J Laking advised Stewards he was unable to make the contracted weight for three of his rides today and was replaced as per the Summary above. The Adjudicative Committee imposed a fine of \$100 under the Minor Infringement Schedule.

Race 8 – ARCHMORE CONTRACTING / TASMAN AGRICULTURE (1400m)

APATCHEE POWER - Checked when becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of SOOO DUSTY which lay outwards and made the bend awkwardly, after receiving slight contact from ROUSSANNE (T Comignaghi) which was shifting outwards to obtain clear running near the 225 metres. T Comignaghi was advised to exercise care.

RACE COMMENTS**Race 1 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1150m)**

LILY OF THE VALLEY (BB Hong) - Slow to begin.

HELLO MARY LOU (S Toolooa) - Shifted outwards abruptly shortly after the start hampering outside runners. Lay outwards rounding the bend near the 800 metres.

FAH SAI (C Barnes) - Hampered shortly after the start losing ground. Rider reported the filly had felt indifferent in its action over the concluding stages. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormality.

THE KINGS GIRL (T Comignaghi) - Hampered shortly after the start losing ground. Rider reported the filly had never travelled well and had been inclined to change legs during the running. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormality. Connections were of the opinion that the filly had failed to back up from its previous race on Wednesday at Reefton.

SHAMELESS TART (K Williams) - Raced three-wide without cover through the early and middle stages.

Race 2 TERRY JAMES MEMORIAL MAIDEN (1150m)

CAUSE CELEBRE (J Laking) - Jumped outwards at the start crowding an outside runner.

SIAPA RAJAH (K Chowdhoo) - Crowded at the start losing ground, then tailed the field throughout despite the urgings of its rider. When questioned regarding the performance rider was unable to offer any excuse. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormality.

MR MISTER (A Balloo) - Slow to begin.

POSTCODE ENVY (T Comignaghi) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 3 GREYMOUTH STAR / HYNDS PIPES SYSTEMS (1150m)

SPRING BLOSSOM (T Jonker) - Connections advised the mare would be racing in season.

TELLYAWHAT (C Barnes) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover.

OHIO SHOWGIRL (K Chowdhoo) - Slow to begin. Hampered near the 400 metres having to shift ground to avoid the heels of BLAIR FLIGHT. Had to shift ground to obtain clear running entering the straight near the 250 metres.

BLAIR FLIGHT (BB Hong) - Contacted the running rail approaching the 450 metres, going off stride and losing momentum, hampering OHIO SHOWGIRL. Lay outwards rounding the final turn.

MEARA MARY (T Comignaghi) - When asked to comment on the performance rider advised that the mare had been outpaced throughout and in her opinion is looking for tracks with more moisture.

Race 4 GO RACING BUYING @ MAGIC MILLIONS THIS MONTH (1150m)

CHARMAINE'S DREAM (T Comignaghi) - Declared a late scratching on Veterinary advice at 12.56pm.

SELFIE (K Mudhoo) - Jumped outwards at the start crowding an outside runner.

BOLT FROM THE BLUE (C Barnes) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

LADY CORA (R Cuneen) - Bounded at the start losing some ground before being sent forward wide to sit outside the leader.

BEAU STITCH (J Laking) - Held up rounding the bend from the 600 metres.

DAUPHINE (K Chowdhoo) - Rider reported he had been inconvenienced when the saddle shifted sideways over the concluding stages.

Race 5

ALEX HAYWOOD / NOEL WAFER POW MEMORIAL MAIDEN (1810m)

PRINCE OF DOON (T Moseley) - Shifted outwards abruptly at the start crowding RED SUNDAY and ACQUITTAL.

NO RIGMAROLE (K Williams) - Jumped away awkwardly with the rider having to re-adjust her right stirrup iron shortly after the start. Forced over extra ground around the first bend.

RED SUNDAY (C Johnson) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

ACQUITTAL (K Chowdhoo) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

TAWHIRIMATEA (K Kwo) - Blundered shortly after the start. Over-raced in the middle stages, shifting outwards to avoid heels near the 1050 metres inconveniencing PRINCESS NALA.

EMPRESS QI (C Barnes) - Made the first bend awkwardly, running wide forcing NO RIGMAROLE over extra ground. Dipped badly passing the 225 metres.

DALPARK (R Mudhoo) - Over-raced when being restrained in the early stages.

PRINCESS NALA (T Jonker) - Inconvenienced near the 1050 metres.

WANNABE 'N' VEGAS (T Comignaghi) - Lay inwards under pressure in the straight and was unable to be fully ridden out.

Trainer **S Tyler** (NO RIGMAROLE) - Issued with a warning after presenting this runner without the notified blinkers.

Race 6

SPEIGHT'S / SUPER LIQUOR GREYMOOUTH MAIDEN (1810m)

KENKI (J Laking) - Declared a late scratching on Veterinary advice at 11.20am.

ROYAL KHAN (C Barnes) - Rider C Barnes was examined by on course Paramedics after being hit in the head by her mount on the way to the start area and was cleared of any injury.

FORT WILLIAM (B Murray) - Slow to begin.

DRUMISLE (S Toolooa) - Began awkwardly losing some ground. Over-raced badly going into the first bend and passing the winning post on the first occasion clipped a heel of THE BOUQUET SLAYER and blundered.

SAHARA EXPRESS (T Comignaghi) - Raced four-wide into the first bend then wide without cover for the majority of the event.

PAGE THREE (K Chowdhoo) - Raced three-wide without cover through the early and middle stages until improving forward to lead near the 1100 metres.

Race 7 | **SAMURAI STAKES (1810m)**

AMAZON GODDESS (A Balloo) - Refused to leave the barriers and took no part in the race. The connections were advised the mare must barrier trial to the Stewards satisfaction prior to racing next.

CANNOLI (T Moseley) - Jumped away awkwardly. Held up for a short distance rounding the final turn.

WAY ABOVE (T Comignaghi) - Slow to begin. Made the bend near the 1100 metres awkwardly, running wide. When questioned regarding the performance rider was unable to offer any tangible excuse other than having been trapped wide at various stages of the race.

REDGUM (C Johnson) - Blundered passing the winning post on the first occasion.

ARE YOU CEREAL (K Mudhoo) - Over-raced in the early to middle stages.

Race 8 | **VERNON & VAZEY TRUCK PARTS KUMARA GOLD NUGGETS (1810m)**

CAMINO ROCOSO (J Laking) - Began awkwardly losing some ground.

ALL ABOUT MAGIC (K Williams) - Over-raced going into the first bend and had to be steadied away from heels passing the 1400 metres.

ROCK SENSATION (K Chowdhoo) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

BLUEY'S CHANCE (A Balloo) - Raced three-wide through the early to middle stages before improving forward to sit outside the leader passing the 1200 metres.

SAVANAH BELLE (R Mudhoo) - Had to be severely restrained when over-racing badly and making the bend near the 1200 metres awkwardly.

WANNABE 'N' PARIS (C Barnes) - Over-raced in the middle stages.

SACRED ELIXIR (T Comignaghi) - Raced wide without cover throughout. Made the final turn awkwardly, making contact with ALL ABOUT MAGIC and becoming unbalanced with SACRED ELIXIR then not being persevered with for the remainder of the race. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormality. Stewards will follow up the recovery of the gelding with trainer K Myers in the coming days.

CETUS (S Toolooa) - Crowded when weakening near the 450 metres.

VEE TWELVE (K Mudhoo) - Rider dropped his whip near the 250 metres.

S Toolooa (CETUS) - Issued with a warning for his whip use on a runner out of contention.

Race 9 | **RECREATION HOTEL (1810m)**

MAIDINTHEMIST (T Moseley) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

APATCHEE POWER (L Callaway) - Slow to begin.

LOCHWINNOCH (T Comignaghi) - Steadied to avoid the heels of LAST LETTER passing the 1600 metres. Badly held up over the final 100 metres.

Race 10 | **BIRCHFIELD COAL MINES (1810m)**

EXQUISITE PEARL (J Lowry) - Bounded at the start. Got its head up on a number of occasions when over-racing through the early stages. Raced wide without cover from near the 1000 metres.

VENETO (C Barnes) - Slow to begin.

DA VINCI GIRL (K Chowdhoo) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Improved onto the heels of EXQUISITE PEARL rounding the bend near the 1100 metres and when shifting outwards clipped a heel of EXQUISITE PEARL and blundered, running wide forcing TOO FERLAXED over extra ground.

JUST TICKETY BOO (K Kwo) - Raced in restricted room rounding the first bend passing the 1500 metres. Raced wide without cover through the early to middle stages. Hampered when held up behind the weakening HIJACKED passing the 600 metres.

PATSY LAD (T Moseley) - Made the bend near the 1100 metres awkwardly having to be checked when becoming awkwardly placed near heels. Steadied off heels near the 900 metres.

TOO FERLAXED (K Williams) - Hampered and forced wider rounding the bend near the 1100 metres.

HIJACKED (B Murray) - Placed in restricted room when weakening passing the 600 metres, going back on to JUST TICKETY BOO which was hampered.

REALDOSER (T Comignaghi) - Rider reported the gelding would be better suited by some easing of the ground.
