RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 BREWS & QUES ON SALE NOW MAIDEN 2100

EAGLE HUNTER (S Weatherley) - Jumped away awkwardly making contact with KALUANUI. Improved forward from the rear quickly passing the 1200 metres when the pace steadied, reaching the lead approaching the 800 metres.

KALUANUI (C Grylls) - Contacted at start.

LADY TELENA (D Bradley) - Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 1800 metres. Raced wide without cover from the 1200 metres.

RISCHIO (L Hemi) - Steadied to obtain cover passing the 1800 metres. Had to shift outwards across heels to obtain clear running near the 200 metres and was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

SHE'S SO RELIABLE (L Allpress) - Steadied when awkwardly placed near the heels of CURRENT SURGE, which lay in away from I'M CHUCK near the 1700 metres. Steadied off the heels of CURRENT SURGE near the 1400 metres. Again steadied off the heels of CURRENT SURGE near the 1100 metres.

OVERAGAIN (J Riddell) - Had to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of I'M CHUCK near the 200 metres.

I'M CHUCK (C Dell) - Held up early in the straight.

Race 2	WAIPUKURAU MOTORS MAIDEN 1200
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SAINT BATHANS (S Weatherley) - Slow away. Badly held up in the straight until near the 150 metres.

SAVASILK (M McNab) - Slow away.

BADGERINGDAWITNESS (J Kamaruddin) - Slow away.

TRULY (C O'Beirne) - Commenced to over-race when being restrained passing the 1000 metres racing fiercely for a distance.

WINDSPEED (D Johnson) - Had to be firmly restrained when improving onto heels approaching the 800 metres.

DREAM GIRL (C Grylls) - Raced three wide without cover.

Race 3	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES MAIDEN RACE 1200
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KRONE (A Goindasamy) - Made contact with FLERTA shortly after leaving the barriers with the rider becoming unbalanced and losing the use of his left stirrup iron before being dislodged from his mount shortly after. A Goindasamy was attended to by ambulance personnel and found to be uninjured.

PENNSYLVANIA (S Weatherley) - Steadied to obtain cover shortly after the start after jumping from a wide barrier then losing ground in the early stages. When questioned, rider advised that the filly had been lost for early speed and he had also been concerned with how the riderless horse might react after dislodging its rider.

KORUBELA MISS (T Yanagida) - Steadied to obtain cover shortly after the start after jumping from a wide barrier then losing ground in the early stages. When questioned, rider advised he had been concerned with how the riderless horse might react after dislodging its rider. Inclined to lay inwards in the straight and did not obtain clear running until shifting outwards across heels near the 150 metres.

TUAHINE (D Johnson) - Made the bend near the 850 metres awkwardly when racing keenly.

SECRET FALLS (F Lazet) - Hung outwards throughout the race. Dislodged its rider when pulling up, with both horse and rider being uninjured.

APACHE WOMAN (C Grylls) - Held up early in the straight and again approaching the 200 metres.

TIGHTEN ME UP (M Cameron) - Inconvenienced approaching the 200 metres when MYRTLE CREEK which was improving into a tight run to its outside was taken in by TUAHINE.

MYRTLE CREEK (M McNab) - Held up entering the final straight and did not obtain clear running until approaching the 200 metres.

Race 4	BRAMWELL BATE LAWYERS SPRINT 1200
<p>SOPHISTICAL (D Johnson) - Slow away.</p> <p>BRADMAN (L Allpress) - Over-raced badly in the middle stages getting its head up when having to be heavily restrained. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the straight.</p> <p>MAGNESS (C Dell) - Raced wide without cover.</p> <p>ENCANTADOR (L Douglas) - Came under pressure near the 600 metres and failed to respond, dropping out to finish a distant last. When questioned rider could offer no excuse, advising the gelding had felt disinterested and may be better suited to synthetic track racing where its best form has been. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.</p> <p>BRIMSTONE (R Elliot) - Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.</p>	
Race 5	VETSONE 1400
<p>NO ROCK NO POP (A Mudhoo) - Jumped away awkwardly.</p> <p>PROJECT (C Barnes) - Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>KING FAROUK (L Allpress) - Lay out rounding the final bend.</p>	
Race 6	PGC CONSTRUCTORS MAIDEN 1600
<p>VISHAKHA (K Hercock) - Began awkwardly and was slow into stride. Held up having to be firmly restrained off heels near the 450 metres.</p> <p>SILKY RED FOX (L Hemi) - Steadied when placed in restricted room going into the bend near the 1400 metres when racing to the inside of HOW MUCH FOR CASH (D Johnson), which had FIVE FORTUNE (R Hannam) racing to its outside and appeared to shift inwards marginally when making the bend awkwardly. R Hannam was advised to exercise care.</p> <p>NONCHALANT (J Riddell) - Raced wide without cover.</p> <p>SAILOR JACK (K Asano) - Hung outwards rounding the final turn and in the straight being unable to be ridden out by its rider as a result.</p> <p>SUBTLE POINT (M Singh) - Reported the gelding would be better suited to a rain-affected track.</p> <p>ANDROMEDA (S Weatherley) - On return to the enclosure was found to have bled from both nostrils. Following a veterinary inspection including an endoscopic examination ANDROMEDA was confirmed to have bled. ANDROMEDA shall not be ridden in exercise for a period of two months or start in any Race or Trial for a period of three months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Veterinarian.</p> <p>S O'Malley (SERGIO) - Issued with a warning for raising his arm above shoulder height when using the whip. Also spoken to regarding his use of the whip on a horse clearly winning.</p>	
Race 7	TREMAIN GROUP MILE 1600
<p>FAMILY TIME (R Elliot) - Slow away.</p> <p>PUTORINO (S O'Malley) - Restrained to obtain cover after jumping from the outside barrier.</p>	

CHANDLER (J Riddell) - Raced three wide without cover. Steadied away from heels when weakening approaching the 200 metres.

SWISH AZ (R Hannam) - Lay out rounding the final bend.

TUIGIRL (S Macnab) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised the mare had hung outwards throughout the race.

ROSBERG (A Goindasamy) - When questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion that the gelding had found today's track conditions too firm. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

WESTBURY STUD STAFF MAIDEN 1400

ABSOLUTELY MAYBE (S O'Malley) - Slow away.

MIDNIGHT SPECIAL (M McNab) - Crowded shortly after the start. Over-raced in the middle stages.

PLUCKY MISS (A Mudhoo) - Raced wide throughout.

STALLONE (D Johnson) - Held up near the 150 metres then when shifting outwards to obtain clear running made contact with AVIATOR near the 125 metres.

AVIATOR (L Allpress) - Lay in under pressure in the straight. Contacted 125 metres.
