GENERAL

Rider R Cole advised Stewards at 9.05 am on Saturday 31 July that he was injured and would not be attending today's meeting.

Apprentice rider W Pinn advised at 9.30 am on race morning that he was unwell and would not be attending the meeting.

Both W Pinn and R Cole are required to provide medical certificates prior to riding next.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 NATURPHOS LIQUID FERTILISER HURDLE (3100 metres)

BANKS ROAD (E Farr) – Slow to begin. Jumped the first fence awkwardly. Contacted and forced wider passing the 750 metres.

SLY BALJO (K Joyce) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1000 metres and knuckled on landing. Pulled up prior to jumping the last three fences.

EL LUCHADOR (J Seivwright) – Hit the third to last fence. Misjudged the second to last fence.

SHOCKOVA (M Gillies) – Failed to jump the last three fences.

VAN BLANC (S Phelan) – Improved onto heels passing the 750 metres then shifted out contacting BANKS ROAD. Hit the second to last fence and blundered unbalancing its rider with the rider losing the use of his right iron before quickly regathering it.

AONGATETE EXPRESS (N Downs) - Misjudged the final fence.

SENASSY (D Parker) – When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no excuse.

Race 2 DAVID MILLER RACING OPEN DAY 29 AUG 2200

AL'S RED ZED (L Zydenbos) – Slow to begin.

JAKKI SPARROW (S Van Lierde) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

FIRE DANCER (M Hill) – Hampered shortly after the start losing ground. Raced keenly in the early stages having to be steadied off heels shifting out passing the 2000 metres.

VANGUARD (S MacNab) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

SHOCKING PIERRE (S Malki) – Ran wide rounding the first bend before being corrected by its rider. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormality.

TYCOON WARRIOR (K Wiles) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormality.

L Zydenbos (AL'S RED ZED) – Spoken to regarding the manner in which she used her whip.

 Race 3
 GRAHAM LEMON, MURRAY DARROCH, OPTIMISM SYD STEEPLECHASE (3500 metres)

 CRACKTHEGOODSTUFF (M Cropp) – Slow to begin.

ZINZAN (J Seivwright) – Began awkwardly.

FLYINGWITHOUTWINGS (N Downs) – Slow to begin. Made the first jump awkwardly briefly unbalancing its rider losing the use of his right iron, then quickly regathered.

MAGIC CANNON (E Farr) – Misjudged the fence near the 1500 metres. When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no excuse.

BLANCO BAY (M Gillies) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions.

Race 4 KNOTTINGLY FARM OPEN STEEPLECHASE (3500 metres)

MANDALAY (S Fannin) – Slow to begin. Misjudged the second to last fence and landed awkwardly.

NO TIP (S Phelan) – Jumped the first fence awkwardly. Misjudged the fifth fence.

THAT'S HOW IT GOES (K Joyce) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

LACUSTRE (C Thornton) – When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that in his opinion the impost of 69 kgs on a heavy track had been detrimental to the gelding's chances. Received veterinary attention following the running of this race after suffering a hoof wall injury to the left fore leg. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.

KANGAROO (D Parker) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Pulled up prior to jumping the final two fences. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding had raced keenly throughout and when placed under pressure, failed to respond. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

TE KAHU (M Cropp) – Rider reported that the gelding had felt lame on pulling up. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormality.

K Joyce (THAT'S HOW IT GOES) – Admitted a breach in that she used her whip excessively when using the whip in consecutive strides. After hearing submissions, the Adjudicative Committee imposed a fine of \$300.

Race 5 PIAKO MITSUBISHI 1200

GNASHER (A Lawson-Carroll) – Began awkwardly then crowded, losing ground.

TIN SOLDIER (E McCall) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

NOTABADPHELAN (E Nicholas) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Inconvenienced passing the 850 metres.

RED INFERNO (T Yanagida) – Improved onto heels having to be steadied before shifting out inconveniencing NOTABADPHELAN passing the 850 metres.

KEEP IT REAL (T Abel) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

GO YOU GOOD THING (E Leighton) - Raced in restricted room passing the 400 metres.

Race 6 COMAG LTD 1200

PULA (M Sanson) – Slow to begin.

C'EST LA GRIS (J Kamaruddin) – Slow to begin.

LETS NOT FORGET (E Leighton) – Hampered shortly after the start losing ground.

SOME LIKE IT HOT (Y Coonee) – Hampered shortly after the start briefly unbalancing its rider.

TAVIROCK (B Rogerson) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

SUPERIOR SAM (T Yanagida) – Restrained behind runners shortly after the start.

SHADOW MAN (C Jones) – Held up approaching the 100 metres having to shift inwards to obtain clear running.

E McCall (SNAKEYE) – Admitted a breach of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres. After hearing submissions, the Adjudicative Committee imposed a fine of \$300.

Y Coonee (SOME LIKE IT HOT) – Reminded of his obligations regarding celebratory gestures prior to the finishing post.

Race 7 TE AROHA TRACTORS & GARDEN MACHINERY 2200

DELUXE EDITION (M Hashizume) – Slow to begin.

FLYING FANTASIA (A Lawson-Carroll) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced wide without cover throughout.

MATARO (K Asano) – Slow to begin then hampered, losing ground. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

E Leighton (LOCALLY SAUCED) – Reprimanded regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

C Jones (TUNZAGUTZ) – Reprimanded regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 8 TE AROHA VETERINARY SERVICES 1400

MANDY MAY (M Sanson) – Began awkwardly then hampered, losing ground. Knuckled shortly after the start.

KRYPTONITE (T Abel) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.
