Race 6 EMAC ELECTRICAL 1600

TIGER FIRE (D Johnson) - Co-trainer Mr A Forsman reported to Stewards, although satisfied with the post-race condition of TIGER FIRE, the horse has now been gelded. A Forsman further advised it is the stables intention to continue on with the gelding's current preparation.

VALZACELLA (M McNab) - Co-trainer Ms J Ritchie advised Stewards VALZACELLA underwent a veterinary examination on Thursday 19 October, which included a dynamic scope and endoscopic examination, which were both clear. J

Ritchie further advised, the stable will look to make gear changes prior to the mare's next race day start, however, VALZACELLA has now be sent for a brief freshen up.

LA FAVORITA (C Grylls) - Made the first turn near the 1800 metres awkwardly.

LED ZED (E Leighton) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Got its head up and raced ungenerously when being steadied off heels near the 1500 metres.

FUNNY GAME (R Elliot) – Raced wide throughout. When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse advising that it was his understanding from connections that the gelding was now likely to be retired from their stable.

WILEWINK (T Newman) - Raced in restricted room near the 250 metres when EAGLE HUNTER was taken out by CIAMBELLA which was laying out. Steadied over the concluding stages when crowded between CIAMBELLA and LED ZED which both shifted ground. Prior to the authorisation of dividends connections viewed Stewards films before electing not to proceed with a protest.

THE IRISH GAMBLER (K Asano) - Gave ground from the 600 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse other than the gelding possibly being better suited to rain affected footing. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which did not reveal any significant abnormality other than the gelding having lost the right hind plate.

B Grylls (MAKTASTIC) - Admitted a charge in that she struck her mount six times prior to the 100 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspensions of B Grylls' licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 7 November up to and including racing on Sunday 14 November, 5 national riding days.

Race 4MAINFREIGHT 1400REGAZZO (S Weatherley) - Slow away.

GOLDEN KIWI (C Grylls) - Slow away. Briefly raced in restricted room near the 300 metres when AMALFI PRINCE lay in and away from MACH SCHNELL.

GREY WOLF (R Elliot) - Tailed off from near the 600 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

SNAKEYE (T Newman) – Rider reported that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer P Mirabelli indicated that the gelding was now likely to be retired.

Race 5 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1400 metres)

OHIWA SUNSET (M McNab) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after rearing over behind the barriers being passed fit to run. Jumped away awkwardly coming together with QUOTA.

KICHEKO SANA (T Yanagida) – Hampered at the start losing ground.

RICH GIRL (V Colgan) – Jumped away very awkwardly hampering ARDOUR which lost ground. Dipped near the 350 metres and was not persevered with over the concluding stages. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had never travelled well, had hung once placed under pressure in the straight and could offer no excuse.

ARDOUR (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly before being further hampered losing ground.

QUOTA (B Grylls) – Jumped away awkwardly and came together with OHIWA SUNSET

LADY MAK (T Newman) - Over-raced when being restrained near the 1000 metres and shifted outwards to avoid heels inconveniencing LIL RED'EYEDNHOOD.

LIL RED'EYEDNHOOD (M Sanson) - Inconvenienced near the 1000 metres then hung outwards badly rounding the bend running very wide and losing its chance. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had raced very greenly and had been field shy. Connections were advised that the mare would be required to barrier trial prior to racing next.

Race 6 DONAGHYS N-BOOST MAIDEN 3YO (1400 metres)

POZZI VIBE (A Goindasamy) - Jumped away awkwardly.

BIGIFF (K Asano) – Slow away.

ZIGANI (B Grylls) - Raced wide throughout.

NOTES (J Kamaruddin) – Had a tendency to over-race in the middle stages.

SHIMMERING (M McNab) - Returned to the enclosure with a moderate laceration to the right hind outside heel and lost the right hind plate during the running.

Race 7 DONAGHYS BUTCH COOMBE MEMORIAL CUP (1200 metres)

The start was delayed due to two runners having to be reloaded after being put into incorrect barrier stalls.

MEGA BOURBON (M McNab) - Was fractious during its preliminary, dislodging the rider. M McNab was uninjured. Came together with PLAYSAMEANPINBALL just short of the finish.

TAMMY WYNETTE (T Newman) - Blundered leaving the barriers.

GRAND GESTURE (S Weatherley) - Slow away.

PLAYSAMEANPINBALL (K Asano) – Raced wide without cover. Came together with MEGA BOURBON just short of the finish.

BURGUNDY ROSE (J Kamaruddin) – Lost the right front plate during the running. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which found the mare to have a delayed recovery.

Race 8 DONAGHYS TASMAN TIM MAIDEN 1200

ADJUDICATOR (R Elliot) - Became detached from the body of the field shortly after the start and trailed the field throughout. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had felt to have jarred up. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which failed to reveal any obvious abnormality. Connections were advised that the gelding would be required to barrier trial prior to racing next.

LA CAPITA (A Goindasamy) – Slow away. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 200 metres.

EXPRESS DESIRE (T Newman) - Held up rounding the final turn and in the straight until near the 250 metres.

DIVINE SAVA (C Grylls) – Raced wide early. Made the final bend awkwardly when horses either side shifted ground.

RADUCANU (M McNab) - Lay out rounding the final turn hampering DIVINE SAVA then continued to lay out under pressure in the straight.

Race 9 DONAGHYS PRO-EQUINE MAIDEN 1200

GOOD OIL (J Kamaruddin) - Hampered leaving the barriers having to be restrained, losing ground. Raced wide in the early stages. Raced greenly throughout. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the colt hung out throughout and was very green.

TAOISEACH (V Colgan) – Began awkwardly shifting ground outwards.

HONEY HONEY (M McNab) - Hampered by an outside runner shortly after the start.

TINKERS DELIGHT (C Barnes) – Hampered by an outside runner shortly after the start.

ANOTHER ENTREE (B Grylls) - Raced wide without cover.

LEADING MAN (S Weatherley) - Raced wide early.

KEANO REEVES (S McKay) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had presented in a fresh state and should improve with today's race adding that in his opinion it is better suited to more rain affected conditions.
