Race 6 NICHOLAS MELONI EVES 2100

OAK (M Cameron) – Trainer Mr G Thomas advised Stewards he was satisfied with the post-race condition of OAK and it is his intention to continue on with the gelding's current preparation. G Thomas further advised he may look to apply blinkers prior to OAK'S next race day start.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 T W MOORE 1950

QUEEN SUGAR (S McKay) – Slow to begin. Steadied when placed in restricted room approaching the 1100 metres then commenced to race ungenerously through the middle stages.

UPLAND COURT (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin.

TE POROPITI (L Satherley) - Began awkwardly shifting out making contact with MADAME GUERIN. Held up for a distance rounding the final bend.

RED EMPEROR (K Asano) - Restrained shortly after the start to obtain cover.

DO THE MATHS (M Cameron) - Got its head up when being steadied racing into the first bend and continued to race keenly for a distance. Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 150 metres.

SWEET TUI (T Yanagida) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. Following a veterinary inspection SWEET TUI was confirmed to have bled. SWEET TUI shall not be ridden in exercise for a period of two months or start in any race or trial for a period of three months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Veterinarian.

K Asano (RED EMPEROR) - Issued with a warning for permitting his mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of QUEEN SUGAR which had to be steadied when placed in restricted room approaching the 1100 metres.

Race 2 SWEENEY TOWNSEND INSURANCE 3YO (1230 metres)

POMPEIANA (A Goindasamy) – Bounded as the start was affected.

NOVASHOW (C Grylls) – Shifted out abruptly at the start crowding HABANA, losing ground as a result.

HABANA (L Innes) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

LINGJUN HERO (T Yanagida) - Began awkwardly. Crowded and checked passing the 950 metres.

ABLE WHITE (V Colgan) - Crowded and checked approaching the 900 metres.

KEYSTONE (C Barnes) - Crowded and checked approaching the 900 metres.

SENSE OF STYLE (M Cameron) - Crowded and checked approaching the 900 metres.

BUCCHERI (L Satherley) - Crowded and checked approaching the 900 metres.

NOTIMETOWASTE (B Rogerson) – Commenced to over-race in the early stages having to be firmly restrained off the heels of BUCCHERI approaching the 900 metres then continued to over-race again having to be firmly restrained off heels near the 700 metres.

M Alam (LAST RESORT) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift in near the 900 metres crowding and severely checking LINGJUN HERO, ABLE WHITE, SENSE OF STYLE, KEYSTONE and BUCCHERI. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee suspended M Alam's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 1 December up to and including racing on Sunday 26 December, 14 national riding days.

Race 3 LANCE LAWSON 1230

NO AGENDA NIGEL (M Alam) - Slow to begin.

CAKEBYTHEOCEAN (V Colgan) - Shifted in at the start making firm contact with LOVE LETTER which lost some ground.

RACONTEUSE (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Lay out rounding the final bend.

LOVE LETTER (L Allpress) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

ZAZZLE (C Barnes) - Briefly held up entering the final straight.

ATLANTIC CITY (D Johnson) - Held up rounding the final bend.

Race 4 LASER ELECTRICAL ROTORUA 1230

DON'T LOOK ETHEL (C Barnes) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

ROCKSPELL (D Johnson) - Slow to begin.

SIZZLING GOLD (L Satherley) – Crowded shortly after the start losing some ground.

ZADANE (A Goindasamy) – Slow to begin.

PIN ME UP (C Grylls) – Slow to begin.

CHOPPER REED (L Innes) - Got its head up for several strides passing the 1100 metres when being steadied to take cover. The rider reported that the gelding had been making abnormal breathing noises. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

THE STONEY ONE (L Allpress) – Raced wide throughout.

SHINING PEAK (K Asano) - Steadied away from heels passing the 1000 metres when racing keenly.

INITIATE (T Newman) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

MACROS (N Parmar) – Held up entering the final straight.

Race 5 ISCL 1560

DENNISMAC (K Asano) - Slow to begin. Raced wide throughout.

REALDOSER (R Elliot) - Steadied when awkwardly on heels racing into the first bend.

ENRIGHT (T Thornton) - When questioned regarding the improved performance the trainer advised that the gelding had benefitted and taken natural improvement from recent racing.

TUSCAN HOLIDAY (C Grylls) – Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 550 metres.

Race 6 ATKINSON & DONALDSON PLUMBERS 1560

MADI'S DREAM (N Parmar) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

OZARK (K Asano) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover. Hampered approaching the 400 metres.

QUEEN SARABI (T Yanagida) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover.

ICE OUT (M Cameron) - Ducked in abruptly despite the efforts of its rider approaching the 400 metres hampering OZARK and RUIZ.

RUIZ (J Kamaruddin) - Hampered approaching the 400 metres.

Race 7 MTF FINANCE ROTORUA 1560

MISHKA (C Grylls) - Slow to begin.

C'EST UNE STAR (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin.

INVALUABLE (V Colgan) - Crowded having to be steadied passing the 1450 metres when runners either side shifted ground. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions.

MOHAKA (L Douglas) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 200 metres.

LAVAGLO (L Allpress) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the mare had failed to respond when placed under pressure after racing keenly during the running.

Race 8 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1560 metres)

HERSELF (C Grylls) – Restrained at the start from a wide draw to obtain cover.

SIDE HUSTLE (V Colgan) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

SOCIAL DISTANCE (D Johnson) - Slow to begin.

JENNIE MORRIS (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early stages. Hampered 250 metres.

SONGSUNGBLU (L Allpress) - Slow to begin.

ARANCIA (L Satherley) - Hampered having to be steadied passing the 1100 metres. Placed in restricted room after improving into a marginal run passing the 500 metres then held up for a distance when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of BELLA VOLAIRE.

BORDEAUX ROSE (M Cameron) – Crowded and buffeted passing the 250 metres.

BELLA VOLAIRE (C Barnes) - Made the bend near the 1200 metres awkwardly shifting outwards and when being corrected by its rider, shifted inwards hampering ARANCIA which had to be steadied to avoid heels near the 1100 metres.

KAIMAI QUEEN (T Yanagida) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

MADAME LE FAY (J Riddell) – Raced greenly for a distance passing the 400 metres.

J Riddell (MADAME LE FAY) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he angled his mount out crowding and buffeting BORDEAUX ROSE onto JENNIE MORRIS which was also hampered passing the 250 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee suspended J Riddell's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 11 December up to and including racing on Sunday 19 December, 5 national riding days.

Race 9 RYDGES HOTEL 1230

GRAND GESTURE (R Elliot) – Held up rounding the bend and for the majority of the straight and went to the line not fully tested by its rider.

ROC CHA (R Beemud) – Bounded at the start.

DRUM MAJOR (B Rogerson) - Crowded at the start.

WEWILLROCK (L Allpress) – Raced keenly through the early stages. Lay in throughout the run home and had to be straightened passing the 125 metres.

STYLISH SUGGESTION (K Asano) - Had to steady when awkwardly placed on the heels of LIGHT BROCADE passing the 225 metres which shifted out before being corrected by its rider.

Race 10 WAITOMO FUELS 1400

PARISIAN (B Rogerson) – Connections were advised that a warning would be placed on the gelding's barrier manners. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

LUM REEK (S McKay) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground and then commenced to over-race for a distance passing the 1250 metres.

REGAL DUCHESS (A Goindasamy) - Had to be steadied near the 550 metres and when being steadied placed KID ROC in restricted room.

KID ROC (J Riddell) – Raced keenly in the middle stages.

CANNSEA CLEARLY (K Asano) - Underwent a post-race veterinary examination including endoscopic examination which did not reveal any abnormality.
