RACE COMMENTS	
Race 1	WORLD SOLAR / OTAUTAU FARMLANDS MAIDEN (1200m)
<p>DUCK DUCK GOOSE (S Toolooa) - Began awkwardly and shifted outwards hampering THE QUEEN and was then crowded by inside runners losing ground.</p> <p>PASSARELA (K Kwo) – Crowded at the start losing ground. Reported to have raced greenly throughout.</p> <p>MOROCCO MISS (T Moseley) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.</p> <p>THE QUEEN (K Mudhoo) - Hampered at the start losing ground and was further hampered shortly after when crowded by inside runners losing further ground.</p> <p>SALISBURY (S Muniandy) – Raced three-wide without cover for the majority of the event.</p> <p>BUSH MILLS BILLY (A Bohorun) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout. Lay inwards early in the run home having to be straightened.</p> <p>JUNE BUG (K Williams) – When asked to comment on the improved performance trainer S McKay reported the filly had been trapped wide at its first up run for the season and had derived natural benefit from that, further adding that the stable was confident of a forward showing today.</p>	
Race 2	AB LIME / STEVEN SHEARING CONTRACTING (1200m)
<p>HENLEY (T Moseley) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>NOAH (K Chowdhooey) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>SACRED KITTY (K Mudhoo) – Over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>GIVEHERAGO (C Campbell) – Raced three-wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>HE'S MI BROTHER (A Bohorun) – Held up early in the run home having to change ground inwards passing the 300 metres to find clear racing room.</p> <p>BENNY LINCOLN (C Johnson) – When asked to comment on the performance of favoured runner the rider advised that he had got back in the field from a wide draw however the gelding had only run on fairly over the concluding stages and was disappointing.</p> <p>A Bohorun (HE'S MI BROTHER) – Assisted by D Walsh, admitted a charge in that he struck his mount 8 times prior to the 100 metre mark with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a fine of \$250.</p> <p>J Lowry (DECEPTIO VISUS) admitted a breach of Rule 648(5) in that he weighed in 0.6kg over his weigh out weight and after considering penalty submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a fine of \$100.</p>	
Race 3	EWAN ALLAN HONDA / SPARROW LOGGING (1200m)
<p>KITTY POWER (K Chowdhooey) – Fractious in its barrier and got back shortly after the start.</p> <p>LOVE SQUIRRELS (C Johnson) – A post-race Veterinary examination revealed the mare to be a bleeder and as such shall not be ridden in exercise for a period of two months or start in any Race or Trial for a period of three months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Veterinarian.</p>	

Race 4	DONALD WHITE HEDGE CUTTING / RIVERTON BUTCHERY (1400m)
<p>ZAC BLACK (S Khetoo) – Slow to begin losing ground. Had to be steadied off heels passing the 800 metres.</p> <p>LA TARDIGRADA (K Kwo) – Reared then bounded at the start losing considerable ground. Connections were advised the mare was on a barrier manners warning.</p> <p>PETE THE DRIVER (S Toolooa) – Held up rounding the final bend.</p> <p>TYLER EIGHT (K Williams) – Lay outwards throughout the run home.</p> <p>MAKE BELIEVE (K Mudhoo) – When asked to comment on the performance the rider advised that in his opinion the mare had failed to see out the distance of today’s race.</p> <p>C Campbell (RUBY ROYALE) - Stewards inquired into the manner in which C Campbell used his whip in the home straight and could not be conclusively satisfied that he had contravened the rules.</p>	
Race 5	FORDE AUTO SERVICES / BRENDAN SHEARING CONTRACTING (1400m)
<p>ON THE BACKFOOT (K Kwo) – Late scratching at 2.28pm for refusing to load into the barriers and when being lead away, reared and fell to the ground. A subsequent Veterinary examination revealed the mare to be clear of any injury. Connections were advised the mare must barrier trial to the Stewards satisfaction prior to racing next.</p> <p>VERDIGRIS (C Campbell) – Bounded at the start.</p> <p>LILYBET (T Moseley) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>THE TUI TOILER (G Jogoo) – Slow to begin. Raced four-wide into the first bend and then wide throughout.</p> <p>PRINCE ALBY (S Khetoo) – Crowded at the start and lost ground when runners either side shifted ground.</p> <p>HATITIMATANGI (BB Hong) – Raced three-wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>BOB MARLIE (K Mudhoo) – Lay inwards throughout the run home.</p> <p>TUMEKE (K Williams) - When asked to comment on the performance of favoured runner the rider advised the gelding had received a nice trip throughout however when placed under pressure had been disappointing.</p> <p>LYKHER HIGHLY (A Bohorun) – Finished in a distant last placing with the rider reporting the filly was looking for more ground. Connections were advised LYKHER HIGHLY was on a racing manners warning and must be more competitive. Trainer G Eade advised he would consider sending the filly for a spell.</p> <p>R Mudhoo (NO BOUQUET) – Assisted by D Walsh admitted a charge in that he struck his mount 6 times prior to the 100 metre mark with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a suspension of Mr Mudhoo’s licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing 8 January until the conclusion of racing 16 January (5 national riding days).</p>	
Race 6	DOUG HORRELL CONTRACTING / RICKI EGERTON DAGGING (2147m)
<p>LINCOLN DREAMER (R Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>MY CASHIER (L Callaway) – Slow to begin losing ground.</p> <p>MIRADELLO (G Jogoo) – Reared and bounded at the start losing ground.</p>	

SUPER TAP (C Johnson) – Over-raced on a moderate tempo through the middle stages.

FRANCIS DRAKE (S Toolooa) – Over-raced in the middle stages prior to being sent forward to sit outside the leader passing the 850 metres.

SHE'S GOT THE LOOK (K Williams) – Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home, having to shift ground outwards passing the 150 metres to find clear racing room.

CLASSIC DIVA (S Khetoo) – Lay inwards throughout the run home.

DESPERADO (J Lowry) - When asked to comment on the performance of favoured runner the rider advised the gelding had received a nice trip throughout however when placed under pressure had been disappointing.

NO QUARTER ASKED (T Moseley) – When asked to comment on the apparent improved performance co-trainer K Tyler advised that after racing well at Cromwell the gelding was not suited by the Gore track and had appreciated a track with slightly more moisture today.

NESTA (C Johnson) – Over-raced in the early stages when being restrained to obtain cover and then continued to over-race through the middle stages.

KILOWATT (S Toolooa) – Briefly held up rounding the final bend.

Race 8	WESTERN ELETCRICAL / GRANT HORRELL CONTRACTING (1600m)

LUGANO'S ACE (K Kwo) – Trainer advised the mare would be ridden further back today if circumstances permit. Raced fiercely in the early stages when being restrained to obtain cover then continued to race keenly through to the middle stages. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the run home until passing the 250 metres.

VILLANELLE (S Toolooa) – Underwent a pre-race Veterinary examination at the start after being observed to have blood and thick mucus in the nose and was declared a late scratching at 4.11pm.

LORD GREYSTOKE (A Bohorun) – Slow to begin.

MARMADUKE (K Chowdhoo) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced erratically in the early stages getting its head up on a number of occasions.

PENTESLA (S Muniandy) – Raced three-wide without cover throughout. Hampered rounding the final bend.

MASTER MARKO (L Callaway) – Raced three-wide without cover in the early stages. Lay out rounding the final bend and when shifting out dictated OLE MATE and PAR TEE wider on the track with the trailing PENTESLA also being hampered.

COAX (K Williams) – Gave ground from the 400 metres.

CAPO DELL IMPERO (C Campbell) – Improved quickly onto the heels of the tiring COAX passing the 400 metres.

OLE MATE (S Khetoo) – Dictated wider on the track rounding the final bend.

PAR TEE (R Mudhoo) - Dictated wider on the track rounding the final bend.

SAVEZ VOUS (K Mudhoo) - Had to be shifted outwards across heels passing the 250 metres when becoming held up.

SOVEREIGNTY (T Moseley) – Held up in the run home until inside the final 125 metres.

Race 9

ODT SOUTHERN MILE QUALIFIER (1600m)

SWEET MOLLY MALONE (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.

THE GREEN GREMLIN (L Callaway) – Taken back at the start from a wide draw to obtain cover.

GLAMOUR (T Moseley) – Over-raced in the early stages when being restrained to obtain cover, getting its head up on a number of occasions.

PETE (S Muniandy) – Held up for a short distance early in the run home.

TAVY ROAD (D Bothamley) – Jostled with FAIRWAY FLIGHT becoming unbalanced when that runner improved into a marginal run near the 300 metres.

FAIRWAY FLIGHT (R Mudhoo) – Held up early in the run home until improving into a marginal run passing the 300 metres.

R Mudhoo (FAIRWAY FLIGHT) – Issued with a warning when angling his runner into a marginal run near the 300 metres making contact with TAVY ROAD who was unbalanced on 2 occasions.
