Race 4 RETURN TO EARTH MDN 1200M

LOIS LANE (L Douglas) – Slow to begin.

JUST EVENS (S O'Malley) – Crowded at the start.

POLLY PLUM (J Kamaruddin) – Began awkwardly.

ERIDOR (J Parkes) – Raced wide into the first turn.

OUR TALITHA (L Allpress) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Checked on the point of the home turn when STEVIE NIX (D Johnson) improved to the inside of ERIDOR (J Parkes) shifting that runner out across the heels of OUR TALITHA. Also affected was DIGGER (D Danis). When question J Parkes advised that his mount was tiring and had gone back on to OUR TALITHA. Stewards took no further action other than to remind D Johnson of her obligations when shifting ground. D Danis advised that his mount was racing greenly and over reacted when forced out.

MORE PZAZZ (J Mudhoo) – Was hampered passing the 200 metres when GREEN MACHINE hung outwards into its line.

S O'MALLEY the rider of JUST EVENS was reminded of his obligations regarding his use of the whip on a runner out of contention.

Race 5 WHITAKER CIVIL CONSTRUCTION 1200M

QUATORZE (C O'Beirne) - Crowded at the start.

IFNDOUBTGETOUT (J Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly.

ANJARDEN (D Danis) – Crowded at the start. Over reacted when steadied near the 800 metres. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in one nostril. Following a veterinary examination ANJARDEN was confirmed to have bled. ANJARDEN shall not be ridden in exercise for a period of two months or start in any Race or Trial for a period of three months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Veterinarian.

DANGER STRYKES (R Elliot) – Knuckled at the start. When questioned into performance rider could offer no excuse.

GURTLYN (J Kamaruddin) – Over reacted when steadied near the 800 metres.

CHAJABA (S O'Malley) – Unable to gain clear running throughout the run home and went to the line not fully tested.

Race 6 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1400M

GINGER SNAPZ (J Kamaruddin) – Slow to begin.

OPAL SPIRIT (J Parkes) – Began awkwardly. After finishing a distant last, OPAL SPIRIT underwent a post race veterinary examination which was clear. Connections were advised a warning would be placed against the mare with regard to its competitiveness.

STAR OF AUSTRALIS (L Allpress) – Bumped becoming unbalanced near 200 metres and contacted again near the finish.

CHAMPAGNES ON ME (T Newman) – Shifted in near the 200 metres and bumped STAR OF AUSTRALIS unbalancing that runner and shifted in again near the finish making further contact with STAR OF AUSTRALIS.

Race 7 THE TARANAKI DAILY NEWS MDN 1400M

ANOTHER BELLA (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin. Had to be angled wide approaching the 200 metres to improve.

LEON ROUGE (J Parkes) - Restrained at the start from its wide barrier.

TENNESSEE ROSE (D Danis) – Restrained at the start from its wide barrier.

SHINING PEAK (M McNab) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

ABOVE THE CLOUDS (T Newman) – Raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages. Hampered passing the 200 metres.

CONTEMPLATION (C Grylls) – Over raced passing the 1100 metres when being restrained to find cover.

JUST BEN (S O'Malley) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Shifted in under pressure in the home straight hampering ABOVE THE CLOUDS.

Race 8LANDMARK HOMES 1400MNEVERSTOPLAUGHING (J Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.

LADY KARTEL (H Schofer) – Raced keenly in the middle stages when the paced eased.

GALWAY BRO (K Asano) - Was steadied passing the 800 metres when the pace eased.

HINEPARA (L Allpress) – Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

THOMAS AQUINAS (S Macnab) – Three wide without cover throughout.

Race 9 RACING AGAIN DEC 27TH 1600M

THE FEARLESS ONE (J Parkes) – Slow to begin. Held up rounding the home turn.

CISJURANE (M Sanson) – Slow to begin.

BIG BEN (L Allpress) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

HIGH FREQUENCY (S MacNab) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

EZDARA (R Beemud) – Lay in under pressure in the straight. Had to steady off heels passing the 200 metres.

MIDNIGHT SPARK (L Hemi) - Raced in restricted room passing the 200 metres.

TAUPARAE (C Grylls) – When questioned into the performance rider had no tangible excuse other than the mare was agitated prior to the race. C Grylls added that TAUPARAE pulled up in a normal post race condition.

CLEESE (J Kamaruddin) – Hampered passing the 200 metres and directed wider when MIDSNIIGHT SPARK was angled outwards.

LADY MAK (D Danis) – Had difficulty obtaining a run until 100 metres.

C DELL (INDY FOX) – Reminded of his obligations regarding his use of the whip on a runner out of contention.
