## RACE COMMENTS

### Race 1 | GARTSHORE CONSTRUCTION MAIDEN 1200

**LONG GAME** (M Cameron) - Jumped away awkwardly. Raced ungenerously when being steadied making the bend passing the 1000 metres awkwardly. Raced greenly throughout.

**VADAMOS STAR** (A Goindasamy) - Jumped away awkwardly getting its head up, losing ground.

**GEMMA FLITZ** (J Fawcett) – Raced three wide without cover. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the filly had been unsuited by today's track conditions.

**CAESAR** (D Johnson) - Lay out throughout. Shifted out passing the 100 metres inconveniencing AYREON.

<b>AYREON</b> (L Allpress) - Inconvenienced passing the 100 metres.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>MILLS REEF WINERY MAIDEN 1400</b>
<p><b>REGAL LION</b> (L Allpress) - Crowded leaving the barriers losing ground. Had difficulty obtaining clear running entering the final straight. Contacted and unbalanced when in restricted room passing the 100 metres.</p> <p><b>MONGOLIAN PRINCESS</b> (S Weatherley) – Jumped away awkwardly after being fractious in the barriers.</p> <p><b>GREGORY</b> (S Collett) - Got its head up and raced ungenerously for a distance passing the 1300 metres. Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p><b>DRUIDOR</b> (E McCall) – Raced three wide without cover.</p> <p><b>MACROS</b> (S Spratt) - Raced in restricted room just prior to the winning post to the outside of MOLLYS GAME (T Yanagida) which shifted outwards when struck with the whip, and to the inside of LOCK UP which was contacted and unbalanced. T Yanagida was advised to exercise care.</p> <p><b>LOCK UP</b> (D Danis) - Contacted and unbalanced just prior to the winning post.</p> <p><b>D Danis</b> (LOCK UP) - When assessing the whip use of D Danis Stewards could not be conclusively satisfied that he had breached Rule 638(3)(g)(i) on this occasion.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>COMPLACENT STANDING AT MAPPERLEY STUD MAIDEN 1400</b>
<p><b>BOSS BABY</b> (T Newman) - Was inclined to get its head up when being restrained in the middle stages.</p> <p><b>WEOWNA TIGER</b> (J Fawcett) – When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding had failed to handle today’s track conditions. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>ULTIMATE MAZDA MAIDEN 2100</b>
<p><b>LIGHT SHOW</b> (S Weatherley) - Made the first bend awkwardly and shifted wider. When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.</p> <p><b>MAKTASTIC</b> (B Grylls) - Rider dropped her whip near the 150 metres.</p> <p><b>ULAANBAATAR</b> (M Cameron) - Was inclined to lay out throughout the running.</p> <p><b>CINNAMON STAR</b> (S Collett) – Returned to the birdcage with blood present in one nostril. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a laceration in the left nostril.</p> <p><b>C Barnes</b> (LED ZED) - Admitted a charge in that she struck her mount LED ZED seven times prior to the 100 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a fine of \$250.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES MAIDEN 1600</b>
<p><b>ARABIA</b> (J Kamaruddin) - Raced keenly in the early stages. Was inclined to lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight having to be straightened by its rider approaching the 100 metres.</p> <p><b>MUSE</b> (S Weatherley) - Shifted out approaching the 100 metres having to be straightened by its rider making slight contact with KERMALINA. Then again shifted out inside the final 50 metres making slight contact with KERMALINA.</p>	

**KERMALINA** (S Spratt) - Shifted inwards approaching the 100 metres making slight contact with MUSE. Then raced in restricted room passing the 50 metres to the outside of MUSE which shifted out slightly with brief contact being made.

Following the running of the race the trainer of the third placed horse **KERMALINA**, Mr D Greene lodged a protest with the Adjudicative Committee alleging interference in the final straight by the second placed horse **ARABIA** and the winner **MUSE**. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee dismissed the protest with the placings standing 1<sup>st</sup> MUSE, 2<sup>nd</sup> ARABIA, 3<sup>rd</sup> KERMALINA, 4<sup>th</sup> KATE VELOUR.

**Race 6** | **WAIKATO BRANCH NZ FARRIERS ASSOCIATION 1600**

**MRS BIG** (C Dell) - Slow to begin. Contacted and unbalanced passing the 300 metres.

**DANCE 'N' SING** (M Cameron) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

**INTO THE DEEP** (A Goindasamy) – Raced three wide without cover.

**MARBUZET** (R Beemud) – Improved onto the heels of the weakening EL FIESTA GIRL passing the 550 metres having to be firmly restrained.

**EL FIESTA GIRL** (S Weatherley) - Came under pressure passing the 800 metres commencing to give ground shortly after and was not persevered with in the straight, being retired from the race. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination including an endoscopic examination which did not to reveal any obvious abnormality. Connections were advised a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.

**NITRATE** (E McCall) - Shifted outwards passing the 300 metres making contact with MRS BIG.

**CHILLAX** (C Grylls) - Over-raced in the lead in the early to middle stages. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that after over-racing, the gelding had been unable to finish the race off once placed under pressure.

**Race 7** | **TEAM WEALLEANS MAIDEN 1600**

**MARINARA** (S Weatherley) - Slow away.

**TE POROPITI** (W Pinn) – Jumped away awkwardly then had to be steadied when crowded shortly after the start, losing ground.

**DOHA** (M Sanson) - Hung outwards throughout and was unable to be fully ridden out in the straight as a result.

**TUMBRIL** (M McNab) – When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no excuse.

**Race 8** | **PUCCINI STANDING AT MAPPERLEY STUD 1200**

**BARRACUDA** (T Thornton) - Restrained to obtain cover after jumping from the outside barrier. Inconvenienced just prior to the winning post.

**BURGUNDY DANCER** (L Satherley) - Began awkwardly and shifted inwards making contact with SUPERACE.

**SUPERACE** (C Grylls) – Contacted at the start.

**BRIAN LAMONT** (B Grylls) - Shifted outwards abruptly just prior to the winning post after being struck with the whip inconveniencing BARRACUDA.

**ZOULANDER** (S Spratt) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding had felt indifferent over the concluding stages. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

**Race 9**

**LASER ELECTRICAL TAURANGA MAIDEN 1200**

**GEE VEE CRYSTAL** (C Grylls) - Jumped away awkwardly.

**CAMINATA** (M McNab) - Crowded leaving the barriers when THE BOOGEYMAN was forced inwards by GOLDEN HUE. Contacted and unbalanced approaching the 150 metres.

**THE BOOGEYMAN** (L Allpress) – Hampered at the start.

**GOLDEN HUE** (B Rogerson) - Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight making contact with CAMINATA approaching the 150 metres with both runners becoming unbalanced.
