W Pinn contacted Stewards this morning advising he would not be attending today's meeting due to aggravating a knee injury. W Pinn will now require a medical clearance prior to riding next.

RACE COMMENTS
Race 1 BAY FORD PUNTER OF THE YEAR 2200M
LILLY LAGUNA (M McNab) - Slow away. Held up rounding the final turn and had difficulty obtaining clear running throughout the final straight.
PARKER LEWIS (C Grylls) - Slow away. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had never travelled well and, in his opinion, may be better suited by rain-affected footing.
EMBER ATTACK (K Hercock) - Crowded shortly after the start.
GEHRIG (S Macnab) - Had to be steadied near the 1900 metres when EMBER ATTACK lay in.
KHAFEEF (A Goindasamy) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages and made the crossing near the 1600 metres awkwardly. Held up early in the straight then when shifting outwards to obtain clear running made contact with HEY HEY HEY when improving into a marginal run near the 200 metres. A Goindasamy was advised to exercise care.
HEY HEY HEY (R Elliot) - Shifted outwards to obtain clear running near the 350 metres when not fully clear of BIG BEN, which had to be steadied. Inclined to shift ground under pressure before being contacted near the 200 metres.
BIG BEN (S Weatherley) - Steadied 350 metres.
TRAMORE (L Kauri) - Raced three wide without cover.
KING KHAN (L Allpress) - Raced wide throughout.

HESACITIBOY (A Mudhoo) - Steadied near the 600 metres when improving into restricted room.

R Elliot (HEY HEY HEY) - Issued with a warning after angling his mount outwards near the 350 metres when not fully clear of BIG BEN.

Race 2 | **STELLA ARTOIS 2000M**

MIGHTY CONNOR (S McKay) - Jumped away awkwardly, losing ground.

HAIL DAMAGE (D Johnson) - Slow away.

HE NO OPILIO (L Kauri) - Raced wide when improving forward rounding the first bend before sitting outside the leader near the 1400 metres. Placed in restricted room when weakening near the 400 metres.

ZOE SATIN (A Mudhoo) - Made the crossing near the 1600 metres awkwardly when being taken out by GLOBAL CURRENCY, having to be steadied to avoid the heels of BULLY BOY.

LOWRY (D Danis) - Raced three wide without cover. Placed in restricted room when weakening near the 400 metres.

PASSWORD (D Bradley) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Made contact with LE GRAZIE when attempting to shift outwards approaching the 600 metres.

LE GRAZIE (C Grylls) - Contacted approaching the 600 metres.

ENGLISH GAMBLER (T Harris) - Lay out rounding the final turn.

CROSS ROADS (L Allpress) - Placed in restricted room rounding the final turn.

GLOBAL CURRENCY (M McNab) - Commenced to lay in when placed under pressure entering the straight and was unable to be fully ridden out.

J Fawcett (JUDY'S SONG) - Admitted a charge in that she struck her mount JUDY'S SONG 8 times prior to the 100 metres with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a fine of \$1,000.

R Elliot (TARWYN) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount TARWYN 6 times prior to the 100 metres with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a suspension of his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Sunday, 17 October until the conclusion of racing on Monday, 25 October, 6 national riding days.

Race 3 | **HASTINGS – HEART OF HAWKES BAY 1400M**

MINNIE MOUSE (L Kauri) - Slow away.

KALUANUI (L Hemi) - Jumped away awkwardly making contact with the hind quarters of WOLFGANG, which became unbalanced, which resulted in KALUANUI being crowded for a distance losing ground.

WOLFGANG (S McKay) - Unbalanced when contacted at the start.

REIGN IT IN (D Johnson) - Over-raced passing the 1200 metres, continuing to race ungenerously through the middle stages.

BELCLARE (M McNab) - After being caught wide without cover was ridden forward to lead near the 800 metres.

HOOKS (S Macnab) - Had to be firmly restrained off the heels of **BELCLARE** (M McNab) near the 700 metres when the pace eased.

NEWSTALK (D Turner) - Raced three wide without cover.

NETANYAHU (J Riddell) - Lay inwards under pressure early in the straight.

MONZA (C Grylls) - Steadied to shift across the heels of **NETANYAHU** near the 300 metres.

GAMESTER - Collapsed post-race after returning to the enclosure being immediately attended to by on-course veterinarians and was found to be deceased from a suspected cardiovascular event.

M McNab (**BELCLARE**) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards when only marginally clear of **HOOKS** and steadying near the 700 metres.

T Harris (**SOLID IMPACT**) – Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount **SOLID IMPACT** six times prior to the 100 metres with the matter being adjourned until tomorrow’s race meeting at Rotorua.

Race 4	NZB READY TO RUN SALE TRAINERS SERIES 3YO 1300M
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MERCURIAL (E Leighton) - Jumped away awkwardly and lay out crowding **IVANKA** onto **UNUSUAL COUNTESS**, which both lost ground. Badly held up near the 300 metres having to be steadied for a distance and shift outwards across heels before obtaining clear running approaching the 100 metres.

IVANKA (K Hercock) - Crowded start losing ground. Over-raced in the middle stages on a moderate tempo. Steadied off heels near the 600 metres.

UNUSUAL COUNTESS (L Allpress) - Crowded start losing ground.

WAKARI (D Johnson) - Slow away.

PURE IMAGINATION (C Grylls) - Commenced to over-race near the 1000 metres then racing ungenerously for a distance making the bending near the 800 metres awkwardly before being allowed to improve forward to lead.

PALAMOS (T Harris) - Over-raced middle stages.

Riders E Leighton (**MERCURIAL**) and R Elliot (**DRUM MAJOR**) were questioned regarding the steadying of the pace in the middle stages. R Elliot advised that after riding his mount forward from a wide barrier to lead he had then opted to steady when **MERCURIAL** was maintaining a position to his inside. E Leighton explained that after taking up a prominent position inside **DRUM MAJOR** once her mount had been left in front it had raced very greenly shying near the 700 metres then ducking away from the running rail near the 600 metres. The explanations of both riders were noted.

T Harris (**PALAMOS**) – Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount **PALAMOS** six times prior to the 100 metres with the matter being adjourned until tomorrow’s race meeting at Rotorua.

Race 5	DAN D’ESPOSITO MEMORIAL MILE 1600M
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MAASIR (D Johnson) - Slow away.

CHAMPERS (S Macnab) - Slow away.

JOY ALONE (J Riddell) - Raced three wide without cover.

SHE'S A MANEATER (M McNab) - Lay in entering the final straight contacting PASSIONE, which was forced inwards across the heels of TANNAHILL. SHE'S A MANEATER continued to lay inwards for the remainder of the straight being contacted by PASSIONE when that runner shifted outwards near the 175 metres.

PASSIONE (S Weatherley) - Contacted and forced inwards across heels near the 350 metres then had difficulty obtaining clear running until shifting outwards making contact with SHE'S A MANEATER near the 175 metres.

FLAVIUS (T Yanagida) - Held up for a distance approaching the 300 metres being unable to obtain clear running for the remainder of the race.

KICK ON (R Elliot) - Held up for a distance passing the 200 metres.

Race 6	RED BADGE SPRING SPRINT (G3) 1400M
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OUR ALLEY CAT (S Weatherley) - Jumped away awkwardly hampering GUILLADA. Badly held up in the straight until near the 100 metres.

GUILLADA (D Hirini) - Hampered start losing ground.

GERMANICUS (S Macnab) - Restrained early after jumping from a wide barrier.

HYPNOS (R Elliot) - Restrained early after jumping from a wide barrier. Rider reported the gelding had hung over the final 600 metres.

MAGIC INCANTO (M Hudson) - Raced three wide without cover.

COLORADO STAR (L Hemi) - Held up early in the straight until near the 200 metres and was inclined to lay inwards.

TABATA (C Grylls) - Held up near the 350 metres and continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the final 100 metres.

SHADOWS CAST (A Mudhoo) - Steadied to avoid heels just short of the finish.

BRANDO (D Johnson) - When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse other than being second up today. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

STREAK OF POWER (R Hannam) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised the gelding had come to the end of its run over the concluding stages but would derive benefit from today's race.

Race 7	TUMU GROUP 1400M
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BEA A ROCA (S Weatherley) - Crowded leaving the barriers. Awkwardly placed near the 150 metres.

KING FAROUK (S Macnab) - Slow away. Steadied near the 600 metres. Held up passing the 400 metres.

MY FATHER'S GUN (D Turner) – Slow away. Awkwardly placed near heels passing the 175 metres.

SUGAH SWEET (R Elliot) – Slow Away

OVERSTAYER (R Hannam) – Restrained early after jumping from the outside barrier

WHITE LIGHTNING (L Allpress) – Restrained early from a wide barrier.

SHOCKALLIA (J Riddell) - Raced three wide without cover.

FOUR QUEENS (C Grylls) - Clipped a heel of SHOCKALLIA and blundered badly near the 500 metres after being dictated outwards by DEEP BEAUTY.

PARISIAN POPPY (T Yanagida) - Hampered near the 500 metres. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 200 metres.

ST NANCY (A Goindasamy) - Hampered near the 500 metres.

ALTERNATE (M McNab) - Crowded concluding stages.

DEEP BEAUTY (D Johnson) - Crowded concluding stages.

ISLA JAY (E Leighton) - Held up for a distance until near the 300 metres. Improved into tight run near the 75 metres making contact with ALTERNATE when that runner lay in away from DEEP BEAUTY, which in turn was shifting away from SHOCKALLIA. All four runners then became unbalanced shortly before the finish.

Following the race objections were lodged by the connections of the 2nd placed horse DEEP BEAUTY and the 3rd placed horse ISLA JAY against the 1st placed horse SHOCKALLIA alleging interference over the concluding stages. After viewing films and hearing submissions the Adjudicative Committee dismissed both protests.

ALTERNATE (M McNab) - Unbalanced when contacted concluding stages.

DEEP BEAUTY (D Johnson) - Unbalanced when contacted concluding stages.

LELAWALA (D Danis) - Dropped out over the final 200 metres to finish a distant last. A post-race veterinary inspection of LELAWALA found the mare to have bled from both nostrils and now being subject to the mandatory stand down periods. LELAWALA shall not be ridden in exercise for a period of two months or start in any Race or Trial for a period of three months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Veterinarian.

D Johnson (DEEP BEAUTY) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount to shift outwards near the 500 metres when not sufficiently clear of FOUR QUEENS which was dictated outwards clipping a heel of SHOCKALLIA and blundering badly. After hearing submissions, the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of her license to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Monday 25 October until the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 3 November, 7 national riding days.

J Riddell (SHOCKALLIA) - Issued with a warning after using the whip in two consecutive strides on SHOCKALLIA near the 100 metres with Stewards taking into account his clear record.

Race 8	LIVAMOL CLASSIC (G1) 2040M
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BEAUDEN (R Elliot) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

MASETTO (T Yanagida) – Was inclined to get its head up when over racing in the early and middle stages. Checked to avoid the heels HARLECH near the 1500 metres.

HARLECH (M McNab) - Held up rounding the final turn and early in the final straight before obtaining clear running near the 250 metres.

RITANI (S Weatherley) - Eased down over the concluding stages, with a postrace veterinary examination finding the mare to be 3/5 lame in the right foreleg with a suspected suspensory injury. A veterinary clearance is now required prior to racing again.

IMELDA MARY (S McKay) – Was under pressure passing the 800 metres shortly after losing contact with the remainder of the field finishing a distant last. Underwent a postrace veterinary examination which revealed a poor rate of recovery.

L Hemi (LLANACORD) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted LLANACORD to shift inwards near the 1500 metres when not sufficiently clear of HARLECH which was dictated inwards into the line of MASETTO which was checked. After hearing submissions, the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 24 October until the conclusion of racing on Tuesday 2 November 7 national riding days.

T Harris (PRISE DE FER) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount PRISE DE FER six times prior to the 100 metres with the matter being adjourned until tomorrow race meeting at Rotorua.

D Johnson (SAVY YONG BLONK) - Admitted a charge in that she struck her mount in two consecutive strides on two occasions in the final 100 metres. After hearing submissions, the Adjudicative Committee imposed a fine of \$3,500.

C Phelan (BIG MIKE) - Admitted a charge in that he omitted a towel when saddling being fined \$300 by the Adjudicative Committee.

Race 9	POWER FARMING 1200M
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EXALTATION (J Kamaruddin) - Slow away.

WICKET MAIDEN (L Hemi)- Raced three wide without cover.

TOP BRASS (N Parmar) – Was inclined to shift ground under pressure in the straight.

MISS AOTEAROA (T Harris) - Held up in the final straight until shifting outwards to obtain clear running near the 175 metres.

MARIA FARINA (S Weatherley) – Held up near the 300 metres then shifting ground back to the inside to obtain clear running.

LAPEL (D Danis) – Held up near the 100 metres having to shift outwards across heels to obtain clear running, inconveniencing RANGER.

RANGER (K Hercock) – Inconvenienced having to be steadied to avoid the heels of LAPEL passing the 100 metres. D Danis was advised to exercise care.

SHEZZACATCH (L Allpress) - Had to be steadied near the 150 metres when MARIA FARINA was taken in by TOP BRASS. N Parmar was advised that he must make a greater effort to maintain a straight line in the running.

Race 10	BOSTOCK NZ SPRING CARNIVAL FINALE 1500M
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NO ROCK NO POP (A Mudhoo) - Declared a late scratching at 5.36pm after becoming cast in the barriers. Connections were advised the mare is now required to barrier trial prior to racing next.

LANGKAWI (L Allpress) - Which was in the adjacent barrier to NO ROCK NO POP was removed from its barrier to undergo a veterinary inspection before being cleared fit to run. Race wide throughout. Crowded 200 metres when AROMATIC shifted outwards. J Kamaruddin will be advised to exercise care.

FEELIN' FANCY (D Johnson) - Slow away. Raced in restricted room passing the 300 metres.

ANGARIA (E Leighton) - Began awkwardly shifting inwards hampering PACKING JOY. Crowded 200 metres becoming unbalanced.

PACKING JOY (C Grylls) - Hampered start losing ground.

JEWEL OF PATCH (D Hirini) - Raced three wide without cover.

AROMATIC (J Kamaruddin) - Shifted out near the 200 metres crowding LANGKAWI.

REAL SLIM TRADIE (K Hercock) - Steadied off heels near the 500 metres. Held up entering the final straight and did not obtain clear running until passing the 200 metres. Received post-race veterinary treatment for a laceration to the right hind consistent to being galloped on in the running.
