The start of Race 1 was delayed approximately 7 minutes due to a miscommunication between veterinary staff and the RIB.

SUPPLEMENTARY

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 THE PAVEMASTERS 2100 MAIDEN

IRISH FLARE (D Montes de Oca) - Hampered shortly after the start losing ground.

MOVINONBYE (A Mudhoo) - Raced three wide without cover passing the 1200 metres. Inconvenienced 800 metres.

HERE COMES TROUBLE (C O'Beirne) - Had to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of IRISH FLARE (D Montes de Oca), which shifted out when not clear, inconveniencing MOVINONBYE. D Montes de Oca was advised to exercise greater care when in similar circumstances.

D Montes de Oca (IRISH FLARE) – Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount IRISH FLARE 6 times prior to the 100 metre mark with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a suspension from the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 9 October up to and including racing on Sunday, 17 October, 5 national riding days.

Race 2 HUMPHRIES CONSTRUCTION 1550 MAIDEN

IRISH PRAYER (L Allpress) - Trainer M Breslin notified Stewards that IRISH PRAYER is in season however he was happy for the mare to run. Inconvenienced 1200 metres.

SMART ATTIRE (L Hemi) - Slow to begin.

KINGFISHER LAD (S O'Malley) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Had to be steadied when improving on to heels passing the 1200 metres, having to shift out, being obliged to race three wide without cover and when doing so briefly inconvenienced IRISH PRAYER.

R Hannam (BIG FRANCK) - Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 3 LAWNMASTER 1000

FLYING ZACK (L Hemi) - Began awkwardly.

GEE STRING (K Hercock)- Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages when being restrained having to be steadied off heels having to shift out dictating PAMPAS over extra ground passing the 800 metres.

PAMPAS (C O'Beirne) - Dictated outwards shortly after the start losing ground. Dictated outwards passing the 800 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 4 RICOH 1000 MAIDEN

BEAU MONDE (F Lazet) - Contacted at the start losing ground. Raced keenly in the early stages, making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

TWOMINUTESINHEAVEN (A Mudhoo) - Contacted at the start losing ground.

O'CEIRINS DELIGHT (M Hudson) - Slow to begin.

DANSEUSE (T Allan) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Forced over extra ground near the 800 metres.

L Kauri (THE BIG BAD WOLF) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted THE BIG BAD WOLF to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of DANSEUSE which was checked and dictated outwards near the 800 metres. After hearing submissions, the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 16 October until the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 23 October, 5 national riding days.

Race 5 LANDMARK HOMES 1200 MAIDEN

SCYLLA (M Singh) - Began awkwardly shifting in, having to be steadied off heels shortly after the start, losing ground. Placed in restricted room having to be steadied passing the 1100 metres.

MONKEY KING (M Hudson) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

SON OF THUNDER (L Hemi) - Raced keenly getting its head up shortly after the start. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

SUNTRIBUTE (S Macnab) - Finished well back. S Macnab advised the mare was never comfortable in the going.

PERFECT POSY (L Allpress) - When questioned regarding performance, rider advised the mare did not handle today's existing track conditions, finishing back.

Race 6 HIGGINS CONCRETE 1400 MAIDEN

SONGSUNGBLU (D Montes de Oca) - Slow to begin. Hampered 1150 metres.

MATINEE (M Hudson) - Slow to begin. Hampered 1150 metres.

MAEBHS RAZEEL (J Riddell) - Began awkwardly then hampered shortly after the start. Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained to find cover. Improved on to heels having to be steadied when racing keenly passing the 1000 metres. Placed in restricted room having to be steadied, making the bend awkwardly passing the 800 metres.

PLATINUM MACHINE (L Allpress) - Improved on to heels having to be steadied, shifting out hampering MATINEE and SONGSUNGBLU, which were both dictated outwards passing the 1150 metres. Placed in restricted room having to be steadied, briefly unbalancing its rider passing the 800 metres. Raced in restricted room approaching the home turn.

SECRET ASSASSIN (C O'Beirne) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages. When questioned regarding performance rider advised the gelding was not comfortable in today's existing track conditions.

Race 7 COURTESY FORD 1400

ATENARTIN (C O'Beirne) - Began awkwardly. When questioned regarding performance, rider advised ATENARTIN had failed to finish the race off and was of the opinion there may be something amiss with the gelding. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

BRIDAL VEIL (F Lazet) - Began awkwardly.

ROSE OF DELGATIE (L Hemi) - Slow to begin.

A Mudhoo (RINGTHEBELLDARCI) - Reminded of his obligation in that he must ride his mount out fully when circumstances permit him to do so.

Race 8 JAPAC HOMES 2100

MR FABULOUS (L Allpress) - Knuckled shortly after the start dislodging rider L Allpress. L Allpress was examined by paramedics and cleared to ride.

HIGH QUALITY (K Hercock) - Slow to begin, then hampered, having to be steadied to avoid the fallen rider. Improved forward to sit three wide without cover passing the 1200 metres.

PRINCE TURBO (F Lazet) - Began awkwardly. Raced wide without cover throughout.

MONDORANI (S Macnab) - Slow to begin.

PLATINUM SPIRIT (L Hemi) - Momentarily held up by the riderless MR FABULOUS passing the 800 metres.

K Hercock (HIGH QUALITY) - Reminded of her obligation in that she must ride her mount out fully to the finish when circumstances permit her to do so.

Race 9 BRAMCO GRANITE & MARBLE 1550

SHOWSHANELLE (C O'Beirne) - Slow to begin then hampered, losing ground.

ESTEFANIA (E McCall) - Slow to begin. Wide without cover throughout.

SASSENACH (R Hannam) - Slow to begin then hampered, losing ground. Hampered when PLATINUM BORDEAUX shifted out under pressure near the 200 metres.

SPEED CALL (S O'Malley) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly throughout. Denied a narrow run near the 200 metres prior to being outwards to improve.

THALASSA (D Bradley) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised the mare had raced keenly and had little left at the finish in the Heavy 11.

THE SEAGULL (J Mudhoo) - Hampered when making contact with SPEED CALL in the back straight.

FRANKENSTEIN (S Macnab) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised the gelding was not suited to the Heavy 11 track conditions.

C Dell (SUPER FLASH) - Admitted a charge of using the whip in 2 consecutive strides on his mount SUPER FLASH in the home straight with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a fine of \$150.
