Race 8 LUCIA VALENTINA WELLINGTON STAKES 1600 (Group 3)

TURN THE ACE (L Allpress) – Co-trainer Mr A Forsman advised Stewards, the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of the gelding, however, has now been sent for a brief freshen up.

WATUZZI (D Johnson) – Slow to begin.

GRAND PROSPECT (L Allpress) – Began awkwardly.

DETONATE (R Hannam) – Raced three wide without cover throughout the early and middle stages.

EDDIE WOOD (L Douglas) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Shifted in under pressure hampering **KHANT CATCH HER** near the 300 metres which was taken inwards.

KHANT CATCH HER (L Hemi) – Hampered and shifted inwards 300 metres.

ANTIPODES (T Yanagida) – Hampered and buffeted and forced outwards onto **LATIN QUARTER** passing the 500 metres.

LATIN QUARTER (M Singh) – Buffeted and hampered 500 metres.

RONIN POROTENE (N Parmar) – Held up for clear racing room early in the final straight and went to the line not fully tested.

PRINCE OF DOON (C Grylls) – When questioned regarding the performance rider reported his mount got further back in the running then intended and was unable to make up any ground in the home straight in the Slow 7 track conditions.

A Mudhoo (HERE COMES TROUBLE) – Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he angled his mount out buffeting and hampering **ANTIPODES** and **LATIN QUEEN** passing the 500 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee suspended A Mudhoo licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 11 December up to and including racing on Sunday 19 December, 5 national riding days.

Race 2	MONSTAVISION MAIDEN 3YO 1100

VERDICCHIO (R Hannam) – Slow to begin. Tailed off throughout. R Hannam advised that in his opinion the filly would improve with racing.

TAMBERI (T Yanigida) – Slow to begin.

MOVIN' ON (M Sanson) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

FIFITA (R Elliot) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 3 | **RETURN TO EARTH MAIDEN 1200**

PISCO SOUR (C Grylls) – Jumped outwards at the start making firm contact with CHAMPAGNE GOLD with both runners losing ground as a result.

CHAMPAGNE GOLD (A Goindasamy) – Contacted at the start losing ground.

REINE D’AMOUR (L Hemi) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Crowded and checked passing the 225 metres.

PERFECTIONIST (L Allpress) – Began awkwardly.

DREAM MACHINE (L Douglas) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Underwent a post race veterinary examination which revealed cardiac arrhythmia. The connections were advised that DREAM MACHINE would require a veterinary clearance prior to trialling or racing next.

TUDOR QUEEN (V Cogan) – Raced wide throughout.

EXPRESSO (M Cameron) – Hung outwards rounding the home turn and passing the 400 metres shifted out forcing TUDOR QUEEN over extra ground.

L Douglas (DREAM MACHINE) – Was spoken to in regards to his whip use on a runner out of contention.

S O’Malley (CHAJABA) – Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he allowed his mount to shift inwards crowding and checking REINE D’AMOUR near the 225 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee suspended S O’Malley’s licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 11 December up to and including racing on Sunday 19 December, 5 national riding days.

Race 4 | **NULOOK ALUMINIUM 1200**

BARNEY RUBBLE (L Douglas) – Restrained shortly after the start to retain cover.

BURGUNDY ROSE (J Kamaruddin) – Slow to begin.

IFINDOUBTGETOUT (J Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

CAMINATA (K Asano) – Raced wide through the early and middle stages. When questioned into the performance of the favoured runner rider advised in his opinion the mare did not handle today’s track conditions.

Following consultation with riders the track was further downgraded to Slow 9 retrospective to race 4.

Race 5 | **REVITAL FERTILISERS 1600**

LORD ESPERANZA (L Allpress) – Restrained to the rear from a wide draw.

BO JACKSON (J Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly bumping with FLORENTIA. Slipped and became unbalanced when racing free of interference passing the 1200 metres as the field were negotiating the crossing losing considerable momentum and ground. BO JACKSON took no further effective part in the race.

SUPER SID (A Goindasamy) – Over raced through the early stages and lost its footing when negotiating the crossing going on to the course proper and slipped near the 1200 metres.

PLATINUM PETALS (C Dell) – Raced three wide without cover.

ALL THAT JAZZ (A Mudhoo) – raced wide without cover throughout.

JESSIE’S ROCK (H Schofer) – Held up entering the final bend and was unable to obtain clear running until approaching the 250 metres.

ALHAMBRA LAD (R Elliot) – Lay in under pressure approaching the 100 metres.

When questioned into the run of **THE FEARLESS ONE** L Douglas advised that his mount was never comfortable in the track conditions which he described were shifty.

Following the running of race 5 the rider of BO JACKSON (J Mudhoo) reported to the Stewards that his mount had slipped badly resulting in it losing its footing in the back straight. The RIB then convened an inspection panel comprising stewards, riders, trainer and course management and after inspecting that area of the track where the slipping occurred, abandoned the meeting.
