S Phelan and N Downs contacted Stewards on the morning of the races advising they were unwell and would not be attending today's meeting. Both riders are required to provide a medical clearance to Stewards prior to riding next.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 TE AROHA JOCKEY CLUB MAIDEN HURDLE 3100 metres

RITESAIDZED (B Lammas) - Slow to begin. Put in a poor jump at the final fence. Rider lost his left iron for a short distance after jumping the fence near the 1100 metres.

MASTER PAINTON (M Roustoby) – Began awkwardly. Hampered jumping the first fence. Raced keenly when being steadied in the early stages.

LIZZED (D Parker) – Slow to begin. Hit the second to last fence.

MATARO (S Fannin) - Slow to begin.

ENGLISH GAMBLER (J Seivwright) - Ran the first fence down and shifted inwards abruptly crowding TWEEDLEDEE onto MASTER PAINTON. Also hampered as a result was AMAZING AZ. Raced keenly when being steadied in the early stages. Misjudged the fence near the 400 metres.

TWEEDLEDEE (M Cropp) – Badly crowded jumping the first fence losing ground as a result. Misjudged the final fence.

AMAZING AZ (E Farr) - Hampered jumping the first fence.

WEST COAST (T Moki) - Hit the second to last fence.

BLACK EYED SUE (L Douglas) – Misjudged the final fence.

S Karnicnik (WHEREABOUTS) - Reprimanded with regards to his whip use on a runner out of contention.

Race 2 TAJC HOSPITALITY MAIDEN HURDLE 3100 metres

IZYMYDAAD (B Lammas) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Restrained in the early stages. Hit the third to last fence.

MASTER FIN (T Moki) - Slow to begin. Jumped indifferently throughout. Pulled up prior to jumping the final three fences. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding had been unsuited by today's track conditions. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormality.

CURIOUS GEORGE (S Fannin) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

MAKE A MOVE (L Douglas) - Began awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages when being restrained. Blundered after jumping the fence near the 1000 metres. Pulled up prior to jumping the final three fences. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which confirmed the gelding to have bled. MAKE A MOVE is now subject to a two month stand down from training and a three month stand down from racing with an additional veterinary certificate of fitness required prior to racing or trialling next.

SLY BALJO (K Joyce) - Hit the third to last fence and blundered on landing hampering the trailing VANGUARD. Misjudged the second to last fence.

VANGUARD (D Parker) – Hampered after jumping the third to last fence.

ZION HILL (E Farr) – Received veterinary attention post-race for a laceration to the right fore pastern.

Race 3 MIKE FRASER-JONES OPEN HURDLE 3100 metres

MIZZENA (S Fannin) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the mare would be better suited to some easing in the ground.

BEAU GESTE (D Parker) - Hit the fourth fence.

BANKS ROAD (M Roustoby) - Misjudged the fence near the 1000 metres and fell dislodging its rider. M Roustoby was attended to by the oncourse Doctor and stood down from his remaining ride. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a laceration to the right fore knee and in both nostrils.

Race 4 THANK YOU CLUB VOLUNTEERS MAIDEN STEEPLECHASE 3500 metres

The field was directed along the course proper on the second occasion racing down the back straight due to the fallen rider having not been removed from the track within sufficient time.

MY TOMMY (L Douglas) - Slow to begin.

KIDDO (S Fannin) - Slow to begin. Hampered by the fallen rider after jumping the third fence.

DONARDO (S Karnicnik) - Slow to begin.

ZINZAN (B Lammas) - Began awkwardly. Hampered jumping the second fence. Put in a poor jump at the fifth fence. Pulled up prior to jumping the final three fences. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding may have got its tongue over the bit during the running. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

LA JUNGLES (T Moki) - Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a right fore tendon injury. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.

ZEDACE (G Walsh) - Hampered jumping the second fence when improving onto heels.

THE ROLLING STONE (D Parker) - Steadied when placed in restricted room prior to jumping the third fence. Hampered by the fallen rider after jumping the third fence.

SINO HEIGHTS (K Joyce) - Misjudged the third fence dislodging its rider. K Joyce was attended to by the oncourse Doctor and stood down from her remaining ride.

ZEDACE (G Walsh) – Crowded after jumping the first fence.

DELEGATE (J Seivwright) - Hampered by the fallen rider after jumping the third fence.

Race 5 BAYLEYS OPEN STEEPLECHASE 3500 metres

KIPKEINO (E Farr) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Put in a poor jump at the final fence.

ARGYLL (D Parker) - Began awkwardly. Put in a poor jump at the first fence. Knuckled after jumping the second to last fence.

DAL KILCHOAN (T Moki) - Misjudged the sixth fence.

NO TIP (C Thornton) - Misjudged the seventh fence.

Race 6 BECOME A TE AROHA MEMBER 1600 metres

DAYTONA RED (D Danis) – Slow to begin. Improved onto heels having to be steadied passing the 600 metres. Held up approaching the 200 metres having to shift inwards to obtain clear running. Improved onto heels just prior to the winning post.

MAJOR TOM (J Fawcett) - Slow to begin.

BATTLE TIME (S Spratt) - Commenced to over-race for a distance passing the 1400 metres.

BEAUDEN (R Elliot) - Held up early in the final straight having to shift out to obtain clear running.

TIMBERLAKE (A Goindasamy) - When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding had been unsuited by today's track conditions.

J Fawcett (MAJOR TOM) - Spoken to regarding her whip use on a runner out of contention.

Race 7 TE AROHA STALLION SERVICE SCHEME 1600 metres

ZEEFA ZED (J Riddell) - Slow to begin.

NASHA RIVA (M Cameron) - Slow to begin. Briefly held up entering the final straight.

CHILLAX (R Elliot) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

LORD POLONIUS (S Collett) - Slow to begin. Held up rounding the final bend and early in the straight then improved onto heels passing the 100 metres having to be steadied.

DELUXE EDITION (T Newman) - Hampered shortly after the start losing ground.

JODELIN GAL (L Satherley) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

TURRET (E Leighton) – Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which confirmed the mare to have bled. TURRET is now subject to a two month stand down from training and a three month stand down from racing with an additional veterinary certificate of fitness required prior to racing or trialling next.

E Leighton (TURRET) - Defended a charge in that she used her whip excessively prior to the 100 metres. After hearing submissions, the Adjudicative Committee found the charge proven and suspended E Leighton's licence to ride in races

from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 11 September up to and including racing on Sunday 19 September, 5 national riding days.

Race 8 THANK YOU TE AROHA STAFF 2200 metres

ELLE D'BERRY (T Yanagida) - Began awkwardly.

RODMAR (E Nicholas) - Began awkwardly then knuckled losing ground. Improved forward to race three wide without cover from near the 1200 metres.

ALFIE DEE (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Made the first bend awkwardly when racing keenly.

FORTUNE WINGS (A Goindasamy) - Began awkwardly.

RICHARD OF YORKE (N Parmar) – Began awkwardly.

OUR CRAFTSMAN (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin.

ECHO BAY (R Elliot) - Raced three wide without cover until near the 1200 metres.

SHOCKING BILL (T Thornton) - Held up rounding the final bend before shifting outwards passing the 400 metres to obtain clear running.

PIGGY MALONE (D Danis) - When questioned regarding the improved performance Trainer D Waddell advised that the gelding had received an unfavourable run at its most recent start, adding that the addition of blinkers had benefitted the gelding.

N Parmar (RICHARD OF YORKE) - Reprimanded for his whip use on a runner out of contention.

Race 9 TE AROHA SUPPORTERS CLUB 1400 metres

NOTABADPHELAN (T Harris) - Slow to begin. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that in his opinion the gelding would be better suited to more rain affected footing.

FINEST WINE (D Johnson) - Restrained behind runners shortly after the start. Held up early in the final straight before shifting out approaching the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

GAGLIARDI (T Thornton) - Began awkwardly. Raced wide without cover throughout.

EDGE OF WONDER (R Elliot) - Restrained behind runners shortly after the start. Inconvenienced approaching the 400 metres by FINEST WINE which shifted in slightly. Contributing was EDGE OF WONDER laying out when rounding the bend. Improved onto heels approaching the 150 metres and was unable to obtain clear running for the remainder of the race.

BELTOY (B Rogerson) - Over-raced when being restrained passing the 1000 metres.

COVENANT (T Newman) – Raced four wide without cover throughout the race.

GLOBAL CURRENCY (M McNab) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

GNASHER (E Leighton) - Inconvenienced after becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 400 metres.

ATOMIC KITTEN (C Grylls) – Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which deemed the mare to have bled. ATOMIC KITTEN is now ineligible to race in New Zealand as this was its second attack of nasal bleeding.

W Pinn (INCA WARRIOR) - Reprimanded for using his whip on a runner in consecutive strides.
