Shifted in abruptly passing the 200 metres when struck with the whip having to be straightened by the rider.

SO NATURAL (T Comignaghi) – Crowded shortly after the start when LINEDANCEKING shifted out abruptly.

SPRING BLOSSOM (L Callaway) – Rider reported that the mare had felt indifferent in its action and was unable to be ridden out over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

DESERT MAGIC (E Nicholas) – Rider reported that the gelding had not felt comfortable in today's testing track conditions.

WALKTHISSWEY (F Lazet) - Treated post-race after being galloped on during the running.

F Lazet (WALKTHISSWEY) – Reprimanded for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 8 HOSPITALITY NEW ZEALAND CANTERBURY 131ST GRANT NATIONAL HURDLES (4200m)

CHIEF SEQUOYAH (E Farr) – Slow to begin. Over raced in the early stages. Put in a poor leap at the last fence on the first round. Landed awkwardly after jumping the fourth last fence. Put in a poor leap jumping the third last fence, unbalancing and dislodging the rider. Neither horse nor rider were injured in this incident.

RINGBOLT (H McNeill) – Put in a poor leap at the last fence on the first round. Under pressure passing the 1200 metres and retired from the race prior to jumping the second last fence.

RICHARD OF YORKE (M Roustoby) – Landed awkwardly after negotiating the second to last fence.

Race 9 | **HOTELIERS CHALLENGE MAIDEN (1200m)**

SHESOFABULOUS (K Kwo) – Began awkwardly.

TURMOIL (K Chowdhoo) – Crowded shortly after the start.

SERAPHIC (B Murray) – Shifted out abruptly at the start crowding outside runner and then making contact with GLADROY becoming unbalanced and losing ground.

GLADROY (C Johnson) – Shifted in abruptly on jumping crowding inside runners.

SHEZA PRO (T Jonker) – Began awkwardly shifting out crowding SENOR DUKE.

SENOR DUKE (J Laking) – Crowded at the start

SAVUSAVU PRINCESS (E Nicholas) – Raced wide throughout. Rider dropped her whip near the 400 metres.

PENDORO (W Papier) – Rider dropped his whip near the 350 metres.

FLEURISSIMO (L Allpress) – When questioned regarding performance, rider advised that the mare had lugged outwards throughout and had not felt comfortable in today's testing track conditions.

LADY MODENA (R Mudhoo) – Briefly held up passing the 350 metres having to shift ground inwards to find clear racing room.

B Murray (SERAPHIC) – Admitted a breach of excessive whip use prior to the 100 metres, with the Ajudicative Committee suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 7 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on 26 August up to and including 8 September.

K Moore (SHEZA PRO) – Issued with a warning after presenting his mount without notified gear.

Race 10 | **LINDAUER OPEN HANDICAP (2000m)**

ROSIE GLOW (S Khetoo) – Slow to begin.

VERRY FLASH (S Macnab) – Held up rounding the final bend having to shift out passing the 375 metres to find clear racing room.
