GENERAL

ROSEWOOD was declared a late scratching at 08.45am on veterinary advice.

RACE 5 - NORWOOD FARM MACHINERY HAWERA MAIDEN 1600 METRES

MIDNIGHT SPARK (L Hemi) - Had to be restrained near the 800 metres when SWIFT (E Nicholas) shifted in when not fully clear. After questioning riders L Hemi advised that her mount had overreacted when being steadied, nevertheless E Nicholas was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

RACE COMMENTS				
Race 1	JUBEE AND CO MAIDEN 2YO (800 m)			
INTENT (L Allpress	s) - Began awkwardly and was slow away. Raced greenly in the home straight.			

KAHMA SUITSYA (E Nicholas) - Was slow into stride.

MISS LILLY (C O'Beirne) - Raced greenly throughout and finished some distance last. C O'Beirne advised that in her opinion the filly was shin sore. A subsequent veterinary examination confirmed MISS LILLY to be shin sore.

GIBRALTAR RISING (W Pinn) - Made the corner awkwardly and ran very wide. Connections were advised that a warning is placed on GIBRALTAR RISINGS racing manners.

RUBY SEEKER (S Macnab) - Ran very wide on the turn. Connections were advised that a warning is placed on RUBY SEEKERS racing manners.

Race 2 WHANGANUI CHRONICLE (1340 m)

BLUE VEIN (S Macnab) - Raced three-wide throughout.

NOD OF THE HEAD (K Asano) - Began awkwardly and shifted out.

HOOKS (S McKay) - Disappointed finishing well back. S McKay advised the gelding is better suited to a more rain effected footing. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

NOD OF THE HEAD (K Asano) - Shifted out under pressure passing the 300 metres hampering DUBAI'S MOKO. K Asano was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground.

VENATO (E Leighton) - Was held up and unable to improve until the 150 metres.

MOZZIE (L Hemi) - Hampered on the point of the home turn when LOVE STORM (T Taiaroa) shifted out. T Taiaroa was shown footage in the presence of the Riding Master and advised to exercise greater care.

Following the running of Race 2 the track was upgraded to Slow 8.

Race 3 DAVE HOSKIN CARRIERS (1600 m)

ZORRALI (L Kauri) - L Kauri was spoken to with regard to his use of the whip on a runner out of contention.

KOXINGA (K Hercock) - Rider was dislodged in the birdcage resulting in her being checked by the ambulance staff and cleared to continue riding. K Hercock was spoken to with regard to her use of the whip on a runner out of contention.

FAR SITE (C Jones) - Held up from near the 200 metres and received an interrupted run in the home straight having to change ground inwards over the final stages to improve.

YOLO (T Taiaroa) - Was held up rounding the turn and then had to be steadied when attempting a narrow run around the 300 metres.

Race 4 THE O'LEARYS FILLIES STAKES (1200 m)

SHEJENGAR (C O'Beirne) - Was removed from the barriers and cleared to run by the veterinary surgeon after charging its gate.

QUEEN OF SPADES (H Schofer) – Began awkwardly bumping PERFECTSISTER.

PERFECTSISTER (M Hudson) - Bumped at the start in turn tightening INVIALO. Raced greenly in the home straight and was inclined to lay inwards.

HILLABY (D Bradley) - Slow away (3L). Shifted in under pressure over the final stages and bumped with QUEEN OF SPADES.

INVIALO (B Rogerson) - Tightened at the start and got back.

THERE YOU GO (K Asano) - Held up for some distance rounding the home turn.

Race 5 TAKE IT EASY TOURS HANDICAP (1340 m)

WILLIAM WALLACE (D Hirini) - Slow away.

COMMUNIQUE (B Grylls) - Made the first turn awkwardly.

CROWNING STAR (L Allpress) - L Allpress reported the mare raced in a fresh state and would improve with the run.

C JONES (Diogenes) - Was cautioned regarding the use of his whip on a runner out of contention.

Race 6HS DYKE WANGANUI GUINEAS (1340 m)DREADLOCK HOLIDAY (C O'Beirne) - Slow away.

WHISKEY (W Pinn) - Which drew the inside barrier shifted out abruptly at the start crowding NEST EGG, SHA CARRI, TREASURE STATE, PRINCESS BIDDY and YEABOI which were all dictated wide on the track.

TREASURE STATE (K Asano) - Rider dropped whip 250 metres. When questioned K Asano advised the gelding could not quicken when asked to do so in the home straight. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 7 FREDRIK PAUL WESTBY MEMORIAL HANDICAP (2040 m)

AKELA BELLE (L Hemi) - Underwent a veterinary examination behind the barrier after L Hemi considered something amiss in the preliminary. AKELA BELLE failed a veterinary inspection after mild lameness was detected and was declared a late scratching at 2.48pm.

MAKZABEEL (K Asano) Slow away. When questioned K Asano advised the gelding was unsuited to the slow pace of today's race.

GORBACHEV (S McKay) – Began awkwardly.

FLORAL ART (S Macnab) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

Race 8 ST JOHNS CLUB (2040 m)

BRUCIE (S McKay) - Over-raced early and had to be steadied.

PRINCE LEO (D Bradley) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

KAHU ROCK (J Mudhoo) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages and near the 1600 metres was hampered and had to be heavily restrained when improving into a very marginal run to the inside of WAIAGARA. KAHU ROCK continued to over-race for some distance and when questioned into the gelding's performance, J Mudhoo advised that KAHU ROCK had little left to finish after over-racing in the early to middle stages.

TIRO (L Allpress) - Lay inwards in the home straight.
