RACE COMMENTS**Race 1 TAB BONUS BACK BLITZ – 16 RACES 4 MEETINGS MAIDEN 1600m**

KENKI (D Bothamley) - Hampered shortly after the start losing ground.

KHANT REID (M Gestain) - Slow to begin.

LADY MODENA (R Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly then hampered losing ground. Over raced in the early stages when being restrained to obtain cover. Held up momentarily passing the 400 metres having to shift out to obtain clear running.

SUMMER NIGHT (C Campbell) - Began awkwardly. Raced three wide without cover passing the 800 metres.

COFFERS (S Wynne) - Slow to begin. Had to be steadied away from heels passing the 1000 metres and again passing the 600 metres when improving onto heels. Rider could offer no tangible excuse for the performance.

CHOICE MOMENT (C Johnson) - Slow to begin. Rider could offer no tangible excuse for the performance.

TAKEITEASY (B Murray)- Over raced in the early and middle stages.

THISTLE (T Comignaghi) - Lay in under pressure over the concluding stages.

T Comignaghi (THISTLE) - Admitted a charge in that she struck her mount THISTLE six times prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a fine of \$250.

Race 2 SOUTH ISLAND RACING AWARDS 1 OCTOBER MAIDEN 1600m

AINE BEAG (K Kwo) - Began awkwardly. Hampered 1400 metres.

ENOUGH SAID (B Murray) - Began awkwardly then crowded losing ground. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

SORISSO (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly. When over racing and being steadied to avoid the heels of BURNVUE shifted in abruptly passing the 1400 metres crowding MAXWELL and ROSE DE GRANVILLE which both had to be steadied, with ROSE DE GRANVILLE then shifting out forcing MAXWELL outwards onto AINE BEAG with all three runners being briefly hampered.

ROSE DE GRANVILLE (C Campbell) – Crowded and hampered 1400 metres.

MAXWELL (A Comignaghi) - Crowded and hampered 1400 metres.

PERIA'S LEGACY (D Bothamley) - Slow to begin.

MR GHIBSON (C Barnes) - Slow to begin. Contacted by ENOUGH SAID which was laying outwards passing the 300 metres.

NO RIGMAROLE (K Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

LACHIE'S MATE (S Toolooa) - Crowded having to be steadied off heels shortly after the start.

NOBLE KNIGHT (J Lowry) - Got its head up when over racing in the early stages.

S Wynne (SORISSO) - Issued with a warning in that she struck her mount SORISSO in consecutive strides.

L Callaway (BURNVUE) - Issued with a warning after allowing his mount BURNVUE to shift in when not fully clear of SORISSO which had to be steadied passing the 1400 metres.

Race 3 | **SPEIGHT'S MAIDEN 1200m**

OUR CLARRY (D Bothamley) - Began awkwardly. Commenced to over race in the early and middle stages.

JAMIESON'S TIPPLE (C Johnson) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

TAIMATE DIVA (K Mudhoo) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground when runners either side shifted ground. Briefly steadied passing the 250 metres to avoid the heels of GRANDILOQUENT (K Williams) which was shifting ground under pressure. K Williams was advised to exercise greater care.

THE RADIANT ONE (T Moseley) - Raced greenly throughout.

MERITORIOUS (C Barnes) - Crowded and buffeted passing the 600 metres when COMMITMENT (T Comignaghi) shifted out to avoid the heels of a tiring runner. T Comignaghi was advised to exercise greater care. Held up rounding the final bend when attempting to obtain clear running passing the 375 metres.

ON MY SHOULDERS (L Callaway) - Held up for a short distance passing the 400 metres. Had to be steadied passing the 200 metres when improving quickly onto the heels of MR HASS.

K Mudhoo (TAIMATE DIVA) - Issued with a warning in that he used his whip when out of contention.

Race 4 | **STALLION TENDER NOW OPEN 1600m**

JIMMY WHO (M Taylor) - Slow to begin.

SULU SEA (K Chowdhoory) - Slow to begin.

JIMINY CRICKET (C Barnes) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

MISS CURIOUS (C Campbell) - Blundered shortly after the start.

ZAKUNDA (S Wynne) - Raced wide from the 1000 metres. Lay inwards concluding stages.

CAST IN BRONZE (J Laking) - Held up for the majority of the run home only gaining clear racing room inside the final 100 metres.

LOVINGYOURWORK (B Murray) - Held up passing the 300 metres and continued to be held up until inside the final 50 metres.

MOIRAS TOWN (T Moseley) – Held up middle stages of the run home and placed in restricted room and jostled with ZAKUNDA when that runner lay inwards over the concluding stages.

Race 5 | **GROUP 1 RACEDAY PARTY 23 OCTOBER 2000m**

HEY MICKEY (K Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly shifting out crowding outside runners.

AQUATTACK (C Johnson) - Slow to begin. Raced wide through the early stages.

FAUX PAS (R Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

HARLEEN QUINZEL (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly then hampered losing ground.

WANNABE 'N' PARIS (C Barnes) - Hampered shortly after the start.

YEAH RIGHT (T Moseley) - Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied off heels losing ground.

JACK BE QUICK (M Taylor) - Lay inwards for a distance passing the 1000 metres making contact with the rail on a number of occasions.

MR FAHRENHEIT (K Kwo) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

KING OF THE DANCE (L Callaway) - Held up rounding the bend only gaining clear racing room passing the 350 metres.

TOP GUY (K Williams) - Lay in early in the run home. Rider advised she had been obliged to improve very wide rounding home turn and had battled on fairly over the concluding stages.

YOLO (T Comignaghi) - When asked to comment on the performance of this favoured runner, rider advised that the mare had been disappointing, adding that carrying top weight had not helped.

Race 6 | **NZB READY TO RUN SALE TRAINERS SERIES 1200m**

Trainer **S Marsh** was issued with a warning when presenting CALLYROSE without the notified pre-race ear covers.

RADEGAST (K Mudhoo) – Refused to leave the barriers as the start was effected and took no part in the running of the race. The connections were advised that the gelding must barrier trial prior to racing next.

CALLYROSE (C Barnes) - Began awkwardly having to be steadied off heels losing ground.

AVAQUINELLA (T Moseley) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

GLADROY (J Lowry) - Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.

FASHION SHOOT (R Mudhoo) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Held up in the final stages of the straight having to shift out to obtain clear running near the 350 metres.

FETTERCAIRN (S Wynne) - Obligated to race wide throughout. Rider advised that the mare had battled on fairly in its first up run for the season and would derive natural benefit from today's race.

Race 7 | **PRYDE'S EASIFEED 1200m**

SEVERINE (K Williams) - Began awkwardly. Held up for several strides passing the 100 metres by the tiring OUR GIRL GILLY.

ROCK SENSATION (K Chowdhury) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

SUMMER MONSOON (C Barnes) - Began awkwardly.

HASABRO (J Lowry) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Shifted wider on the track for a short distance passing the 900 metres.

OUR GIRL GILLY (M Gestain) - Over raced in the early stages and passing the 900 metres shifted out dictating HASABRO wider on the track for a short distance. M Gestain was advised to exercise greater care.

NEED I SAY MORE (R Mudhoo) - Raced three wide without cover on the speed, with the rider reporting that the gelding had peaked in its run over the concluding stages and would derive natural benefit from its first up race.

EL BEE DARCI (C Campbell) - Held up passing the 300 metres when denied a marginal run to the inside of ROCANTO having to be steadied and shifted out to find clear racing room passing the 150 metres, and was again held up for a short distance passing the 100 metres.

GOODANYA (T Moseley) - Bumped with WHALE SONG on two occasions near the 250 metres when WHALE SONG attempted a run to the outside of HASABRO which shifted outwards under pressure.

WHALE SONG (T Comignaghi) - Held up for clear running early in the run home and bumped with GOODANYA when looking for clear racing room passing the 250 metres.

MARKUS AURELIUS (J Laking) - Held up in the run home and had to shift outwards across heels passing the 100 metres to find clear racing room

The connections of **GOODANYA** viewed replays of the incident near the 250 metres before deciding not to lodge a protest.

Following this race the track was upgraded to Dead 4.

Race 8

NEW ZEALAND BLOODSTOCK CANTERBURY BELLE STAKES 1200m

Trainer **F Auret** was issued with a warning when presenting MOCHATINI without the notified side winkers.

CLASSIC DIVA (L Callaway) - Slow to begin.

FAH SAI (M Taylor) - Slow to begin then hampered losing ground.

SORRENTO (G Jogoo) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Got its head up when being steadied when racing keenly in the early stages.

SWISS 'N' GIGGLES (C Barnes) - Began awkwardly.

GLOBAL BEAUTY (B May) - Over raced in the early stages and got its head up when avoiding heels near the 900 metres.

VENTURESOME (T Comignaghi) - Over raced in the early stages. Held up for the majority of the final straight and went to the line untested.

MOCHATINI (S Wynne) - Raced wide without cover throughout, with the rider unable to offer any tangible excuse.

ZACAT (C Johnson) - Shifted in abruptly after making contact with IRISH RED, dictating SHAMELESS TART inwards near the 50 metres.

SYNCHRONIZE (R Mudhoo) - When spoken to regarding the performance of this favoured runner, rider advised that the filly had been handy throughout but failed to finish the race off as expected over the concluding stages.

B May (GLOBAL BEAUTY) - Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 9	MARTIN COLLINS NEW ZEALAND CUP TRIAL 1800m

DIORISSIMO (M Taylor) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after rearing up and banging its head in the stabling area, being declared fit to race. Held up in the run home only gaining clear racing room passing the 150 metres.

ASATHOUGHT (C Johnson) - Slow to begin.

STANDREWS MASONIC (M Gestain) - Slow to begin.

SEVEN AAJES (K Chowdhoo) - Began awkwardly. Lay in for the majority of the run home and could not be ridden to full advantage.

BEACHED AS BRO (K Mudhoo) - Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied and then improved wide in the early stages before sitting outside the leader passing the 1200 metres.

WILLIAM WALLACE (T Moseley) - Crowded and steadied shortly after the start. Lay outwards in the run home and shifted inwards over the concluding stages when placed under pressure.

FIVE PRINCES (L Callaway) - Raced three wide without cover passing the 1000 metres. Denied a marginal run approaching the 400 metres having to steady and shift inwards.

TAKE THE DEEL (T Comignaghi) - Held up in the run home only gaining clear racing room inside the 125 metres.

SOUTHERN OCEAN (K Williams) - Rider reported that the gelding had peaked in its run over the concluding stages and would take benefit from its first race in a few months.

T Comignaghi (TAKE THE DEEL) - Admitted a charge of using the whip in three consecutive strides on her mount TAKE THE DEEL near the 50 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a fine of \$300.

Race 10	RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE 1400m

RIVALDO (K Chowdhoo) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after becoming fractious in the barriers and declared a late scratching at 5.25 pm. The connections were advised that the gelding was on a barrier manners warning.

GLORIOUS OCEAN (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly. Rider S Wynne will be spoken to at a later date in regards to leaving the jockeys area without the stewards permission.

THE GROWLER (S Toolooa) - Slow to begin. When questioned regarding performance rider stated that in his opinion the gelding had been feeling today's firmer track conditions.

BRONTE BEACH (B Murray) - Slow to begin.

HEE'S OUR SECRET (C Barnes) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

SERIOUSLY (T Moseley) - Got its head up when being steadied shortly after the start and then raced wide throughout.

ZELENSKI (J Laking) - Crowded racing into the first bend when GLORIOUS OCEAN was taken outwards by UCALLEDIT which lay out at this point when making the bend awkwardly.

ARKLOW (K Williams) - Shifted out passing the 700 metres when awkwardly placed close to the heels of MAXIMUS PRIME and in doing so inconvenienced HUNTER VILLAIN and SERIOUSLY which were momentarily dictated wider on the track.
