Race 5 – QUIGLEY CONTRACTING MAIDEN 2200m

MAN OH MAN - Trainer P Corbett advised that the gelding had subsequently been euthanised on welfare grounds due to the extent of its injury.

Race 8 – RYAL BUSH TRANSPORT 1200m

ADANNAYA – Trainer L Robinson advised that following blood tests the mare was found to be suffering from a bacterial infection of the liver receiving the appropriate veterinary treatment, and would be given a brief spell.

Race 9 – GO RACING WITH GO RACING 1200m

CURVE - Co-trainer Michael Pitman advised he was satisfied with the post-race condition of the gelding, adding that CURVE had previously disappointed when racing at that venue. Mr Pitman further advised he would be making gear changes prior to its next start.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 | A TEAM CONSTRUCTION 2100m

QUEEN SWEEP (M Gestain) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

POINT SCORE (K Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Over raced in the early stages getting its head up on a number of occasions.

STANDREWS MASONIC (T Moseley) - Placed in restricted room passing the 900 metres when ORIGINAL GANGSTER lay in on the point of the turn with STANDREWS MASONIC going back onto EL GLADIADOR.

EL GLADIADOR (R Mudhoo) - Made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly having to be steadied to avoid the heels of STANDREWS MASONIC. Held up approaching the final straight.

R Mudhoo (EL GLADIADOR) - Spoken to in the presence of the riding mentor regarding his riding style in the final straight.

Race 2 | HAPPY BIRTHDAY GONZO MAIDEN 1400m

BAILADOR (Z Bholah) - Slow to begin. Hampered near the 100 metres when AINE BEAG was taken in by CRI DE COEUR.

CRI DE COEUR (C Campbell) - Over raced in the early stages having to be shifted outwards to avoid heels passing the 1200 metres and in doing so hampered ENOUGH SAID. Obligated to race wide for the remainder of the race. Was inclined to shift ground under pressure in the straight hampering AINE BEAG near the 250 metres. C Campbell was advised to exercise greater care.

ENOUGH SAID (L Callaway) - Hampered 1200 metres.

SORISSO (T Comignaghi) - Placed in restricted room near the 900 metres having to be checked when BURNVUE shifted inwards.

CAPTAIN (T Moseley) - Hampered near the 900 metres. Raced three wide without cover. Hung inwards in the straight.

AINE BEAG (K Kwo) - Hampered near the 250 metres.

NO DANCING TODAY (S Toolooa) – Trainer M McCann subsequently reported that the mare had suffered a suspensory injury and had been retired.

R Cuneen (BURNVUE) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of SORISSO which was checked near the 900 metres, with CAPTAIN being hampered as a result. After hearing submissions, the Judicial Committee suspended R Cuneen’s licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Friday 10 September until the conclusion of racing on Sunday 19 September, 6 national riding days.

LENNON (K Chowdhoo) - Became very fractious in its barrier prior to the start.

COFFERS (T Comignaghi) - Slow to begin.

PEGASUS POWER (M Taylor) - Slow to begin. Raced three wide without cover throughout. Became awkwardly placed near heels racing into the bend near the 900 metres having to shift outwards abruptly losing ground and hampering CAVALRYMAN.

CAVALRYMAN (L Callaway) - Hampered at the start. Hampered again near the 900 metres losing ground.

LACHIE'S MATE (S Toolooa) - Began awkwardly losing some ground.

TANTALEE (R Mudhoo) - Shifted inwards abruptly after the start crowding and hampering CAVALRYMAN and PERIA'S LEGACY.

PERIA'S LEGACY (J Laking) - Bumped shortly after the start when TANTALEE shifted in abruptly crowding and hampering CAVALRYMAN which was taken in onto TANTALEE.

UN AGENDA (T Jonker) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

S Toolooa (LACHIE'S MATE) - Reprimanded for his use of a whip on a runner out of contention.

Race 4	MOUNT SOMERS HONEY 1200m

LUX CUM AMORE (M Taylor) - Proved difficult to load delaying the start. The connections were advised the gelding was under a barrier manners' warning. Began awkwardly then further hampered losing ground when BUOYANT shifted inwards abruptly at the start.

BUOYANT (R Mudhoo) - Proved difficult to load. Raced wide without cover from the 800 metres.

ART DE TRIOMPHE (K Williams) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

EMANON (T Moseley) - Raced greenly in the early stages and near the 900 metres shifted inwards placing VICTOR ROUGE in restricted room for a short distance.

VICTOR ROUGE (K Kwo) - Placed in restricted room for a short distance near the 900 metres.

NO BOUQUET (K Mudhoo) - Hampered near the 250 metres when MACKENZIE LAD (K Chowdhoo) shifted inwards when struck with the whip. K Chowdhoo was advised to exercise greater care.

Race 5	PRYDE'S EASIFEED 1200m

GLORIOUS OCEAN (K Chowdhoo) - Bounded at the start and slow to begin.

BRONTE BEACH (K Williams) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover.

GLORY CHANCE (S Toolooa) - Raced three wide without cover through the early and middle stages.

BENAUD (M Gestain) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

DREAMING EASY (T Jonker) - Inconvenienced near the 200 metres when GLORIOUS OCEAN shifted outwards.

Trainer **J Richards** - Issued with a warning after his two runners SUPREME KHAN and SECRET AMOUR were late being presented into the parade ring.

Race 6 | **SOUTH ISLAND SEED DRESSING 2100m**

VENETO (M Taylor) – Began very awkwardly losing considerable ground (8 lengths). Apprentice M Taylor was shown footage of the start in the presence of the riding mentor and a warning placed against VENETO for its barrier manners.

SHAZ THE BANK (S Toolooa) - Raced wide without cover through the early stages.

YEAH RIGHT (T Moseley) - Held up early in the straight until angling out across heels near the 250 metres.

TOP GUY (K Williams) - Lay in under pressure in the final 100 metres having to be straightened by its rider.

T Moseley (YEAH RIGHT) - Issued with a warning after angling his mount outwards when not sufficiently clear of SUPER TAP which had to be briefly steadied near the 250 metres.

Race 7 | **SIMS BAKERY, CAKES FOR EVERY OCCASION 1200m**

ROCANTO (M Gestain) - Slow to begin. When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse but was of the opinion the gelding would derive benefit from today's race.

OUR GIRL GILLY (W Papier) - Jumped away awkwardly.

EL BEE DARCI (T Comignaghi) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

MISS TYCOON ROSE (K Chowdhoo) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home before shifting outwards across heels near the 300 metres to obtain clear racing room.

Race 8 | **MATT SMITH CONSTRUCTION THANK YOU 1200m**

The start was delayed when several runners proved difficult to load, particularly JAMIESON'S TIPPLE.

JAMIESON'S TIPPLE (T Jonker) - The connections were advised that the gelding was on a barrier manners warning. Lay out throughout the race.

SELFIE (K Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

MAKABAR (K Chowdhoo) - Began awkwardly.

VINO BELLA (S Toolooa) - Began awkwardly.

CAN'T SAY ENOUGH (R Cuneen) - Blundered on jumping. Raced three wide without cover throughout. Lay in under pressure in the straight, having to be steadied away from the heels of JAMIESON'S TIPPLE near the 200 metres.

T Jonker (JAMIESON'S TIPPLE) - Reprimanded for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

C Campbell (MADAM SEQUOIA) - Reprimanded for his use of the whip on a runner out of contention.

Race 9 | **GARY MCCORMICK BIN HIRE 1600m**

GOODANYA (K Chowdhoo) - Began awkwardly, got its head up on a number of occasions through the early stages on a slow tempo when being steadied to take a trailing position.

THE GROWLER (S Toolooa) - Over raced in the early and middle stages on a slow tempo. When questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion the gelding is better suited by some easing of the ground.

RITANI (M Gestain) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

TAPPY'S ONE (J Laking) - Lay in throughout the straight. Lost the left hind plate passing the 400 metres.

FRANKIE THE FOX (R Mudhoo) - Rider was struck by the detached plate near the 350 metres.

Race 10

MOLLOY AGRICULTURE LTD 1400m

HARLEEN QUINZEL (M Taylor) - Slow to begin.

SHOCK PROSPECT (S Toolooa) - Began awkwardly losing some ground.

MISS CURIOUS (C Campbell) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

SANTISSIMA (M Gestain) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

JIN LU (T Moseley) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

ZAKUNDA (T Comignaghi) - Hung in throughout the straight.
