**CORNFLOWER BLUE** (J Kamaruddin) – Trainer J Richards advised Stewards, he was satisfied with the post-race condition of CORNFLOWER BLUE and it is his intention to continue on with the mare's current preparation.

#### Race 8 US NAVY FLAG @ THE OAKS (2000 metres)

**BO JACKSON** (C Grylls) – Co-trainer E Browne reported to Stewards, the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of the gelding and it is their intention to continue on with BO JACKSON'S current preparation.

#### Race 3 WAIKATO DRAUGHT MILE 1600M

**GERDA** (D Johnson) – Trainer E Davies advised Stewards she was satisfied with the post-race condition of the mare, however, further advised GERDA has now been retired from racing and will be sent to stud.

## RACE COMMENTS

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>GROUP ONE TURF BAR MAIDEN 1550</b>
<p><b>DAARIO</b> (S Collett) - Slow away.</p> <p><b>SIETE</b> (B May) - Steadied near the 1400 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of DUSKY EYES.</p> <p><b>ELUSIVE CAPITAL</b> (S Spratt) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>SKY OASIS</b> (K Asano) – Was inclined to over-race in the early stages. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had travelled well enough but failed to respond once placed under pressure and had been disappointing. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which failed to reveal any abnormality.</p> <p><b>LAST CARD BETTY</b> (J Fawcett) - Was not persevered with in the straight when well beaten. Rider advised that the mare had hung but was otherwise unable to offer any excuse, being of the opinion that it would be better suited to rain affected footing.</p> <p><b>UPCLOSENOUGH</b> (M Cameron) - Had to be steadied away from the heels of the weakening SIETE near the 450 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>THE OAKS STUD MAIDEN 1550</b>
<p><b>HOWAREYA</b> (R Beemud) – Jumped away awkwardly.</p> <p><b>FLAG HUNTER</b> (S Collett) - Over-raced in the middle stages having to be firmly restrained to avoid heels. Was inclined to lay inwards rounding the final turn and in the straight.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>WAIKATO-BOP HARNESS RACING MAIDEN 1300</b>
<p><b>GINSBURG</b> (D Johnson) - Restrained after jumping from the outside barrier. Proved reluctant to load with co-trainer A Forsman being advised that a barrier warning would be placed against the filly.</p> <p><b>LISTONIAN</b> (S Spratt) - Jumped away awkwardly.</p> <p><b>STUNGUN</b> (J Fawcett) – Slow away. Commenced to race fiercely shortly after the start continuing to do so through the middle stages.</p> <p><b>LEAR JET</b> (S Collett) - Raced three wide without cover.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>OAKVUE LODGE MAIDEN 970</b>
<p><b>IDYLLIC</b> (M McNab) - Slow away. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the filly had tended to race greenly throughout and would benefit from the experience.</p> <p><b>LIL EL GEE DEE</b> (C Grylls) - Jumped away awkwardly coming together with BOSS BABY.</p> <p><b>BOSS BABY</b> (T Newman) – Jumped away awkwardly coming together with LIL EL GEE DEE. Steadied near the 700 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of SAVASILK which shifted inwards away from ZAFFIRE BAY when being steadied.</p> <p><b>ZAFFIRE BAY</b> (S Collett) – Raced three wide without cover.</p> <p><b>TRIPLE HEART</b> (M Alam) - Lay out entering the final straight.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>CAMBRIDGE NZ RIDING FOR THE DISABLED MAIDEN 970</b>

**EAGLE TARZAN** (M Cameron) – Raced ungenerously getting its head up near the 800 metres and again near the 600 metres.

**DIVINE DUDE** (B Rogerson) – Raced wide throughout.

**AOIDE** (J Fawcett) - Lay out rounding the final turn.

**KING OF REDS** (C Grylls) – Lay out rounding the final turn.

**MERCURIAL** (W Pinn) - Improved into a tight run to the inside of KING OF REDS near the 300 metres. Lay out over the concluding stages.

**Race 6**

**MARTIN COLLINS NEW ZEALAND 970**

**SHAMPAGNE DANCER** (M Sanson) – Jumped away awkwardly then commenced to over-race shortly after leaving the barriers, racing wide without cover throughout.

**DARCI PALMER** (C Grylls) - Hampered approaching the 800 metres when SHAMPAGNE DANCER which commenced to over-race, shifted outwards to improve forward. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that after getting back early the gelding had been unable to recover under its top weight.

**QUICK PREVIEW** (S Spratt) - Lay in away from EASY PEASY over the concluding stages.

**Race 7**

**CAMBRIDGE EQUINE HOSPITAL 2000**

**FLORAL BELT** (A Goindasamy) - Jumped away awkwardly then being further hampered.

**ELLE MAKFI** (C Barnes) – Crowded shortly after leaving the barriers then laying out hampering FLORAL BELT.

**LA CASA** (S Collett) – Hampered shortly after the start. Lay in under pressure having to be straightened near the 150 metres.

**WILLY AWAY** (D Johnson) - Lay out rounding the bend near the 1400 metres, running wide forcing MR BAZAMOUR over extra ground.

**MR BAZAMOUR** (W Pinn) - Hampered when forced over extra ground rounding the bend passing the 1400 metres.

**HARD DONE** (M McNab) - When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse advising that in his opinion it may be feeling the effects of recent racing and that he was of the understanding that the gelding would now be freshened.

**LORD POLONIUS** (T Yanagida) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the straight.

**T Yanagida** (LORD POLONIUS) - Issued with a warning after striking his mount in two consecutive strides near the 150 metres.
