<p>Hawke's Bay Racing Inc – Saturday, 16 October 2021</p> <p>T Harris – Admitted charges in that he struck his respective mounts with the whip six times prior to the 100 metres in Race 3 (SOLID IMPACT), Race 4 (PALAMOS) and Race 8 (PRISE DE FER). After viewing all three films and hearing submissions the Adjudicator suspended T Harris's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing today, Sunday 17 October up to and including racing on Sunday 24 October, 5 national riding days, and in addition imposed a fine of \$750.</p>

Race 1	RYDGES HOTEL ROTORUA MAIDEN 1400
<p>PANDEMIC (T Harris) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>PARIS RUBY (T Newman) - Hampered shortly after the start losing ground. Over-raced in the early stages when being restrained.</p> <p>EVA AMELIA (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>SAPPORO (R Elliot) - Slow to begin. Over-raced when being restrained near the 1100 metres.</p> <p>TOFFEE (L Allpress) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised that after being taken on in front the mare had been quickly beaten once placed under pressure and that it may be better suited to more rain affected ground.</p> <p>B Grylls (ZAKHAN) - Spoken to with regards to her whip use on a runner out of contention.</p>	
Race 2	TW MOORE 3YO (1215 metres)
<p>Race 2 was delayed due to DRAGON BISCUIT requiring farrier attention at the barrier.</p> <p>GAME NIGHT (D Danis) - Began awkwardly shifting outwards.</p> <p>RED VIENNA (A Goindasamy) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.</p> <p>KORUBELA MISS (L Hemi) - Began awkwardly then crowded losing ground. Had to be firmly restrained when improving onto heels near the 1000 metres.</p> <p>DRAGON BISCUIT (E Leighton) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>FUNNY GIRL (C Grylls) – Over-raced in the middle stages.</p>	

HABANA (K Asano) – Over-raced in the middle stages.

AFTER PARTY (M McNab) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that in his opinion the filly is better suited to more rain affected footing.

Race 3

LANCE LAWSON 1215

ROC CHA (B Grylls) - Some time after the running of this race Stewards were advised by the stable representative that they were of the belief that their runner engaged in Race 4 (ALEGRE) had mistakenly been presented and ran in Race 3 as ROC CHA. An inspection and identity check by Stewards of both horses which were both 5 year old chestnut mares, confirmed this to be the case. ALEGRE was immediately scratched from Race 4 with TAB Raceday Control being contacted and ROC CHA retrospectively declared a late scratching at 3.20pm with any bets made on this runner eligible to be refunded. An enquiry into the circumstances of how this error had occurred was adjourned.

VALETTI (S Weatherley) - Began awkwardly.

MONTANA MIST (E McCall) – Refused to leave the barriers as the start was affected, taking no part in the race. Connections were advised that MONTANA MIST would now be required to barrier trial prior to racing next.

HEZA LOOKER (E Leighton) – Raced three wide without cover.

QUICK PREVIEW (L Allpress) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the straight.

T Yanagida (CAPALDI) - Spoken to with regards to his whip use on a runner out of contention.

Race 4

FAULKNER DRAINAGE 1400

ALEGRE (B Grylls) - Declared a late scratching at 3.01 pm after Stewards became aware that the mare had been mistakenly saddled and ran in Race 3 as ROC CHA.

LOCOMOTION (D Johnson) – Underwent a veterinary inspection on arrival at the barriers and was declared a late scratching at 3.07 pm as it was found to be 3/5 lame in the right hind leg with a veterinary clearance required prior to racing next.

UP 'N' GONE (N Parmar) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

LA VELOCITA (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin. Briefly held up entering the final straight.

PRINCE OF TALLIN (T Harris) - Restrained behind runners shortly after the start. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

BOSTON STRONG BOY (R Elliot) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

Race 5

SWEYNESSE STAKES (G3) (1215 metres)

TAVI MAC (D Johnson) - Slow to begin.

SHEEZALLMINE (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin.

PACKING ROCKSTAR (T Harris) - Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained to obtain cover. Became awkwardly placed on heels having to be restrained when JE SUIS TIGER shifted in when not fully clear passing the 1000 metres and over-raced for a distance.

T Newman (JE SUIS TIGER) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift inwards passing the 1000 metres when not fully clear of PACKING ROCKSTAR which was racing keenly then getting its head up when having to be firmly restrained.	
Race 6	SWEENEY TOWNSEND INSURANCE BROKERS LTD 1400
GALLARDO (K Asano) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.	
FRANCESCA (S Weatherley) - Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection including an endoscopic examination which found the mare to have bled. FRANCESCA shall not be ridden in exercise for a period of two months or start in any race or trial for a period of three months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Veterinarian.	
NOD OF THE HEAD (J Riddell) - Lay out rounding the final turn.	
AOTEA LAD (N Parmar) - Lay in under pressure in the straight.	
MARCHIONESS (M McNab) - Briefly held up approaching the 200 metres.	
Race 7	STAPHANOS CLASSIC (Listed Race) (1950 metres)
RIVER RUN (K Asano) – Restrained to obtain cover after jumping from the outside barrier. Checked when placed in restricted room to the inside of the weakening MAJOR TOM near the 400 metres.	
MAJOR TOM (B Grylls) – Raced wide without cover. Crowded when weakening near the 450 metres.	
BEAUDZ WELL (S Weatherley) – Shifted outwards under pressure inside the final 100 metres.	
QUIZ KID (E Leighton) – Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which found the gelding to have bled, also suffering from cardiac arrhythmia. QUIZ KID shall not be ridden in exercise for a period of two months or start in any race or trial for a period of three months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Veterinarian.	
TWO MADISON (A Goindasamy) - Steadied when improving onto heels near the 50 metres having to shift ground again having to be steadied away from heels just short of the finish.	
SWEET CLEMENTINE (C Grylls) – Held up rounding the final turn.	
Race 8	WAITOMO FUELS 1950
IFFIE SHOWS (J Riddell) - Jumped away awkwardly.	
TOUCH THE CLOUDS (A Goindasamy) – Raced wide in the early stages.	
SPEED CALL (R Elliot) - Got its head up when being steadied in the early stages.	
NITRATE (E McCall) – Raced wide without cover from the 1000 metres.
