Rider D Bothamley advised on the morning of the races that he was unable to make the weight for DEVIOUS in Race 6 and was replaced as per schedule above. D Bothamley admitted a breach of Rule 330(3)(c) with the Adjudicator imposing a fine of \$200 under the Minor Infringement Schedule.

Race 11 – GERRY RUSH MEMORIAL MAIDEN (2200m)

Trainer J Burrows advised that KHANT REID which had raced disappointingly has now been retired from her stable as a racing proposition.

Race 1	RYAL BUSH TRANSPORT GET WELL GARY MAIDEN 1600m
<p>DA VINCI GIRL (K Chowdhoo) - Crowded on jumping losing ground. Held up rounding the final bend then lay in early in the run home.</p> <p>KENKI (B Grylls) - Shifted inwards on jumping crowding inside runner.</p> <p>FOUR BY FOUR (T Jonker) - Over raced in the early stages. Hampered passing the 1000 metres. Made the bend awkwardly passing the 900 metres shifting inwards to obtain cover.</p> <p>EULOGY SHOW (S Wynne) - Raced wide throughout. Hampered passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>KLEAR THE DECK (R Cuneen) - Had to be steadied when over racing passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>SERAPHIC (B Murray) - When being steadied to avoid heels near the 1000 metres shifted out hampering FOUR BY FOUR and EULOGY SHOW. Not persevered with in the home straight, with the rider reporting that the gelding had been difficult to steer throughout.</p>	
Race 2	COCHRANES OF CANTERBURY 1600m
<p>CAMINO ROCOSO (R Mudhoo) - Restrained from its wide barrier draw in the early stages.</p> <p>FRANKIE THE FOX (K Mudhoo) - Bounded at the start losing ground.</p> <p>THE GROWLER (B Grylls) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>GOODANYA (T Newman) - Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>DAWN PARADE (K Asano) - Crowded and checked passing the 900 metres.</p> <p>S Wynne (STOKERS ROCK) - Reminded of her obligations when using the whip on a runner out of contention.</p> <p>G Jogoo (RAINMAN) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he directed his mount RAINMAN inwards when not sufficiently clear of DAWN PARADE which was checked near the 900 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of G Jogoo's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 23 October until the conclusion of racing on 30 October, 6 national days.</p>	
Race 3	RD PETROLEUM MAIDEN 1200m
<p>FOLKTALE (R Mudhoo) - Crowded on jumping losing ground.</p> <p>RAARDY RAAR (D Bothamley) - Began awkwardly losing some ground.</p> <p>COMMITMENT (T Comignaghi) - Shifted outwards abruptly on jumping crowding outside runner.</p> <p>JAMIESON'S TIPPLE (T Newman) - Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>MERITORIOUS (C Barnes) - Held up early in the run home.</p> <p>CHRISTOPHE VERMEER (B Grylls) - Held up near the 220 metres for several strides.</p>	

DONEGAL LAD (T Moseley) - Fractious in its barrier charging its gate prior to the start. Raced keenly while leading. Shied outwards abruptly near the 150 metres and was eased down by its rider. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. Following a veterinary inspection DONEGAL LAD was confirmed to have bled. DONEGAL LAD shall not be ridden in exercise for a period of two months or start in any Race or Trial for a period of three months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Veterinarian.

Race 4 | **NORM & LEANNE STEWART 2200m**

JIMINY CRICKET (K Asano) - Slow to begin.

STOP MAKING SENSE (B Grylls) - Raced wide in the early stages. Crowded and checked passing the 200 metres.

ZAKUNDA (S Wynne) - Got its head up when over racing for a distance in the early stages. Held up in the early stages of the run home. Crowded and checked near the 200 metres.

JACK KNOWS BEST (R Cuneen) - Raced keenly in the early stages. Held up in the early stages of the run home.

THISTLE (T Comignaghi) - Had to be steadied away from the heels of the runner in front when over racing passing the 1950 metres.

KAJINO (T Jonker) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

JACK BE QUICK (R Mudhoo) - Steadied off heels passing the 900 metres.

MOIRAS TOWN (T Moseley) - Lay out under pressure early in the run home dictating several runners wider before being straightened by its rider. Shifted in under pressure near the 200 metres.

HEY SOUL SISTER (G Jogoo) - Held up near the 250 metres having to shift ground outwards.

T Moseley (MOIRAS TOWN) - Defended a charge of careless riding alleging that he permitted his mount MOIRAS TOWN to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of PAMIR which was dictated inwards onto ZAKUNDA and STOP MAKING SENSE which were both checked near the 200 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicator upheld the charge and imposed a suspension of T Moseley's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 23 October until the conclusion of racing on 29 October, 5 national days.

Race 5 | **PAUL BRAND PENDENE FARMS 2200m**

OCEANS AWAY (B Murray) - Restrained to the rear on jumping.

LETSBRINGTON (G Jogoo) - Got its head up when over racing in the early stages.

SEVEN AAJES (K Asano) - Over raced in the early stages. Held up early in the run home.

LEITRIM LAD (T Moseley) - When asked to comment on the improved performance, rider T Moseley advised that the gelding had appreciated the step up in distance today and a senior rider on board.

R Mudhoo (DUNHILL) - Issued with a warning after using his whip with an action which raised the rider's arm above shoulder height.

Race 6 | **MCCREA PAINTERS & DECORATORS ASHBURTON CUP 1200m**

SCARFI (K Mudhoo) - Fractious in its barrier prior to the start. A post race veterinary inspection revealed superficial wounds to the head area.

OUR GIRL GILLY (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly losing ground and was then urged forward to lead near the 800 metres.

ROCK SENSATION (K Chowdhoo) - Slow to begin.

NEED I SAY MORE (S Toolooa) - Briefly steadied near the 800 metres when MINT JULEP was dictated inwards briefly by OUR GIRL GILLY (S Wynne) which was improving forward to lead. S Wynne was advised to exercise greater care. When asked to comment on the performance, rider advised that the gelding had had a nice run throughout but when placed under pressure had failed to let down and had been disappointing.

DEVIOUS (L Callaway) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

JOHNNY JONES (R Mudhoo) - Steadied near the 600 metres when awkwardly placed on heels.

LIVE DRAMA (T Comignaghi) - Lay outwards and away from inside runner passing the 300 metres making firm contact with SUMMER MONSOON.

SUMMER MONSOON (K Asano) - Bumped from the inside passing the 300 metres. Rider dropped his outside rein when it became entangled with his whip near the 150 metres. Shifted inwards under pressure near the 50 metres placing LIVE DRAMA in restricted room. K Asano was advised to exercise greater care and straighten his mount sooner than he had on this occasion.

Race 7 | **RAINERS IRRIGATION 1400m**

NAMIBIA MISS (T Moseley) - Fractious in its barrier prior to the start. Slow to begin.

DIORADELLE (S Wynne) - Crowded on jumping losing ground. Held up early in the straight and had to shift ground outwards passing the 250 metres to find clear racing room.

RADIANT ROSIE (K Chowdhoo) - Shifted in abruptly on jumping crowding inside runner.

REPULSE (L Callaway) - Got its head up when being steadied in the early stages.

REACT (B Grylls) - Raced wide throughout.

FETTERCAIRN (T Comignaghi) - When asked to comment on the performance of this favoured runner, rider advised that the mare had been disappointing and could offer no tangible excuses, however she has suggested to connections that they make some gear changes.

Race 8 | **BARNESWOOD FARM STAKES (G3) 1400m**

DORINGO (C Barnes) - Shifted out at the start crowding outside runners.

I WISH I WIN (R Mudhoo) - Crowded at the start losing ground. Placed in restricted room and briefly buffeted between GLORY BOUND and ART DE TRIOMPHE passing the 800 metres, with the rider reporting that the gelding racing for the first time in blinkers had panicked when in restricted room and had shifted in and away from runners to his inside and outside for a distance eventually having to be restrained passing the 700 metres to avoid heels.

GLORY BOUND (B Grylls) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

THE RADIANT ONE (T Comignaghi) - Raced wide in the early stages.

ART DE TRIOMPHE (K Williams) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

HYSPEC (L Callaway) - Shied passing the 125 metres shifting in unbalancing the rider for a short distance, with the rider reporting that the filly had observed something on the inside of the track and reacted poorly going off stride. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination when showing signs of mild cholic and was treated by the on-course veterinarian.

R Mudhoo (I WISH I WIN) - Spoken to advisedly to ensure he rides his mounts out to the line when circumstances permit after he was observed to relax his ride in the final strides to hold third by a very small margin.

Race 9

VALACHI DOWNS 1400m

SAIGON HOT NIGHT (M Taylor) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Stewards spoke to apprentice rider M Taylor in the presence of the Apprentice Riding Mentor in regard to her mount losing contact with the field, particularly through the middle stages. M Taylor advised that after being crowded at the start the gelding had been flat and lost ground in the early and middle stages on a good tempo despite her efforts, adding that SAIGON HOT NIGHT was probably looking for tracks with more moisture and further distance. Stewards noted M Taylor's comments but advised her that in future in similar circumstances she would be expected to show more vigour to keep her mounts in touch with the body of the field.

RADEGAST (R Mudhoo) - Badly crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

SHOCK PROSPECT (C Barnes) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

SENTIENT (T Moseley) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

CLOONEY (J Laking) - Lay outwards shortly after the start crowding several runners to the outside.

LOVINGYOURWORK (B Murray) - Over raced in the early stages and had to be shifted outwards across heels passing the 1100 metres.

MISTER RELIABLE (B Grylls) - Raced wide without cover in the early stages and was obliged to improve wide rounding the final bend.

LINEDANCKING (D Bothamley) - When asked to comment on the apparent improved performance, trainer S Woodsford advised that the gelding had been racing well prior to its previous start when it had been trapped wide throughout, and had benefited from being able to race handy to the lead today after beginning well from the wide draw.

Race 10

MIDLANDS NUTRITIONAL 1400m

SUPREME KHAN (R Mudhoo) – Fractious in its barrier prior to the start. Raced wide in the early stages.

EXCHANGE (J Lowry) - Very slow to begin and lost contact with the body of the field in the early stages despite the efforts of the rider.

YAMUNA (K Mudhoo) - Slow to begin then taken in to obtain cover shortly after the start.

PROVIDENCEPROVIDES (K Asano) - Bounded as the start was effected losing some ground.

LARPOWER (D Bothamley) - Raced wide without cover in the early stages.

HARBOURSIDE (B Grylls) - Had some trouble obtaining clear racing room in the early stages of the run home.

BENEFICIAL (J Laking) - Held up from the 200 metres and went to the line not fully tested by its rider.

Trainer **D Miller** (YAMUNA) was fined \$50 under the Minor Infringement Schedule for late declaration of rider.
