### GENERAL

H Schofer advised stewards at 9 am she was unable to make the carded weight in Races 2 and 6 and was unable to claim her one kilo allowance in her other rides. H Schofer admitted a charge under Rule 330 (3)(c) and fined \$100 under the minor infringement schedule.

<b>SUPPLEMENTARY</b>

<b>RACE COMMENTS</b>
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<b>Race 1</b>	<b>EVENTS TARANAKI MDN 1800 metres</b>
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**BURCHA** (H Schofer) – Was presented in the enclosure with visor blinkers when the correct gear was blinkers. The mistake was corrected prior to the start.

**IRISH FLARE** (S Macnab) – Got back at the start.

**TOGA PARTY** (L Hemi) – Made the first bend awkwardly and shifted out dictating SOUTHERN BABE over extra ground.

**PLAYING THE FOOL** (B Grylls) – Struggled to keep up throughout and was not persevered with in the home straight when running off on the turn. Connections were advised the gelding must trial prior to its next start. R Manning advised that he would trial the gelding in blinkers.

**SOUTHERN BABE** (T Taiaroa) – Dictated over extra ground first bend.

**SPACEK** (L Kauri) – Changed legs and went off stride approaching the home turn.

**D Montes de Oca** (REDGUM) – Was spoken to with regard to the manner he used his whip over the final stages (above shoulder height).

**BURCHA** (H Schofer) - When questioned into the run rider advised the gelding was not entirely happy in the ground but was generally disappointing.

<b>Race 2</b>	<b>TARANAKI PINE MDN 990 metres</b>
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**ORGANISED CHAOS** (D Dell) – Slow away. Hampered first turn.

**SWEET KARMA** (D Montes de Oca) – Began awkwardly.

**KUSHINDA** (T Taiaroa) – Made the first turn awkwardly and shifted out hampering ORGANISED CHAOS and LOOX LIKE A PRO.

**FAIRYSTEPS** (L Allpress) – Raced greenly throughout.

**LOOX LIKE A PRO** (C Jones) – Hampered first turn. Improved on to heels near the 250 metres and had to be steadied.

**L Hemi** (PACE ATTACK) – Stewards enquired into the manner which L Hemi used her whip inside the 100 metres but were satisfied on this occasion she did not contravene the rule.

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>WHITAKER CIVIL CONSTRUCTION 990 metres</b>
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**ROC CHA** (B May) – Team Rogerson was fined \$50 under the Minor Infringement Schedule after presenting ROC SHA with incorrect gear. Began awkwardly and was slow away.

**TEREINE** (L Allpress) – Dipped in the heavy going near the 700 metres. This area of the track was inspected by track staff and divots were replaced.

**OTTAVIO** (B Rogerson) – Disappointed, rider had no excuse.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>WYNDSPELL@GRANGEWILLIAM STUD 1300 metres</b>
<p><b>POCHESTI</b> (C Jones) - Shifted out abruptly at the start tightening ZOLA EXPRESS and SOME LIKE IT HOT which was badly hampered. Also affected was SMOOTH COGNAC which was tightened and became unbalanced. Commenced to give ground rounding the home turn. When questioned C Jones advised the gelding was not entirely comfortable in the heavy 10.</p> <p><b>SOME LIKE IT HOT</b> (Y Coonee) - Badly hampered at the start. Raced wide throughout.</p> <p><b>ZOLA EXPRESS</b> (H Schofer) - Tightened at the start.</p> <p><b>SMOOTH COGNAC</b> (A Mudhoo) - Tightened at the start and became unbalanced.</p> <p><b>HOT SHOCKOLATE</b> (B Grylls) - Over raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>B Rogerson</b> (SO SURREAL) - Was dislodged on returning to the enclosure and after being examined by Paramedics was cleared to ride.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>SEATON PARK OPEN 1200 metres</b>
<p><b>LONDON EXPRESS</b> (C Jones) - Began awkwardly then raced keenly. Bumped 200 metres.</p> <p><b>CASAQUINMAN</b> (K Hercock) – Slow Away.</p> <p><b>DIVINE DIVE</b> - Shifted out passing the 200 metres and bumped with LONDON EXPRESS which was improving to its outside. T Taiaroa was shown footage of her ride in the presence of the Riding Master and advised to exercise greater care.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>NZB READY TO RUN TRAINERS SERIES 1400 metres</b>
<p><b>BELT ROAD</b> (L Allpress) - When questioned into the run of BELT ROAD which disappointed L Allpress advised in her opinion the gelding would derive benefit from the run.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>NZB AIRFREIGHT ROAD TO JERICHO 3210 metres</b>
<p><b>SENASSY</b> (C O'Beirne) – Raced keenly early.</p> <p><b>BRUCIE</b> (S McKay) - Shifted out across heels near the 350 metres and momentarily had to steady off the heels of THE COSSACK.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of <b>PENELOPE CRUISE</b> L Allpress was of the opinion the 60 kgs over 3210 metres told over the final stages.</p> <p>Following the running of race 7 <b>S McKay</b> the rider of BRUCIE which ran 2<sup>nd</sup> lodged an objection against the winner THE COSSACK alleging interference near the 350 metres. After hearing submissions the Adjudicator dismissed the protest.</p> <p><b>S McKay</b> BRUCIE - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount six times prior to the 100 metres with the Adjudicator imposing a \$250 fine.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>REVITAL FERTILISERS OPEN 1800 metres</b>
<p><b>VERRY FLASH</b> (S Nacnab) – Began awkwardly and got back.</p> <p><b>BAKELA</b> (T Taiaroa) – Over raced early and skied its head for some distance on the first round.</p>	

**ZEEFA ZED** (B Rogerson) – Over raced early when wide so was taken forward to lead near the 1600 metres. When questioned into the improved performance Trainer J Wheeler advised the gelding benefited from the apprentice claim today.

**CHARLIE HORSE** (D Turner) – Raced keenly early due to there being no early speed.

**HAPPY STAR** – Rider L Allpress was of the opinion the gelding did not see out the 1800 metres in the heavy 10 track.

**B Rogerson** (ZEEFA ZED) – Was warned under Rule 638(3)(g)(i) for using her whip in 2 consecutive strides inside 100 metres.

<b>Race 9</b>	<b>STELLA ARTOIS 1800 metres</b>
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**BEAR GRYLS** - Examined by the veterinary surgeon at 3.35pm and found to have a suspensory injury, BEAR GRYLS was subsequently late scratched and connections were advised a clearance is required prior to its next start.

**WINE N' DINE** (B Rogerson) – Slow away. Finished some distance last, a subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Connections advised that the mare will be retired.

**GOBUYIT** (B Grylls) – Was momentarily held up near the 350 metres.
