SUPPLEMENTARY

Canterbury Racing 3rd December 2021 – Race 5 Coupland's Bakeries Rating 74 2000 Metres

Trainer P Harris advised Stewards that post-race **TOP GHIA** was found to have suffered a tendon injury with the mare now being retired from racing.

Trainer P Harris advised that after a disappointing performance **OCEANS AWAY** underwent blood tests which revealed the gelding to have a low white blood cell count and has been treated accordingly.

RACE COMMENTS	
Race 1	SOUTHERN INDUSTRIAL COATINGS MAIDEN (1400m)
<p>BUSH MILLS BILLY (A Bohorun) - Late scratching on Veterinary advice at 12.36 pm after being fractious around at the start area, making heavy contact with a tractor and suffering a wound to the left hock.</p> <p>BOB MARLIE (K Mudhoo) - Bounded at the start. Held up rounding the final bend and had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the run home, having to shift ground outwards passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>SIR ALLYKHAZANN (J Laking) - Got its head up in the early stages when being steadied to take a trailing position.</p> <p>AGAINST ALL ODDS (C Campbell) - Raced wide in the early stages. Lay inwards in the run home and could not be ridden out over the concluding stages.</p> <p>TAPPY'S LAD (C Johnson) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>TUMEKE (K Williams) - Held up rounding the final bend and in the home straight, having to shift ground inside the final 50 metres to find clear racing room.</p>	
Race 2	BELLEW & Co @SOUTHLAND REAL ESTATE MAIDEN (1400m)
<p>MARMADUKE (D Bothamley) - Blundered at the start briefly unbalancing the rider, losing some ground. Held up rounding the final bend only gaining clear racing room inside the final 150 metres.</p> <p>HAVAHO JO (A Bohorun) - Began awkwardly shifting out crowding outside runner. Raced greenly in the early stages. Briefly crowded passing the 300 metres when TORA ROSE (T Moseley) shifted out to find clear racing room. T Moseley was advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p>ANAFTERNOONDELIGHT (R Mudhoo) - Crowded at the start losing ground. Over-raced in the middle stages.</p> <p>SOVEREIGNTY (S Toolooa) - Had to be steadied near the 1200 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.</p> <p>OLE MATE (S Khetoo) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout. Hung outwards rounding the final bend. Lost the near hind racing plate during the running.</p> <p>EBONY MAGIC (BB Hong) - Raced four-wide without cover for the majority of the event.</p> <p>BACK HUT (C Campbell) - Raced wide with cover throughout.</p> <p>CAROLINE MARGARET (G Jogoo) - Made the final bend awkwardly.</p> <p>COSY NOOK (L Callaway) - Lay outwards rounding the final bend and throughout the run home.</p> <p>TORA ROSE (T Moseley) - Held up rounding the final bend having to shift ground inwards near the 200 metres to find clear racing room.</p> <p>BEAU STITCH (K Chowdhoo) - Briefly placed in restricted room passing the 75 metres when COSY NOOK shifted out marginally.</p>	
Race 3	GROUP ILT HANDICAP (1400m)

GOODANYA (K Chowdhoo) - Placed in restricted room passing the 1100 metres and briefly steadied when SILENT BATTLER was taken inwards by outside runners. Held up rounding the final bend only gaining clear racing room inside the final 175 metres.

HE'S GOT POWER (S Khetoo) - Over-raced until reaching the lead passing the 800 metres.

SILENT BATTLER (J Laking) - Held up rounding the final bend and then denied a marginal run passing the 150 metres having to be briefly steadied.

Race 4 | **SHOE CLINIC HANDICAP (1200m)**

J Lowry admitted a breach of Rule 330(3)(c) in that he failed to make the contract weight for his ride on MAKE BELIEVE and was fined \$100 under the Minor Infringement Schedule. J Lowry was replaced by S Muniandy.

GLORY CHANCE (K Williams) - Connections reported this mare would be racing in season.

SHE'S RECOMMENDED (T Moseley) - Fractious in the barriers and dropped its head just prior to the start unseating the rider. T Moseley was uninjured and able to fulfil his riding engagement. Held up for the majority of the run home.

FIERY RED (G Jogoo) - Began awkwardly and lost ground.

NEVER QUITZ (S Toolooa) - Began awkwardly shifting up the track crowding an outside runner. Held up over the concluding stages.

I'M HERE (T Comignaghi) - Began awkwardly and was then restrained to the rear from its wide barrier. Held up in the run home and went to the line not fully tested by its rider.

WALKTHISSWEY (K Chowdhoo) - Shifted out at the start crowding outside runners. Held up rounding the final bend and had to shift ground outwards passing the 200 metres to find clear racing room. Lay inwards over the concluding stages.

WAIMATE BILL (A Bohorun) - Crowded by inside runners shortly after the start losing ground.

COPY ME IN (C Johnson) - Raced four-wide without cover throughout.

LOUIS LUCK (D Bothamley) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout. Crowded and steadied near the 150 metres when PHYLLITE (C Campbell) shifted in under pressure before being straightened by its rider. C Campbell was advised to exercise greater care and straighten his mount sooner than he did on this occasion.

PHYLLITE (C Campbell) - Shifted ground inwards under pressure in the home straight having to be straightened on a number of occasions.

SHAM ON TOAST (K Mudhoo) - Crowded and had to steady near the 50 metres when PHYLLITE again shifted inwards before being straightened by its rider.

K Chowdhoo (WALKTHISSWEY) admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards near the 50 metres when not sufficiently clear crowding and checking PHYLLITE. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of Mr Chowdhoo's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing today Saturday 11 December until the conclusion of racing Thursday 23 December 2021, 7 national riding days.

Race 5 | **CHOPPA'S TYRES HANDICAP (1200m)**

THE ACE (K Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly and was then crowded losing ground.

MINT JULEP (K Chowdhoo) - Began awkwardly and shifted ground outwards crowding an outside runner. Crowded and placed in restricted room having to be restrained passing the 1100 metres.

CHEERS (S Toolooa) - Crowded and placed in restricted room having to be restrained passing the 1100 metres.

THE GOOD SHEPHERD (A Bohorun) - Over-raced through the early to middle stages.

BLAIR FLIGHT (J Laking) - Raced wide without cover until reaching the lead passing the 600 metres.

TYLER EIGHT (S Khetoo) - Lay outwards on the home turn with the rider dropping his whip passing the 225 metres then continued to lay out throughout the run home.

S Khetoo (TYLER EIGHT) defended a charge of careless riding, the particulars being that he permitted his mount to shift inwards near the 1100 metres when not sufficiently clear crowding MINT JULEP and CHEERS with MINT JULEP losing its position. After viewing replays and hearing evidence from all parties the Adjudicative Committee found the charge proved and following penalty submissions imposed a suspension of Mr Khetoo's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing today Saturday 11 December until the conclusion of racing Saturday 18 December 2021, 4 national riding days.

Race 6 | **HOWLEY JOINERY HANDICAP (2200m)**

SHE'S GOT THE LOOK (K Williams) - Began awkwardly.

FRANCIS DRAKE (S Toolooa) - Began awkwardly and got back.

SPONSOR (D Bothamley) - Over-raced in the early stages.

SUPER TAP (C Johnson) - When asked to comment on the performance rider advised the mare had received a nice run throughout but only battled over the concluding stages.

Race 7 | **TIM YEO CONTRACTING SOUTHLAND CRYSTALS (2200m)**

ASATHOUGHT (G Jogoo) - Slow to begin.

WANNABE 'N' PARIS (K Chowdhoo) - Had to be steadied off heels shortly after the start. Over-raced through the middle stages. Again had to be steadied away from heels passing the 100 metres when tiring.

RIVIERA ROCK (T Moseley) - Had to be steadied off heels shortly after the start. When asked to comment on the performance rider advised the gelding was not suited by the muddling pace of today's race.

FIRODEN (C Campbell) - Raced three-wide without cover through the early to middle stages before improving forward to sit outside the leader passing the 1000 metres.

NOMEN LUDI (K Williams) - When asked to comment on the apparent improved performance Trainer E Winsloe advised the gelding had been taken on when leading in the New Zealand Cup in its previous start, had appreciated the drop back in distance today and was aided by a heady ride from a senior rider.

MR INTELLIGENCE (J Lowry) - When asked to comment on the performance rider advised that his mount had battled on fairly over the concluding stages but carrying the top weight of 62 kgs had taken its toll on the gelding over the concluding stages.

Race 8	NIGEL ROBERTSON BUILDING HANDICAP (1600m)
<p>OLAF (D Bothamley) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>FULL FURY (S Khetoo) - Restrained to the rear on jumping from its wide barrier. Rider dropped his whip passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>T Moseley (DIRECT FLIGHT) - Issued with a warning for using his whip on consecutive strides over the concluding stages.</p>	
Race 9	THE EDGE HANDICAP (1600m)
<p>GLAMOUR (B May) - Proved difficult to load. Slow to begin.</p> <p>CHEYENNE DREAMS (T Moseley) - Slow to begin. When asked to comment on the performance rider advised the mare had been flat throughout and proved disappointing. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormality. Stewards will follow up the recovery of the mare with Trainer S McKay in the coming days.</p> <p>CLASSIC DIVA (S Khetoo) - Slow to begin and was crowded shortly after the start when runners either side shifted ground. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running through the middle stages of the run home.</p> <p>REDFORD (Y Atchamah) - Restrained to take cover in the early stages and was hampered shortly afterwards when outside runners shifted in. Raced wide from the 1100 metres.</p> <p>PONIARD (K Chowdhoo) - Improved wide rounding the final bend. Shifted ground inwards over the concluding stages having to be straightened.</p> <p>DARCEE QUE (T Comignaghi) - Shifted up the track in the run home briefly crowding outside runners.</p> <p>FAIRWAY FLIGHT (R Mudhoo) - Steadied away from the heels of GLAMOUR (B May) which shifted in marginally passing the 100 metres. B May was advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p>PROWLER (C Campbell) - Briefly steadied near the 50 metres when PONIARD (K Chowdhoo) shifted in under pressure. K Chowdhoo was advised to exercise greater care.</p>
