Trainer K Buttimore will be spoken to by the RIB regarding the matter.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 | SADDLE & SULKY MOTEL MAIDEN 2000M

THE RATTLIN' BOG (M Hudson) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Lay inwards under pressure in the home straight.

RONIN POROTENE (C O'Beirne) – Began awkwardly.

BLUE RATA QUEEN (L Hemi) – Tightened at the start when runners either side shifted ground. Rider was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground passing the 400 metres.

KAZADEROSE (L Douglas) – Held up on the final bend.

SHEZ SUPER (L Allpress) – When questioned into performance L Allpress advised that the mare was not suited by today's track conditions. Underwent a post race veterinary examination which revealed an elevated heart rate and soreness in both forelegs.

Race 2 | THE TARANAKI DAILY NEWS 1200

OWEN MOORE (M Sanson) – Began awkwardly.

SCOTCH (L Allpress) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 3 | LIQUOR KING MAIDEN 1200M

TRIGGER HAPPY (K Hercock) – Began awkwardly settling at the rear. Raced greenly in the home straight and had to be steadied off heels passing the 100 metres.

ONCE BITTEN (M Sanson) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

SHE'S PATSY (C O'Beirne) – Over raced early to middle stages having to be restrained off heels passing the 800 metres. Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

CYA MARIA (H Schofer) – Held up rounding the final turn.

Race 4 | RETURN TO EARTH 3YO MAIDEN 1400M

JAMAICAN EXPRESS (L Douglas) – Slow away. Over raced passing the 600 metres.

COM SI COM SA (C O'Beirne) – Restrained to the rear from its wide draw.

LOSTCAUSE (K Hercock) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Bumped with SAVASILK passing the 300 metres.

THIRD TIME ROUND (L Hemi) – Had to be restrained off heels passing the 700 metres.

FOOTLOOSE (N Parmar) – Raced greenly in the home straight.

SAVASILK (J Kamaruddin) – Bumped with LOSTCAUSE passing the 300 metres.

FABLUE (L Allpress) – Had to be steadied near the 200 metres when RABONA shifted inwards. L Allpress reported that the filly raced greenly throughout.

B Grylls (RABONA) – Issued with a warning when allowing her mount to shift inwards when insufficiently clear of FABLUE near the 200 metres.

Race 5 | **PETER SOLE TRANSPORT 1400**

ALL IN ECHOES (L Hemi) – Began awkwardly then refused to hit out and took no effective part. As this was the second occasion the filly had refused to jump away connections were advised that the filly was required to trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards multiple times prior to next racing.

REIGN IT IN (L Allpress) – Slow away. Over raced passing the 800 metres.

OUR FAIR TRADE (J Kamaruddin) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

ODYSSEUS (L Douglas) – Over raced for a distance through the back straight.

JUSTFIXIT WULDYA (H Schofer) – Held up through the early stages of the home straight.

CHAJABA (S O'Malley) – Over raced passing the 800 metres.

Race 6 | **24/7 SECURITY 2000**

There was a two minute delay to the start at the request of Race Day Control.

LORD SPENCER (L Douglas) – Raced wide for the majority of the event.

NOD (K Asano) – Had to be restrained off heels passing the 1400 metres. Had to be restrained off heels passing the 600 metres.

LADY CALYPSO (K Hercock) – Dictated inwards by EL FIESTA GIRL (C Grylls) shortly after the start inconveniencing MR GERONIMO. Over raced passing the 900 metres.

MR GERONIMO (A Mudhoo) – Inconvenienced shortly after the start and had to be steadied off heels as a result.

C Grylls (EL FIESTA GIRL) – Issued with a warning when shifting ground when insufficiently clear shortly after the start.

Race 7 | **HASSALL HOMES CITY OF NEW PLYMOUTH CUP 1800**

BARNEY RUBBLE (L Douglas) – Slow away.

UP 'N' GONE (B Grylls) – Made the first bend awkwardly. Dictated wide on the home turn.

LORD ESPERANZA (F Lazet) - Over raced in the early stages when being restrained to take cover, continued to over race for a distance thereafter.

ALHAMBRA LAD (D Turner) – Over raced briefly passing the 900 metres.

TAKE A GAMBLE (M Hudson) – raced wide for the majority of the event.

HINEPARA (L Allpress) – Checked when tiring approaching the home turn and was not persevered with. After questioning riders and viewing available films, footage proved inconclusive and no further action was taken. Finished a distant last. A post race veterinary examination was clear.

ATARANGI (J Kamaruddin) – Dictated wide on the home turn.

Race 8	POWERWORX TARANAKI CUP FEB 5TH MAIDEN 1600M
THEMOONSTOODSTILL (B Grylls) – Began awkwardly settling at the rear.	
ZUMA ROCK (F Lazet) – Shifted outwards under pressure approaching the 100 metres simultaneously as IT’S MARGO shifting inwards, resulting in tightening to CRY BABY and THE PROPHET SPEAKS. F Lazet was advised that she is expected to straighten her mount sooner than she did on this occasion.	
C Burdan MAKADOON – Advised the stewards that the mare may have been lame on pulling up. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.
