RACE COMMENTS**Race 1 BARFOOT & THOMPSON 2100**

ROYAL PERFORMER (J Kamaruddin) – Restrained passing the 1900 metres to obtain cover. Rider lost his left iron near the 175 metres placing the rider at a disadvantage for the remainder of the race when being unable to regain the stirrup iron. The riding gear of J Kamaruddin was inspected following the race and found to be in good condition with the cause of the incident being the foot of J Kamaruddin slipping out of the iron.

ISKANDER (A Lawson-Carroll) – Raced wide in the early and middle stages.

BOUFFANT (T Newman) – Became awkwardly placed near the 750 metres when laying out across heels losing ground.

SUMMER FESTIVAL (C Grylls) - Forced wider passing the 375 metres by ISKANDER which shifted out to obtain clear running. Apprentice rider A Lawson-Carroll was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.

Race 2 PREMIER HORSE TRANSPORT 1200

TIME FLIES (O Bosson) - Lay out abruptly soon after leaving the barriers crowding MISSY MOOLA, FELLINI and FOODIE BROTHERS approaching the 1100 metres with MISSY MOOLA clipping a heel and blundering, and FELLINI and FOODIE BROTHERS both becoming unbalanced and steadying. When questioned regarding performance rider O Bosson was unable to offer any excuse other than the gelding racing a little greenly with O Bosson further advising that it would be the intention to attempt to ride TIME FLIES off the pace which was confirmed by trainer J Richards.

MISSY MOOLA (C Burdan) - Crowded 1100 metres clipping a heel and blundering losing ground.

FELLINI (J Kamaruddin) - Crowded becoming unbalanced 1100 metres and steadying.

FOODIE BROTHERS (M Hashizume) – Crowded becoming unbalanced 1100 metres and steadying. Dictated wider approaching the 400 metres by FELLINI which shifted out to obtain clear running.

GIBRALTAR RISING (R Elliot) – Lay out soon after leaving the barriers becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of TIMELESS which lay in passing the 1000 metres, with GIBRALTAR RISING steadying as a result, then raced ungenerously for a distance. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

RENDEZVOUS (A Goindasamy) – Raced greenly making the final bend awkwardly.

ALABAMA GOLD (L Innes) - Was inclined to lay out for the majority of the race.

TIMELESS (T Thornton) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Was inclined to lay out for the majority of the race.

Race 3 NORWEGIAN PARK 1200

SEVEN TWENTY (M Hashizume) – Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover from its wide barrier. Improved onto heels near the 800 metres, shifting out.

CALL ME FLINT (B Grylls) – Crowded at the start losing ground.

MYRTLE CREEK (K Asano) – Lay out throughout the race racing greenly in the final straight.

LASER'S FURY (T Newman) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

MIDNIGHT MASS (L Innes) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the straight becoming awkwardly placed near heels in the final 30 metres. L Innes advised that the gelding would prefer firmer footing.

Race 4 | **MADISON QUALITEX MAIDEN 1600**

EVERY SHOW (D Danis) - Slow to begin.

DREAM FORCE (N Parmar) – Slow to begin.

AQUA MAN (A Lawson-Carroll) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

ELUSIVE CAPITAL (B Grylls) - Became unbalanced when in restricted room passing the 1500 metres, then was steadied to obtain cover.

CRUISY LASS (C Burdan) - Raced fiercely approaching the 1100 metres having to be restrained off heels, losing ground and continued to race keenly for a distance. Lay in onto heels approaching the 100 metres before being corrected by its rider.

OPTIMUM SWEET (T Newman) – Raced wide without cover for a majority of the race.

LOTTAROC (M Cameron) - Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages then raced keenly in the middle stages and then hung out making the final bend. When questioned regarding performance rider M Cameron explained that he had been asked to ride the colt with cover and when attempting to find cover and got further back than intended, with LOTTAROC then racing greenly amongst runners. M Cameron further advised that he would be recommending to connections to ride the colt further forward. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

TRUST IN YOU (M Hashizume) - Made the bend awkwardly passing the 400 metres when laying in.

CONTEMPLATION (C Grylls) – Held up approaching the 400 metres. Lay out across heels and was steadied near the 250 metres when improving into a marginal run.

GO FIONA (K Asano) – Improved into a marginal run passing the 150 metres.

ILLICIT MISS (J Kamaruddin) – Inconvenienced approaching the 100 metres when taken wider by AQUA MAN.

PAHI LASS (Y Kumagai) - When questioned regarding the improved performance trainer C Cumming advised that the mare had been going good races and had appreciated the step up in distance and a claim, further adding that PAHI LASS had been well leading in today's race.

Race 5 | **BROOKBY STABLES 1500**

REGAL LION (M Cameron) - Slow to begin.

RIVERPLATE (L Innes) – Began awkwardly.

PIN ME UP (J Kamaruddin) – Raced in restricted room approaching the 1400 metres and was then restrained. Crowded and hampered 1100 metres, losing ground.

SHOCKATILLATAP (S McKay) - Ducked out abruptly passing the 1300 metres.

SUPERETTE (A Goindasamy) - Commenced to hang outwards soon after leaving the barriers, shifting out when being restrained passing the 1000 metres racing ungenerously then shifting in and crowding PIN ME UP which was hampered losing ground. SUPERETTE then continued to race erratically laying out making the bend awkwardly, running wide and could not be ridden out in the final straight. Trainer S Marsh was advised that SUPERETTE would be required to barrier trial right handed prior to racing right handed again. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

HORACE (K Asano) – Raced wide without cover for a majority of the race. Taken wider passing the 900 metres by SUPERETTE then restrained 700 metres to avoid that runner’s heels, and shifted in. When questioned regarding performance rider K Asano advised that the gelding raced keenly in the early stages and had got further back in the running than intended. K Asano further advised that he was satisfied with the gelding’s effort.

WHISKEY (T Thornton) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight when attempting to improve into a marginal run.

THE PERFECT PINK (O Bosson) - Lay in under pressure over the concluding stages and made slight contact with LA CRIQUE.

LA CRIQUE (C Grylls) – Briefly crowded over the concluding stages when THE PERFECT PINK shifted in under pressure.

O Bosson (THE PERFECT PINK) - Admitted a charge of using the whip in two consecutive strides on his mount THE PERFECT PINK inside the final 100 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee suspended O Bosson’s licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 9 January up to and including racing on Thursday 20 January, 6 national riding days and in addition imposed a fine of \$400.

Race 6	TE AKAU GINGERNUTS SALVER (2100 metres) (Listed Race)
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L O’Sullivan & A Scott (TUSCAN HOLIDAY) - Co-trainer A Scott was fined \$100 by the Adjudicator after presenting TUSCAN HOLIDAY with the incorrect saddle cloth.

WHITE NOISE (R Elliot) - Began awkwardly shifting out abruptly making contact with REGAZZO. Raced wide from near the 800 metres. Raced in restricted room approaching the 300 metres to the inside of TE POROPITI which shifted in. Lost the off hind plate during the running.

TEXAS TEA (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin.

NIPPAGIN (M Hashizume) - Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover from its wide barrier.

VADIABEEL (D Danis) - Raced wide in the early stages.

LIKE IT SWEET (L Innes) - Dipped and knuckled after racing over the crossing near the 1600 metres. Lay out in the final straight.

OZARK (K Asano) - Raced in restricted room approaching the 1500 metres and was hampered.

THE NIGHT KING (M Cameron) – Raced in restricted room 300 metres when weakening.

TE POROPITI (T Newman) – Shifted in approaching the 300 metres making brief contact, becoming unbalanced.

T Newman (TE POROPITI) – Issued with a warning after permitting TE POROPITI to shift in near the 300 metres crowding WHITE NOISE.

<p>KARALINO (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>MONACO (T Newman) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>SHORT FUSE (A Goindasamy) - Jumped outwards at the start.</p> <p>THE MITIGATOR (N Parmar) - Began awkwardly.</p> <p>TELLALL (K Asano) – Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover from its wide barrier.</p> <p>TEVERE (M Hashizume) - Shifted out to obtain clear running approaching the 400 metres dictating IRISH GIRL wider on the track.</p> <p>IRISH GIRL (B Grylls) – Dictated wider 400 metres.</p> <p>MEGA BOURBON (M Cameron) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running passing the 200 metres improving near heels near the 150 metres before shifting in passing the 75 metres.</p> <p>SHEEZALLMINE (O Bosson) - Eased down by its rider over the final 100 metres with O Bosson reporting the mare had felt sore behind. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the mare to be 2/5 lame in the left hind leg. Connections were advised that the mare would require a veterinary clearance prior to racing next.</p>

<p>BAD 'N' BOUJ (S McKay) – Began awkwardly then restrained to obtain cover from its wide barrier.</p> <p>AMANO (C Grylls) - Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover from its wide barrier.</p> <p>RHAEGAR (R Elliot) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>LOOKSEASY (D Danis) – Shifted out under pressure passing the 100 metres.</p> <p>DAWN PARADE (K Asano) - Raced keenly in the early to middle stages becoming awkwardly placed near heels when laying out near the 700 metres.</p> <p>MARIA FARINA (M Cameron) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running until approaching the 200 metres.</p> <p>STRINGLINE (M Hashizume) - Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages to the inside of TANNAHILL which shifted in slightly.</p> <p>TANNAHILL (C Burdan) - When questioned regarding the improved performance co-trainer S Phelan advised that the gelding had benefitted from the addition of blinkers, an apprentice claim and a more favourable run in transit.</p>
