Race 7 FAREWELL AND THANK YOU MICHAEL O'TOOLE MILE (1600 metres)

LADIES MAN (D Johnson) – Trainer Mr A Sharrock advised Stewards he is satisfied with the post-race condition of the LADIES MAN and it is his intention to continue on with the gelding's current preparation.

Race 8 VALACHI DOWNS FOXBRIDGE PLATE (G2) 1200

AVANTAGE (D Johnson) – Trainer Mr J Richards advised Stewards he was satisfied with the post-race condition of the mare and it is his intention to continue on with AVANTAGE’S current preparation.

TAVI MAC (M McNab) – Trainer Mr A Sharrock advised Stewards, he is satisfied with the post-race condition of TAVI MAC and it is his intention to continue on with the gelding’s current preparation.

Race 10 PETER KELLY – BAYLEYS REAL ESTATE 1400

DAWN PARADE (M McNab) – Trainer Mr T Pike reported to Stewards an inspection of the gelding was completed at the stable the morning of Sunday 5 September, which revealed DAWN PARADE to have swelling and bruising to the right eye. T Pike further advised the gelding has undergone treatment for the swelling and it is his intention to continue on with DAWN PARADE’S current preparation.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 SHOCKING @ RICH HILL STUD (1800 metres)

BROOKBOURNE (B May) - Slow to begin.

LILLY LAGUNA (M McNab) - Began awkwardly then hampered, losing ground.

THORA’S JOY (V Colgan) - Slow to begin then crowded, losing ground. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

PERSWEY ME (T Newman) - Improved onto heels approaching the 200 metres having to be steadied.

THE ACTRESS (C Grylls) - Held up for a distance approaching the 350 metres.

Race 2 SUPER SETH @ WAIKATO STUD (1400 metres)

MARGARET JEAN (D Johnson) - Began awkwardly then shifted out hampering ENRIGHT.

RED STAR (B Rogerson) - Restrained behind runners shortly after the start. Improved onto heels passing the 100 metres having to be firmly restrained.

SOLID IMPACT (J Riddell) – Began awkwardly.

VERDANA (J Fawcett) - Slow to begin.

JACK IN THE BOX (T Yanagida) - Hampered shortly after the start losing ground.

SAMARKAND (M Cameron) - Began awkwardly.

ONLY IN AMERICA (S Spratt) - Raced three wide without cover.

ENRIGHT (D Danis) - Raced wide without cover. Hampered shortly after the start.

SHE’S DASHING (M McNab) - Steadied when placed in restricted room between JACK IN THE BOX which shifted out and VERDANA which shifted in passing the 100 metres with T Yanagida and J Fawcett being advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.

Race 3 RIBCHESTER @ HAUNUI FARM MAIDEN (1300 metres)

LADY VADAMOS (A Mudhoo) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly having to be steadied for a distance passing the 1100 metres.

TE TOKI (V Colgan) - Began awkwardly.

TIGER FIRE (M Cameron) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Made the bend awkwardly passing the 800 metres.

POLAR BLAST (J Riddell) - Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of TIGER FIRE which was racing greenly passing the 1000 metres. Held up until near the 250 metres.

Race 4 | **PER INCANTO PROVEN @ LITTLE AVONDALE STUD (1200 metres)**

REMARKABLE RUTH (C Lindsay) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

LOCK UP (D Danis) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

CAN'T FAULT HER (M McNab) – Began awkwardly.

LAKEMAN (J Fawcett) - Slow to begin.

DARK SCARLETT (W Pinn) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages when being restrained. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

PORTOFINO (M Cameron) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no excuse.

QUARTZ QUEEN (B Grylls) – Held up until near the 250 metres. When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no excuse.

MACROS (C Jones) - Lay out rounding the final bend.

Race 5 | **TE AKAU STUD & RACING (1200 metres)**

SAGUNTO (S McKay) - Began awkwardly.

MAIDSTONE PARK (C Grylls) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

WHOSHE'S GIRL (E McCall) - Slow to begin.

BRIAN LAMONT (E Leighton) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

DUBY (J Kamaruddin) - Hampered shortly after the start. Made the bend awkwardly near the 800 metres when racing keenly.

LOCOMOTION (D Johnson) - Hampered shortly after the start. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the mare had failed to handle today's track conditions.

J Fawcett (THEBEASTFORTHEEAST) - Reminded of her obligations in that she must rider her mounts out fully to the end of the race when circumstances permit her to do so.

Race 6 | **HELLO YOUMZAIN @ CAMBRIDGE STUD (1200 metres)**

TIA CELESTE (L Satherley) - Slow to begin.

EL NOIR (K Asano) - Knuckled shortly after the start.

BRING IT ON (E Nicholas) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

CORNFLOWER BLUE (J Kamaruddin) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running rounding the bend and early in the final straight. Improved onto heels passing the 100 metres being held up for the remainder of the race. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

SHOSHONE (E Leighton) - Steadied when placed in restricted room inside of CHALLA which shifted inwards passing the 1050 metres. Had to be steadied off heels when the pace eased passing the 900 metres.

N Parmar (CHALLA) - Issued with a warning for permitting his mount to shift in when not sufficiently clear of SHOSHONE passing the 1050 metres.

Race 7 | **MATAMATA VETERINARY SERVICES MAIDEN (1100 metres)**

LA BELLA BEALS (D Johnson) - Slow to begin. Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.

MELANIA (K Hercock) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages. Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

SHOW ME A DREAMER (T Thornton) - Slow to begin.

ONE DREAM ONE SOUL (F Lazet) - Dictated inwards by AGLIANICO which was angled inwards making contact with ARCEUS passing the 1000 metres.

ARCEUS (J Riddell) - Contacted and unbalanced passing the 1000 metres.

ARIS ARIS (C Grylls) - Inconvenienced passing the 200 metres when AGLIANICO shifted out under pressure. A Goindasamy was advised to exercise care.

AGLIANICO (A Goindasamy) – Shifted out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

THATSMORELIKEIT (S Collett) - Made the bend awkwardly near the 800 metres. Had to be firmly restrained off heels passing the 300 metres when ARCEUS shifted inwards slightly and LA BELLA BEALS had improved into a marginal run before shifting out and away from FLOWER OF WANAKA which had lay out entering the final straight.

A Goindasamy (AGLIANICO) – Issued with a warning for permitting his mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear dictating ONE DREAM ONE SOUL inwards which made contact with ARCEUS with both runners becoming unbalanced passing the 1000 metres.

Race 8 | **US NAVY FLAG @ THE OAKS (2000 metres)**

UNDER THE PUMP (S McKay) - Began awkwardly briefly unbalancing its rider, losing ground. Then lay out in the early stages.

PIERIAN SPRING (B May) - Slow to begin.

LORD PAINTON (B Grylls) – Briefly held up entering the final straight.

BO JACKSON (C Grylls) - Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race. When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no excuse.

B Grylls (LORD PAINTON) - Issued with a warning for using her whip in consecutive strides.
