RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 HB RACING WISHING YOU A HAPPY NEW YEAR SPRINT 1200

CANDLE (D Bradley) - Restrained to the rear. Lay in under pressure over the concluding stages. When questioned regarding performance rider had no excuse and advised the filly was disappointing. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed the filly to have tied up.

WICKET MAIDEN (L Allpress) - Raced wide throughout. When questioned L Allpress advised that despite being wide throughout the mare was disappointing and had no excuse.

NO TIME TO JAZZ (F Lazet) - When questioned into the improved performance of the winner, which had disappointed at its previous start, Trainer P Holden, advised the primary contributing factor was the drop back to 1200 metres

FISCAL FUN (T Newman) - When questioned, rider was of the opinion the filly may be better suited to any easing of the track and a longer distance.

Race 2 RACING AGAIN 27 JANUARY 3YO MAIDEN 1200

GRAEME JOHN (R Elliot) - Began awkwardly and shifted out into the line of KORUBELA MISS, steadied, and as a result was slow away. Raced greenly entering the home straight.

DARWIN (L Allpress) - Bumped with BELLA DA PARTY at the start. Lay in over the concluding stages.

BELLA DA PARTY (K Hercock) - Bumped start. Over-raced passing the 800 metres.

KAREHANA BAY (B Grylls) - Steadied near the post when SECRET FALLS Lay out.

MR BLUE SKY (K Asano) - When questioned, K Asano advised the colt was outpaced throughout and may now be better suited to a longer distance.

Race 3 RACING THIS TIME ON FACEBOOK MAIDEN 1200

ALL HEART (M Alam) - Commenced to buck shortly after the start and raced erratically throughout. Trainer was advised the gelding must trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

XTRAVERT (J Kamaruddin) - Lay in passing the 250 metres

CANNY MAN (K Asano) - Crowded shortly after the start when TRULY (B Grylls) was dictated into its line by inward movement from ALBY PARK (T Yanagida). After questioning riders and viewing footage, Stewards issued T Yanagida with a warning taking into account simultaneous movement from PRECISION SHOOTER which shifted out marginally. Lay in over the concluding stages crowding ALBY PARK, which was steadied.

ALBY PARK (T Yanagida) - Crowded and had to be steadied over the concluding stages.

MIDNIGHT SWEY (C Dell) - Over-raced in the early stages. Raced in restricted room passing the 250 metres.

PAPA MOANA (D Turner) - Raced greenly the home straight.

Race 4 POWER FARMING 1400

LONDON BOUND (K Asano) - Slow away. Held up in the early part of the home straight, checked near the 200 metres when SHEZZACATCH (T Yanagida) shifted out into clear running simultaneously as PENNY ROYAL (K Hercock) shifted in, so was not persevered with over the final stages when out of contention. After questioning riders, Stewards advised both K Hercock and T Yanagida to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

PENNY ROYAL (K Hercock) - Over-raced early and middle stages and in the home straight shifted ground inward approaching the 200 metres hampering BRIMSTONE. K Hercock was advised to exercise greater care.

BRIMSTONE (R Elliot) - Hampered 200 metres when in restricted room and was not persevered with over the final stages when out of contention.

NO ROCK NO POP (J Mudhoo) - Raced wide throughout.

D Turner (JEWEL OF PATCH) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount JEWEL OF PATCH 6 times prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a fine of \$500.

Race 5 MONSTAVISION MAIDEN 1600

ROCKET LAD (C Burdan) - Slow away.

OCEANIDES (T Yanagida) - Over-raced early stages. Shifted inwards in the home straight and had to be straightened, resulting in BILLY EASTON shifting away from that runner hampering POLIZZI, which in turn bumped with AVIATOR.

PLATINUM RAIN (D Turner) - Raced erratically and had to be checked off the heels of ROAD CRUZ (C Dell) shortly after the start. C Dell was advised to exercise care. Attempted to buck near the 1000 metres. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormality. Trainer L Latta was advised PLATINUM RAIN must trial to Stewards' satisfaction prior to its next start. L Latta advised PLATINUM RAIN will be retired.

AVIATOR (L Allpress) - Over-raced towards the end of the back straight and improved up on to the heels of BILLY EASTON for some distance near the 800 metres. Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination was clear.

POLIZZI (K Hercock) - Hampered home straight, bumping with AVIATOR.

Race 6 EAST PIER HOTEL MILE 1600

MAKKALDEE (K Hercock) - Slow away. Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

OVERSTAYER (A Mudhoo) - Raced wide throughout. Gave ground from the 700 metres, finishing last. When questioned rider could offer no excuse other than travelling three wide.

PRINCE OF TALLIN (K Asano) - When questioned K Asano advised the gelding had raced greenly throughout. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed a slow post-race recovery.

ORLOV (R Elliot) - Made the final bend awkwardly, then lay outwards over the concluding stages.

Race 7 GARTH BEST – BEST TRAVEL MEMORIAL 2100

JANE O' (R Elliot) - Slow away.

EAGLE HUNTER (M Sanson) - Raced wide throughout. M Sanson was reminded of her obligation to ride her mount out fully to the finish when circumstances permit.

DRAGON REALM (C Burdan) - Over-raced middle stage.

PLATINUM ROAD (D Turner) - Under pressure from near the 1000 metres and finished well back. D Turner had no particular excuse. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 8 COPYPLUS HASTINGS 1400

WEOWNA TIGER (C Burdan) - Checked 1200 metres then commenced to hang rounding the turn placing the rider at a disadvantage for the remainder. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any immediate abnormality. Connections were advised a warning would be placed against the racing manners of WEONA TIGER.

PLATINUM LINING (D Turner) - Finished a distant last. Rider advised the PLATINUM LINING had disappointed. A subsequent veterinary examination was clear.

K Hercock (PINK CHAMPAGNE) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted PINK CHAMPAGNE to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of WEOWNA TIGER, which was checked near the 1200 metres. After considering submissions to Adjudicator imposed a suspension of her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 8 January 2022 until the conclusion of racing on Friday, 14 January 2022 (4 national riding days).
