Whangarei Racing Club @ Ruakaka - Saturday, 7 August 2021 Race 2 HIREPOOL (1600 metres) PADDY WAGON (J Fillmore) – Trainer Mr M Garrett advised Stewards, PADDY WAGON, was taken directly to Waikato Vets for a further veterinary examination including x-rays, which revealed the mare to have a split off fore pastern. PADDY WAGON underwent surgery where four screws were put into the pastern area. M Garrett further advised that PADDY WAGON has now left Waikato Vets and is recovering well.

RACE COMMENTS	
Race 1	WAIKATO DRAUGHT 1200
<p>MARCHIONESS (M McNab) - Crowded at the start. Raced keenly in the early stages. Held up until shifting inwards to obtain clear running approaching the 100 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a minor laceration to the off hind leg.</p> <p>TIN SOLDIER (C Dell) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>TREASURE STATE (D Johnson) - Slow to begin. Crowded being forced outwards making firm contact with ESCUDO passing the 225 metres.</p> <p>BERGAMO FOX (E Nicholas) - Crowded at the start.</p> <p>RUN FOR COVER (S Collett) – Crowded having to be steadied passing the 225 metres.</p> <p>ESCUDO (S Weatherley) - Contacted and unbalanced passing the 225 metres.</p> <p>LOWRY (L Satherley) - Inconvenienced approaching the 100 metres having to be steadied.</p> <p>RED INFERNO (T Yanagida) – Held up until shifting outwards to obtain clear running near the 225 metres.</p> <p>IRISH BOY (L Innes) – Became awkwardly placed on heels just prior to the winning post.</p> <p>M McNab (MARCHIONESS) - Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift out over the concluding stages inconveniencing IRISH BOY.</p> <p>T Yanagida (RED INFERNO) – Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he directed his mount out near the 225 metres when not sufficiently clear of TREASURE STATE, ESCUDO and RUN FOR COVER which were all crowded and checked to varying degrees. After hearing submissions, the Adjudicative Committee suspended T Yanagida’s licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 14 August until the conclusion of racing on Thursday 26 August, 5 national riding days and a fine of \$500.</p>	
Race 2	SVS STARTING GATES 1200
<p>THE BOOGEYMAN (E Nicholas) - Began awkwardly.</p> <p>JIMMY JANDAL (T Yanagida) - Slow to begin. Tailed off in the early stages despite the urgings of its rider.</p> <p>TIGHTEN YOUR GRIP (D Johnson) - Crowded at the start losing ground. Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p>GOLDEN HUE (W Pinn) – Lay out rounding the home turn bumping MR RAFIKI wider.</p> <p>MR RAFIKI (S Collett) - Contacted and forced wider entering the final straight.</p> <p>BELLA LUCE (A Lawson-Carroll) - Saddle shifted forward in the early stages placing the rider at a disadvantage for the remainder of the race.</p> <p>SO CHARMING (L Satherley) - Raced keenly in the early stages.</p>	

WHISKEY (S Weatherley) - Inconvenienced passing the 350 metres and again shortly after when racing greenly inside of BELLA LUCE.

J Kamaruddin (PERFECTIONIST) - Was reminded of his obligations in that he must ride his mounts out to the end of the race when circumstances permit him to do so.

W Pinn (GOLDEN HUE) - Issued with a warning for weighing in 0.4kgs under the handicap weight.

Race 3 | **XMAS @ TE RAPA TICKETS NOW ON SALE 1200**

AERO DE PARIS (J Kamaruddin) – Hung out for the majority of the race. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

DIVINE DIVE (S Collett) – Forced wider passing the 800 metres when racing to the outside of AERO DE PARIS which was laying out.

Race 4 | **DUNSTAN HORSEFEEDS 1400**

LETS NOT FORGET (L Satherley) - Slow to begin.

LE CAPILLA (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly.

PRAETORIAN (C Barnes) - Crowded at the start. Eased down in the final straight. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormality.

TELEKINETIC (M Cameron) - Began awkwardly.

LUV BELLA BOO (T Yanagida) - Contacted at the start.

DANCE 'N' SING (E Nicholas) - Crowded at the start.

ULAANBAATAR (D Johnson) - When questioned regarding performance, rider D Johnson advised the gelding was not comfortable in the existing track conditions.

TAVIROCK (R Elliot) – Inconvenienced passing the 350 metres when DANCE 'N' SING shifted out slightly.

HOGAN (V Colgan) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

TOOGOODTOSAYNO (S Collett) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a laceration to the right hind quarter.

R Elliot (TAVIROCK) - Reprimanded for his whip use prior to the 100 metres. Was stood down from his remaining rides due to illness.

CALL ME EVIE (W Pinn) - Slow to begin. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the mare to have bled. Connections were advised that the mare would now be subject to the mandatory two month stand down from training, three month stand down from racing with the appropriate veterinary clearance required prior to racing or trialling next.

PUSHKA (C Jones) – Slow to begin.

NOW IS NOW (S Spratt) – Crowded at the start.	
ANGELICA (J Kamaruddin) - Restrained at the start from a wide barrier.	
BULLYBROOK (E McCall) - Raced keenly in the early stages.	
MEGEVE (D Johnson) - Raced keenly in the early stages.	
Race 6	SUPER SETH @ WAIKATO STUD MILE (1600 metres)
ROSEWOOD (C Jones) - Slow to begin.	
CARPE DIEM (A Muhoo) – When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not revealed any obvious abnormality. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed against the gelding’s racing performance.	
Race 7	SKYCITY HAMILTON MILE (1600 metres)
RIVER RUN (M McNab) – Slow to begin.	
VITTACHI (S Spratt) – Raced in restricted room for a short distance passing the 800 metres. When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no excuse.	
KIRRA LAD (S Weatherley) – When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.	
ROYCE ROCA (S Collett) – When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the mare had been disappointing. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.	
Race 8	VALACHI DOWNS FOXBRIDGE PLATE DAY 28/8 2100
DIVINE DUKE (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin.	
AKELA BELLE (L Hemi) - Crowded shortly after the start.	
NASHA RIVA (D Johnson) - Began awkwardly then hampered shortly after having to be steadied.	
LA CASA (S Collett) – When questioned regarding the performance, the rider advised that the gelding had been uncomfortable in today’s track conditions.	
ENGLISH GAMBLER (J Riddell) – Raced keenly in the middle stages. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.
