Riders underwent work place alcohol breath testing all providing clear results.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 CENTRAL OTAGO LAKES EQUESTRIAN CENTRE MAIDEN 2030m

THREE OVER TWO (R Cuneen) – Jumped away awkwardly.

ROYAL KHAN (B Murray) - Hampered shortly after the start. Was held up rounding the final bend and for the majority of the run home going to the line untested by its rider.

HOUSE OF CARDS (S Toolooa) – Raced three wide without cover through the early and middle stages.

The connections of the second placed SPONSOR lodged a protest against the winner NO QUARTER ASKED on the grounds of interference over the concluding stages with the Adjudicative Committee upholding the protest promoting SPONSOR to first placing and NO QUARTER ASKED being relegated to second.

S Khetoo (NO QUARTER ASKED) – Was issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift out under pressure over the concluding stages making contact with SPONSOR who was shifted off his line of running.

Race 2 OTAGO FARM MACHINERY MAIDEN 1400m

DICELAND (L Allpress) – Steadied when placed in restricted room shortly after the start. Hampered passing the 200 metres and raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

MASTER MARKO (L Callaway) – Fractious in its barrier prior to the start and was then slow to begin.

XIAMEN (C Johnson) – Tailed the field throughout and was reported by its rider to race greenly. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed no abnormalities.

DOUBLE PROSPERITY (B Murray) – Had to be steadied when denied a marginal run passing the 200 metres and when shifting out briefly hampered DICELAND.

CAPO DELL IMPERO (J Lowry) – Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of LENNON near the 1100 metres. K Chowdhoory was advised to exercise greater care.

There was a delay to placings being confirmed due to the photo finish camera malfunctioning.

L Callaway (MASTER MARKO) – Issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(g)(ii) for striking his mount on consecutive strides.

Race 3 WINGATUI FUNCTION CENTRE MAIDEN 1400m

BOB MARLIE (K Mudhoo) - Slow away. Held up for the majority of the run home only gaining clear racing room inside the final 75 metres.

BEAU STITCH (B Murray) – Slow away.

UGO (L Callaway) - Slow away.

BENTLEY (T Comignaghi) – Shifted in abruptly as the field made the junction at the 1200 metres having to be straightened by its rider. Held up rounding the final bend and when changing ground near the 250 metres inconvenienced VAN DIESEL.

VAN DIESEL (T Moseley) – Inconvenienced near the 250 metres. Held up for clear running until inside the final 100 metres.

JIMILICIOUS (K Chowdhoory) – Placed in restricted room passing the 1100 metres when GRANDILOQUENT shifted in before being straightened by its rider.

TAPPY'S LAD (C Johnson) – Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the event.

ROSY CLARK (C Campbell) – Steadied away from heels near the 750 metres when racing keenly. Held up rounding the final bend and for the majority of the run home going to the line not fully tested by its rider.

Race 4 ALLEVIATE ADMINISTRATION RATING 74 1400m

MAMMA SANS (B Murray) – Slow away. Held up rounding the final bend and shifted ground inwards passing the 250 metres to find clear racing room.

RUBY ROYALE (C Johnson) – Slow away.

SHOWEMHOWITSDONE (S Toolooa) – Slow away.

MY WORLD (K Chowdhoory) – Raced three wide without cover. Placed in restricted room having to be steadied passing the 100 metres when RUBY ROYALE shifted outwards under pressure.

CAITLYN JAY (K Asano) – Raced wide without cover.

ARKLOW (L Allpress) – Raced wide without cover through the early stages and wide throughout.

JIM'S GIFT (K Mudhoo) – Raced in restricted room passing the 175 metres.

C Johnson (RUBY ROYALE) – Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift out under pressure crowding MY WORLD who was steadied passing the 100 metres.

Race 5 POSITIVE SIGNS + PRINT OPN HCP 1400m

CETUS (K Chowdhoory) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

GOODANYA (T Comignaghi) – Blundered leaving the barriers.

THE GIFT (J Lowry) – Jumped away awkwardly. Rider advised the mare had had breathing issues throughout the running and in his opinion, she may have flipped her palette. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary inspection which revealed epiglottic entrapment with the connections advised the mare will require a veterinary clearance prior to racing next. Stewards will also follow up with connections in the coming days.

TELLYAWHAT (K Williams) – Jumped away awkwardly.

EL BEE DARCI (R Mudhoo) – Steadied passing the 1000 metres.

SENTIENT (T Moseley) – Gave ground from the 400 metres and was not persevered with in the run home with the rider advising the gelding had not backed up from its run on Friday.

Race 6 SPEIGHT'S RATING 65 2030m

IFITHAPPENSAGAIN (L Allpress) – Was fractious in its barrier and jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

OCEANS AWAY (B Murray) – Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages after jumping from a wide barrier.

SHOCK AND AWE (Y Atchamah) – Jumped away awkwardly. Raced wide from the 1000 metres.

WILD LIKE (K Chowdhoory) – Began awkwardly.

JACK KNOWS BEST (R Cuneen) – Over raced in the early stages. When asked to comment on the performance rider advised the gelding was looking for tracks with more moisture in them.

SUMMER NIGHT (K Asano) - Over raced in the early stages and was then allowed to stride forward down the back straight to sit outside the leader passing the 800 metres.

REDGUM (T Moseley) - Over raced for a distance passing the 1200 metres and continued to race greenly in the run down the back straight.

SUPER TAP (C Johnson) – Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home.

HEY MICKEY (T Comignaghi) – Hampered and had to steady when SUPER TAP was taken inwards by the weakening SUMMER NIGHT simultaneous to VEE TWELVE shifting ground outwards under pressure.

COUNTRY BOY (C Campbell) – Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home only gaining clear racing room inside the final 125 metres.

Race 7 LOVERACING.NZ CROMWELL CUP OPN HCP 2030m

WILLIAM WALLACE (B Murray) – Slow away.

EL GLADIADOR (T Comignaghi) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running through the middle part of the run home only gaining clear racing room inside the final 75 metres. Nonetheless rider advised Stewards she had been disappointed with the effort of the gelding.

LEITRIM LAD (T Moseley) - Briefly steadied away from heels passing the 700 metres when over racing.

ORIGINAL GANGSTER (K Williams) – Briefly steadied away from the heels of FIRODEN passing the 250 metres when that runner shifted ground marginally.

Race 8 FRESH CHOICE CROMWELL RATING 65 1220m

SHAM ON TOAST (K Mudhoo) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

GLOBAL STAR (L Allpress) – Jumped away awkwardly before being further hampered losing ground. Raced keenly in the early stages.

MAXIE TAP (C Johnson) – Over raced passing the 1000 metres. Held up in the run home and then further hampered having to steady passing the 75 metres when TAP 'N' GO shifted inwards. L Callaway was advised to exercise greater care and straighten his mounts sooner than he did on this occasion.

GIVEHERAGO (K Williams) – Placed in restricted room and had to be steadied passing the 900 metres when OUR CLARRY shifted inwards. Then shifted ground outwards hampering TAP 'N' GO who was shifted wider on the track for a short distance passing the 850 metres. Rider reported the mare had a nice trip after being hampered but when placed under pressure in the final straight had disappointed.

TAP 'N' GO (L Callaway) – Hampered and forced wider on the track passing the 850 metres.

SWEET MOLLY MALONE (C Campbell) – Made the bend near the 700 metres awkwardly when shifted wider by inside runners and then hung rounding the final bend.

SHE'S RECOMMENDED (T Moseley) – Held up in the run home only gaining clear racing room inside the final 125 metres.

Y Atchamah (OUR CLARRY) – Issued with a warning when allowing his mount to shift in crowding GIVEHERAGO passing the 900 metres.

K Williams (GIVEHERAGO) – Issued a warning for allowing her mount to shift out when not fully clear of TAP 'N' GO which was forced wider on the track passing the 850 metres.

Race 9 GRAND CASINO RATING 65 1400m

WILD ROVER (K Chowdhoory) – Slow to begin.

PROWLER (J Lowry) – Slow to begin.

REDFORD (L Callaway) – Slow to begin. Steadied when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 500 metres.

THE GREEN GREMLIN (C Campbell) – Raced four wide with cover throughout.

NEVER QUITZ (S Toolooa) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

VARDON ROAD (K Williams) - Made the bend by the 500 metres awkwardly when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of WILD ROVER which shifted out with the trailing REDFORD having to be steadied as a result.

PHELAN THE POWER (K Asano) – Lay outwards in the run home and near the 200 metres made contact with POWNCE before being straightened by its rider. Continued to lay out in the run home and near the 50 metres shifted out again and brushed with POWNCE.

SO NATURAL (Y Atchamah) - Awkwardly placed on heels near the 50 metres having to be briefly steadied.

TREYBON (L Allpress) – Held up rounding the bend and early in the run home and when shifting ground inwards near the 200 metres placed WAIMATE BILL in restricted room breifly.

WAIMATE BILL (A Bohorun) – Placed in restricted room near the 200 metres.

The connections of the second placed POWNCE lodged a protest against the winner PHELAN THE POWER on the grounds of interference in the final straight. After hearing from all parties, the Adjudicator dismissed the protest.

K Asano (PHELAN THE POWER) – Was issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift outwards in the run home contacting POWNCE near the 200 metres and again brushing with that runner inside the final 50 metres.
