Race 1	VESPA 1200
RIVER RUN (M McNab) - Hampered shortly after the start losing ground. Held up throughout the final straight.	
FINAL SUGGESTION (L Satherley) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Lay in entering the final straight.	
BARBARA (S Spratt) - Began awkwardly.	
TWO MADISON (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin.	
RENEGADE FIGHTER (E McCall) - Slow to begin.	
COLIN OSCOPY (A Goindasamy) - Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of HAIL DAMAGE (D Johnson) which shifted in and away from BARBARA approaching the 100 metres. D Johnson was advised to exercise care when in a similar circumstance.	

Race 2	SAVIL ROW 2100
MIDNITE INVASION (M Cameron) - Began awkwardly losing ground.	
C'EST UNE STAR (L Satherley) - Began awkwardly. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that in her opinion a drop in distance would benefit the mare.	
CERYS (T Yanagida) - Slow to begin. Improved onto the heels of TOUCH THE CLOUDS (A Goindasamy) which shifted outwards under pressure approaching the 100 metres then shifted out making contact with LANDGRAVE which was slightly unbalanced. A Goindasamy was advised to exercise care.	
RISING RANSOM (E McCall) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.	
TOUCH THE CLOUDS (A Goindasamy) - Raced keenly in the early to middle stages.	
LA STRATA (T Newman) - Lost the right front plate during the running.	
PIPING HOT (T Harris) - Raced keenly when the pace steadied passing the 800 metres.	
N Parmar (SHEBRINGSMERUBIES) - Spoken to him regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.	
L Satherley (C'EST UNE STAR) - Reprimanded for her whip use on a runner out of contention.	

Race 3	NZB READY TO RUN SALE TRAINERS SERIES 3YO #1 (1200 metres)
SHAMBLES (S Spratt) - Slow to begin.	
GREAT PLAINS (B May) - Slow to begin. Improved onto heels passing the 300 metres having to be steadied before shifting outwards to improve.	

DRUM MAJOR (R Elliot) - Improved onto heels passing the 100 metres having to shift outwards to improve.

VOLARE (A Goindasamy) - Shifted out when placed in restricted room making contact with FONSALETTE having to be steadied passing the 50 metres.

FONSALETTE (D Johnson) - Crowded to the inside of CHANEL which shifted in and outside of VOLARE which shifted out resulting in FONSALETTE having to be steadied passing the 50 metres.

ZAZZLE (C Barnes) - Raced keenly in the early stages then had to be steadied off heels rounding the bend near the 800 metres and ran wide.

CHANEL (M McNab) - Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

M McNab (CHANEL) - Issued with a warning for permitting his mount to shift in passing the 50 metres when not sufficiently clear of FONSALETTE which was crowded and VOLARE which had to be steadied when placed in restricted room. When assessing the incident, Stewards took into account the outward movement of VOLARE.

Race 4

NZB READY TO RUN SALE TRAINERS SERIES 3YO #2 (1200 metres)

GLORY BOUND (C Grylls) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Raced greenly in the final straight having a tendency to lay in when placed under pressure.

MR RAFIKI (S Collett) - Began awkwardly. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding would benefit from some easing in the ground. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

THE PERFECT PINK (M McNab) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

HOARD THE BOURBON (D Johnson) - Restrained behind runners shortly after the start.

MEDAL (M Cameron) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Contacted GLORY BOUND when both runners shifted ground slightly passing the 200 metres.

Race 5

CAMBRIDGE STUD NORTHLAND BREEDERS' STAKES (G3) 1200

IMPERATRIZ (D Johnson) - Began awkwardly.

I WISH I WIN (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly briefly unbalancing its rider.

DOUBTFUL SOUND (M McNab) - Restrained behind runners shortly after the start. Over raced in the early stages.

MAGNETO (R Elliot) - Restrained behind runners shortly after the start.

BELDARRA (S Collett) - Underwent a post race veterinary examination which included an endoscopy examination which revealed no abnormalities.

R Elliot (MAGNETO) – Issued with a charge for using his whip on more than five times prior to the 100 metres. After hearing submissions, the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension on R Elliot's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 5th September up to and including racing on Wednesday 15th September 5 National days and imposing a \$200 fine.

Race 6	VALACHI DOWNS SELLING ONLY AT KARAKA 2022 MILE (1600 metres)
<p>TAVIROCK (R Elliot) - Slow to begin. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until early in the final straight. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that in his opinion the entire would benefit from some easing in the ground.</p> <p>SON OF SASANOF (S Spratt) - Hampered shortly after the start losing ground. Had difficulty obtaining clear running throughout the final straight.</p> <p>MUSE (S Weatherley) - Slow to begin. Held up entering the final straight having to shift outwards to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>AFITUSI (L Satherley) - Commended to race ungenerously passing the 1400 metres and continued to do so through the middle stages.</p> <p>MISS BEAUJOLAIS (T Thornton) - Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed superficial wounds to the right hind pastern.</p> <p>CAPTAIN OUMUAMUA (J Riddell) - Improved onto heels having to be briefly steadied passing the 100 metres.</p> <p>FUNNY GAME (M Cameron) - Travelled three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>ARANCIA (C Grylls) - Travelled wide without cover throughout.</p>	
Race 7	FAREWELL AND THANK YOU MICHAEL O'TOOLE MILE (1600 metres)
<p>MIANJO (S Collett) - Began awkwardly then crowded losing ground.</p> <p>NITRATE (E McCall) - Restrained behind runners shortly after the start. Raced keenly for a distance approaching the 800 metres.</p> <p>LADIES MAN (D Johnson) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the final straight. When questioned regarding performance, the rider advised that in her opinion the gelding would benefit from a step up in distance and improved track conditions.</p> <p>FLAVIUS (J Riddell) - Held up until shifting out passing the 350 metres.</p> <p>BOUFFANT (V Colgan) - When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no excuses.</p> <p>DANCE 'N' SING (M Cameron) - When questioned regarding performance, the rider advised that in his opinion the mare would benefit from some easing in the ground. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormality.</p>	
Race 8	VALACHI DOWNS FOXBRIDGE PLATE (G2) 1200
<p>HIFLYER (S Collett) - Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>MORE WONDER (C Grylls) - Hampered shortly after the start losing ground.</p> <p>IRISH GIRL (T Thornton) - Clipped a heel and blundered approaching the 350 metres.</p> <p>SUPREME HIEGHTS (L Satherley) - Heavily contacted and unbalanced passing the 225 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.</p>	

AVANTAGE (D Johnson) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Raced in restricted room having to be steadied passing the 100 metres when runners either side shifted ground. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that after being caught wide without cover, the effort had told in the straight with the mare failing to finish the race off. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

HARLECH (S Weatherley) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight before shifting out making heavy contact with SUPREME HEIGHTS.

V Colgan (GINO SEVERINI) - Admitted a charge in that he used his whip in consecutive strides over the concluding stages. After hearing submissions, the Adjudicative Committee suspended V Colgan's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 8th September up to and including racing on Thursday 16th September, 5 national days plus a fine of \$750.

L Satherley (SUPREME HEIGHTS) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount to shift out when now sufficiently clear of IRISH GIRL which clipped a heel and blundered passing the 350 metres. After hearing submissions, the Adjudicative Committee suspended L Satherley's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 11 September up to and including racing on Saturday 19 September, 5 national days.

S Weatherley (HARLECH) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he angled his mount outwards when not sufficiently clear of SUPREME HEIGHTS which was firmly contacted and unbalanced passing the 225 metres. After hearing submissions, the Adjudicative Committee suspended S Weatherley's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 11 September up to and including racing on Thursday 23 September, 7 national days.

Race 9

WAR DECREE 1200

MISTRESS MINX (S Collett) - Slow to begin. Then crowded shortly after having to be steadied.

CHEERS (J Fawcett) - Began awkwardly.

NOVERRE (D Johnson) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

KEEP IT REAL (J Kamaruddin) - Slow away.

NEW DAWN (J Riddell) - Began awkwardly. Improved onto heels passing the 250 metres having to shift inwards to improve.

ISLA JAY (S Weatherley) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

REAL SLIM TRADIE (T Thornton) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

RED INFERNO (T Yanagida) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

ZOULANDER (S Spratt) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

ANTIGUA (T Newman) - Returned to the birdcage with blood present in both nostrils. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which confirmed the gelding to have bled. Connections were advised that ANTIGUA would now be subject to the mandatory two month stand down from training, three months standdown from racing with a veterinary clearance being required prior to racing or trialling next.

L Satherley (DIAMOND GIRL) - Reprimanded for using her whip in consecutive strides over the concluding stages.

T Thornton (REAL SLIM TRADIE) - Was spoken to regarding the manner in which she used her whip over the concluding stages.

Race 10

PETER KELLY – BAYLEYS REAL ESTATE 1400

TRIGON LAD (T Thornton) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

LINCOLN KING (C Lindsay) - Knuckled on jumping away.

DAWN PARADE (M McNab) - Slow to begin.

FONTEYN (A Goindasamy) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

WHEAO (L Satherley) - Commenced to buck shortly after the start, losing ground as a result. Connections were advised that the gelding would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in one nostril. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a laceration in the right nostril.

Stipendiary Stewards report as posted is provisional and subject to further review and amendment
