Race 10 - LINDAUER OPEN (2000 metres)

K Williams (MISS TAVI) – Was reprimanded for her use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 SPEIGHT'S 0-1 WIN HURDLE (3100m)

REDESDALE (B Lammas) – Misjudged the first fence. Raced wide in the early stages. Retired from the race near the 400 metres prior to jumping the second to last fence.

GOLD'NGURU (G Walsh) – Jumped indifferently throughout before being retired from the race near the 1400 metres.

KAHARAU (E Farr) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1200 metres. Put in a poor jump at the fourth to last fence.

BULLITT (N Downs) – Hit the second to last fence.

Race 2 ZILCO RATING 74 (1200m)

GOODANYA (K Chowdhoory) – Began awkwardly. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 300 metres. When spoken to regarding the form turnaround of the gelding, trainer P Harris advised that GOODANYA had benefited from its race on the first day of the meeting along with the drop in class today.

TAP 'N' GO (L Callaway) – Raced wide throughout. Rider reported that the gelding failed to cope with today's very testing track conditions.

WHERE'S WALLY (K Williams) – When questioned regarding performance the rider was unable to offer any excuse, advising that the gelding had been a beaten runner near the 600 metres. A post race veterinary inspection revealed an elevated heart rate.

Race 3 ELLIE STOKES TRUST FUNDRAISER MAIDEN (1400m)

SERAPHIC (B Murray) – Slow to begin. Raced wide throughout.

HEADS UP (G Jogoo) – Began awkwardly. Raced ungenerously early to middle stages having to be further restrained when improving onto heels approaching the 800 metres.

SHEZA PRO (T Jonker) – Raced in restricted room near the 1100 metres to the inside of BURNVUE which lay in away from LENNON (K Chowdhoory), with SHEZA PRO going back onto GALAXY POWER which had to steady. K Chowdhoory was advised to exercise greater care.

GALAXY POWER (K Mudhoo) – Steadied to avoid heels near the 1100 metres. Lay in under pressure in the straight.

R Cuneen (BURNVUE) – Reprimanded for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 4 COUPLAND'S BAKERIES CELEBRATING 50 YEARS RATING 74 (1600m)

ARE YOU CEREAL (M Gestain) – Made contact with SO MUCH MOUR leaving the barriers. Inconvenienced near the 400 metres when ORIGINAL GANGSTER shifted inwards with ARE YOU CEREAL then shifting outwards across heels to obtain clear running.

SO MUCH MOUR (B Rogerson) – Contacted leaving the barriers. Raced wide throughout.

J Lowry (ST ANDRE) – Admitted a charge of excessive whip use prior to the 100 metres, with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a fine of \$300.

Race 5 VERNON & VAZEY RATING 74 (2000m)

QUEEN SWEEP (M Gestain) – Slow to begin. Had to shift outwards to obtain clear running passing the 500 metres.

ZURAFAA (T Comignaghi) – Made the crossing near the 1900 metres awkwardly.

SLAMMER (C Campbell) – Raced wide throughout. Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 500 metres when ZURAFAA was forced outwards by LOCALLY SAUCED (K Chowdhoory).

K Chowdhoory (LOCALLY SAUCED) – Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift outwards near the 500 metres.

Race 6 RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE 146TH GRAND NATIONAL STEEPLECHASE (5600m)

TITTLETATTLE (G Walsh) – Jumped the fence near the 800 metres on the first occasion indifferently. Put in a poor jump at the fourth to last fence.

MRS TWINKLETOES (E Farr) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 400 metres on the second occasion. Badly misjudged the second to last fence and blundered on landing.

MASTER COURTSMAN (M Gillies) – Misjudged the first of the stand double on the second occasion. Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1900 metres on the final occasion.

MR ENTHUSIASTIC (M Cropp) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1900 metres on the final occasion landing awkwardly. Jumped the two fences of the kennels double near the 1200 metres on the final occasion slowly and was then retired from the race.

THE ROLLING STONE (H McNeill) – Jumped the fence near the 1500 metres awkwardly. Retired from the race prior to jumping the final fence.

COCONUT (J Seivwright) – Put in a poor jump at the third to last fence. Retired from the race prior to jumping the final fence.

SHAMAL (B Lammas) – Put in a poor jump at the second to last fence.

TALLYHO TWINKLETON (S Phelan) – Jumped the second to last fence indifferently becoming unbalanced on landing.

Race 7 D REYNOLDS ELECTRICAL WINTER CLASSIC (1800m)

The start was delayed due to the saddles of MISS TAVI and ZEEFA ZED requiring adjustment behind the barriers.

TAKE THE DEEL (T Moseley) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

VERRY FLASH (A Comignaghi) – Raced wide throughout.

S Khetoo (ROSIE GLOW) – Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he allowed his mount to shift inwards near the 1500 metres when not sufficiently clear of BLUEY'S CHANCE which was checked. After hearing submissions the Adjudicative Committee suspended S Khetoo's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Friday 27 August until the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 8 September, 6 national days, and in addition imposed a fine of \$250.

TAPPY'S ONE (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the middle stages.

FULL FURY (S Toolooa) – Lay outwards rounding the bend and throughout the run home.

S Khetoo (ROSIE GLOW) and **S Toolooa** (FULLY FURY) were reprimanded for being late to take their mounts in the enclosure.

Race 8 HEATSTORE OPEN HANDICAP (1400m)

IRISH EXCUSE (K Williams) – The start was delayed when the gelding was reluctant to load. The connections were advised that IRISH EXCUSE was under a barrier manners warning. Slow to begin.

ROCK ISLAND LINE (K Asano) – Raced wide throughout.

CARSON RIVER (K Chowdhoory) – Held up early in the straight.

JUSTASKME (B Rogerson) – Inconvenienced near the 200 metres when ROCK ISLAND LINE shifted outwards under pressure. Shifted inwards under pressure passing the 100 metres having to be straightened by its rider.

K Asano (ROCK ISLAND LINE) – Admitted a charge of excessive whip use prior to the 100 metres, with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a fine of \$500.

T Taiaroa (CHOSEN PEAK) – Admitted a charge of excessive whip use prior to the 100 metres, with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a fine of \$300.

Race 9 MILLENNIUM HOTELS & RESORTS RATING 65 (1400m)

SHE'S GOT THE LOOK (S Macnab) – Began awkwardly.

HARLEEN QUINZEL (G Jogoo) - Blundered on jumping.

BELT ROAD (L Allpress) – Slow to begin. Raced wide throughout.

WILD LIKE (K Chowdhoory) – Over raced in the early stages. Had to shift ground to avoid the heels of BARRETT passing the 500 metres.

KING OF THE CASTLE (S Khetoo) – Raced wide throughout.

BARRETT (K Williams) – Had to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of MEILA REI near the 600 metres then striking a heel of that runner and blundering before being further hampered when THE BUFFER shifted outwards.

THE BUFFER (T Moseley) – Held up passing the 600 metres then being forced outwards due to movement of runners to its inside further hampering BARRETT.

PAPAGENA (S Toolooa) – Lay out rounding the final turn forcing DETTIFOSS outwards onto REGAL GIRL and THE BUFFER near the 500 metres.

RED MAGICIAN (K Mudhoo) – Struck a heel of the weakening PAPAGENA and blundered approaching the 400 metres.

Trainer L Stewart (HARLEEN QUINZEL) – Issued with a warning for late declaration of rider.

K Chowdhoory (WILD LIKE) – Admitted a charge of excessive whip use prior to the 100 metres. After hearing submissions, the Adjudicative Committee suspended K Chowdhoory's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Friday 20 August until the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 1 September, 7 national riding days.

Race 10 SI RACING AWARDS 17 SEPTEMBER RATING 65 (2000m)

RAISE YOUR SIGHTS (K Asano) – Slow to begin then further hampered by TAPDOG which jumped inwards.

COLOUR ME RED (L Callaway) – Jumped away awkwardly and shifted outwards hampering FAUX PAS.

FAUX PAS (R Mudhoo) – Hampered start.

OCEANS AWAY (T Taiaroa) – Crowded on jumping, was inclined to over race getting its head up in the early stages. Placed in restricted room for a distance approaching the 700 metres when ECHO BAY shifted outwards with OCEANS AWAY making contact with the hindquarters of AQUATTACK.

AQUATTACK (T Comignaghi) – Crowded on jumping. Hindquarters contacted near the 700 metres becoming unbalanced.

SUTHERLAND (K Mudhoo) – Over raced in the early stages.

COUNTESS RUBY (L Allpress) – Raced wide throughout. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the mare had been unable to quicken in today's track conditions.

TAPDOG (C Johnson) – Held up rounding the final turn and early in the straight.

B Murray (CAST IN BRONZE) – Reprimanded for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.
