Race 5 LAMB PETERS PRINT GREYTOWN MAIDEN 1400M

LISTONIAN (J Riddell) – Co-trainer Mr J Benner advised Stewards the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of the gelding, however, LISTONIAN will no longer be considered as a racing prospect for the stable.

Race 8 LIVAMOL CLASSIC (G1) 2040M

RITANI (S Weatherley) – Co-trainer Mrs K Taplin advised Stewards the swelling to the right foreleg has subsided, however, RITANI will now be retired from racing and go to stud.

IMELDA MARY (S McKay) – Trainer Mr W Hillis reported to Stewards that he was satisfied with the post-race condition of the mare and it is his intention to continue on with IMELDA MARY'S current preparation.

RACE COMMENTS**Race 1 THE MEAT COMPANY DANNEVIRKE MAIDEN 2200**

TSUNAMI (L Allpress) - Slow away.

IRISH FLARE (D Montes de Oca) - Held up early stages of the home straight.

ESTABLISHMENT (S O'Malley) - When questioned into the run of ESTABLISHMENT, which finished last, S O'Malley advised the gelding pulled up in normal post-race condition and was disappointing.

L Hemi (IAN'S LEGACY) - Spoken to regarding her whip action inside the final 100 metres.

Race 2 MURRAY CONTRACTORS MAIDEN 1200

MARGARET ELIZABETH (J Mudhoo) - Slow away. Raced greenly early stages.

BRECKENRIDGE (M Hudson) - Began awkwardly, bumping ONE DREAM ONE SOUL.

ONE DREAM ONE SOUL (K Hercock) - Bumped at start.

BORN TO RUN (S McKay) - Briefly over-raced passing the 550 metres.

GUCCI BELT (L Allpress) - Slow away. Raced in restricted room throughout the home straight and went to the line without being tested.

LADY HYSTERIA (L Hemi) - Raced wide throughout.

BEAN A PLEASURE (R Hannam) - Shifted out under pressure over the final stages and had to be steadied for several strides off the heels of LADY HYSTERIA, which shifted in marginally. BEAN A PLEASURE was then angled outwards to improve near the finish.

FREE RANGE (S Macnab) - When questioned rider advised the mare was unsuited to today's Slow 9 track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slow recovery.

Race 3 MERRYLEES HOTEL 1200

SUNLIT LANE (K Hercock) - Slow away.

SHARKY (M Singh) - Tightened near the 1000 metres when MAGNESS lay inwards simultaneously as TANGO LOVE lay outwards. Disappointed, finishing well back. When questioned, rider was of the opinion the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing. Connections confirmed SHARKY would be spelled.

MAGNESS (A Mudhoo) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

LINCOLN'S KRUZ (J Riddell) - Made the final turn awkwardly and lay outwards on the home corner. Checked when attempting a narrow run to the inside of ANSU, which shifted inwards when struck with the whip near the 250 metres, which resulted in ANSU and LINCOLN'S KRUZ jostling for several strides.

ANSU (R Hannam) - Steadied off heels passing the 900 metres. Shifted inwards near the 250 metres, making contact with LINCOLN'S KRUZ, becoming unbalanced.

STEPTOE (S O'Malley) - Raced midfield throughout and failed to finish the race off to any extent, finishing well back. S O'Malley had no excuse and advised the gelding was disappointing.

Race 4 | **MIKE JAMES PLUMBING MAIDEN 1200**

VESPERADO - Late scratching at 1.15pm on veterinary advice after incurring an injury in the tie-ups.

SWEET JINEEN (L Allpress) - Slow away, then over-raced for a distance in the back straight. Made the final turn awkwardly and ran wide.

NOT A BRASS RAZOO (F Lazet) - Began awkwardly. Lay in under pressure in the home straight.

MISS ROSIE (D Hirini) - Restrained from a wide draw.

Race 5 | **DDS ELECTRICAL MIDEN 1400**

EXTRAORDINAIRE (S Macnab) - Rider was examined and cleared to ride by St John personnel after incurring a minor injury at the barrier. Bumped start.

RELY ON ME (M Hudson) - Began awkwardly, bumping EXTRAORDINAIRE.

CATCHOXLATER (J Mudhoo) - Slow away. Steadied off heels passing the 800 metres.

TOBKAY (A Mudhoo) - Raced wide throughout.

THE BLIKSEM (D Bradley) - Steadied approaching the 800 metres when improving onto heels. Held up early in the home straight.

KHALFANI (K Hercock) - Held up for the majority of the home straight.

JAKK IRISH (S McKay) - Raced in restricted room throughout the home straight.

SUBTLE POINT (M Singh) - Denied a narrow run near the 250 metres, then held up for some distance, gaining clear running passing the 200 metres.

ZENA ROCKS (L Allpress) - When questioned rider was of the opinion the filly was unsuited to the track which she described as "holding". A post-race veterinary examination was clear.

Race 6 | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE MAIDEN 1400**

SCYLLA (D Bradley) - Slow away. Finished well back and was disappointing. D Bradley was of the opinion the mare may have come into season.

VISHAKHA (K Hercock) - Slow away.

OCEANIDES (A Mudhoo) - Skied its head when being steadied shortly after the start while over-racing.

MADRID (L Hemi) - Raced keenly in the back straight.

LADY VADAMOS (M Hudson) - Raced fiercely in the early to middle stages and had to be continuously steadied for some distance. Trainer L Somervell advised Stewards consideration would be given to removing the blinkers prior to LADY VADAMOS starting next.

BELLE ADAIRE (C Dell) - Inclined to shift out under pressure in the home straight.	
Race 7	PROPERTY BROKERS PAHIATUA/WOODVILLE 1400
FIANO (A Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly. Inconvenienced passing the 100 metres when PLATINUM STAR (R Hannam) shifted out when improving to its inside. R Hannam was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.	
TAKE THAT (M Singh) - Slow away. Bumped 200 metres.	
LIFFEY (S Macnab) - Raced wide throughout.	
HINEPARA (S McKay) - Shifted out when struck with the whip passing the 200 metres, bumping TAKE THAT.	
MISS SHER NAN (D Bradley) - Gave ground from the 650 metres with D Bradley not persevering with the mare in the home straight when he considered something may be amiss. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.	
S Macnab (LIFFEY) - Admitted a charge of using the whip in 2 consecutive strides on her mount LIFFEY in the home straight with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a fine of \$125.	
Race 8	MACDOUGALL AGRI SERVICES MAIDEN 1600
THE RATTLIN' BOG (S O'Malley) - Slow away.	
BATTLE SECRET (J Riddell) - Hung outwards making the first turn. When questioned into the run of BATTLE SECRET, J Riddell advised the gelding failed to respond to any extent when placed under pressure after racing on the pace throughout and was disappointing.	
SHE'S SO RELIABLE (L Hemi) - Over-raced passing the 1400 metres.	
A Mudhoo (FLYING HABIT) - Shown footage of his ride in the presence of the Riding Master and issued with a warning after making a celebratory gesture on the post and in doing so allowed his mount to shift inwards and make contact with the running rail.	
Race 9	MARTY & DI'S CATERING 1600
G Haigh (THE SEAGULL) - Issued with a warning for presenting THE SEAGULL without declared gear (blinkers).	
TE AWE AWE (M Hudson) - Slow away. Raced wide without cover throughout and was forced five wide to make its run rounding the home turn when THE SEAGULL improved to its inside.	
FIDDYAFORTNIGHT (S Macnab) - The left side winker became detached passing the 300 metres.	
TIRO (F Lazet) - Held up for a short distance near the 200 metres.	
ONE TO DIE FOR (K Hercock) - Hung throughout. Trainer K Gray will consider altering the mare's gear prior to its next start and dropping back to 1400 metres.
