Race 7 WAE Waikouaiti Cup 2200M

C Campbell (FIRODEN) - Issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(g)(ii) in that he struck his mount in consecutive strides inside the final 100 metres.

Race 9 Otago Daily Times Southern Mile Series R 65 1600M

Stewards today concluded their enquiry into the ride on MADAM SEQUOIA by T Jonker. After considering Miss Jonker's evidence tendered on the day and viewing replays Stewards accepted Miss Jonker's explanation but did remind her that she would be expected to show some more vigour on her mounts than she had on this occasion.

Race 1	CROYDON CONTRACTING / ADVANCE AGRICULTURE MAIDEN (1335m)
<p>There was a delay of approximately 9 minutes 30 seconds to the start of this race due to a second Ambulance being called for after a horse attendant was injured in the birdcage and required attention from the on-course St John Ambulance Paramedics.</p> <p>BENTLEY (T Comignaghi) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>WUDDZZ (D Bothamley) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>TORA ROSE (S Toolooa) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>SCARLETT'S PROMISE (BB Hong) - Slow to begin. Over-raced in the early stages and got its head up on a number of occasions.</p> <p>BELLA BROOK (R Mudhoo) - Under pressure from the 700 metres.</p> <p>AGAINST ALL ODDS (S Muniandy) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>NO BOUQUET (K Mudhoo) - Raced three-wide with cover throughout. When asked to comment on the performance rider advised he had been obliged to get back from a wide draw and had found it difficult to make ground on a good tempo.</p> <p>RIVIERA ROSE (L Callaway) - Briefly held up rounding the final bend.</p>	
Race 2	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1335m)
<p>KITTY POWER (A Bohorun) - Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>OHIO SHOWGIRL (K Chowdhoory) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>ZAMBEZI ZIPPER (S Khetoo) - Got back shortly after the start.</p> <p>SPRING BLOSSOM (T Jonker) - Under pressure from the 500 metres and gave ground over the concluding stages, finishing in a distant last placing. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed the mare to have a high heart rate and a slow recovery. Stewards will follow up with trainer N White in the coming days.</p> <p>GELATO (R Mudhoo) - When asked to comment on the performance rider advised that the mare is better suited to firmer tracks.</p>	
Race 3	AUTO FUNDS / O'CONNOR RICHMOND MAIDEN (2000m)
<p>ACQUITTAL (K Chowdhoory) - Crowded shortly after the start losing some ground. Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1300 metres when the pace of the race eased at this point.</p> <p>CODA BIANCA (G Jogoo) - Steadied to avoid the heels of SOVEREIGNTY when racing keenly passing the 1800 metres and then continued to race keenly through the middle stages.</p> <p>THE TUI TOILER (L Callaway) - Made the first bend near the 1700 metres awkwardly, shifting wider on the track. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the run home.</p>	

SAVEZ VOUS (C Barnes) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

LEVON (D Bothamley) - Briefly held up passing the 250 metres.

CARLOS (A Bohorun) - Lay inwards throughout the run home having to be corrected by its rider.

KENTUCKY COUGAR (S Muniandy) - The breast plate became detached during the running causing the rider some difficulty, particularly through the middle stages when racing keenly.

OLE MATE (T Moseley) - When asked to comment on the disappointing performance rider could offer no tangible excuse.

Race 4	PETERS GENETICS (2000m)

HEIDI HI (K Williams) - Shifted out abruptly at the start.

SHE'S GOT THE LOOK (R Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly and shifted out crowding PURE CLASS.

PURE CLASS (T Jonker) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

NO QUARTER ASKED (T Moseley) - Raced three-wide into the first bend. When asked to comment on the disappointing performance rider could offer no tangible excuse.

VAGUE (K Chowdhoo) - Raced keenly while leading through the early to middle stages.

YOUNEVERKNOW (S Toolooa) - Steadied off heels passing the 900 metres when racing keenly and was then obliged to race three-wide from this point.

STOP MAKING SENSE (T Comignaghi) - Improved wide from the 800 metres to lead passing the 450 metres.

YEAH RIGHT (C Barnes) - Held up from the 500 metres to the 350 metres.

CLASSIC DIVA (S Khetoo) - When asked to comment on the disappointing performance rider could offer no tangible excuse.

Race 5	AON INSURANCE (1200m)

HUMBUCKER (K Williams) - Slow to begin. Over-raced through the early stages.

KING COUGAR (J Laking) - Had to be steadied off heels passing the 900 metres. When asked to comment rider could offer no tangible excuse for the disappointing performance.

SO MUCH MOUR (S Khetoo) - Steadied off heels passing the 850 metres when racing keenly.

EARL OF ORKNEY (T Comignaghi) - Raced three-wide without cover for the majority of the race.

MINT JULEP (T Moseley) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home only gaining clear racing room passing the 200 metres.

BEESLASTSTING (R Mudhoo) - Shifted ground outwards throughout the run home having to be straightened.

C Barnes (CHOKITO) - Issued with a warning after allowing CHOKITO to shift ground inwards near the 900 metres when not fully clear of KING COUGAR which had to steady.

Race 6 | **ROOFCRAFT INDUSTRIES / HOKONUI SUZUKI (1200m)**

SHAM ON TOAST (R Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

IRISH ENVY (C Johnson) - Slow to begin. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the run home and was then held up over the concluding stages with the rider reporting that when being steadied the mare had overreacted.

DAUPHINE (K Chowdhoo) - Over-raced through the early stages. Raced wide throughout. Lay inwards throughout the run home having to be straightened.

TAP 'N' GO (L Callaway) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

GLOBAL STAR (T Comignaghi) - Raced wide throughout. Rider reported the mare had hung throughout and had been disappointing.

MAXIE TAP (T Moseley) - Held up rounding the final bend and had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the run home.

GLORY CHANCE (K Mudhoo) - Steadied to avoid the heels of SACRED KITTY which when laying in, shifted in passing the 125 metres.

SACRED KITTY (K Kwo) - Lay inwards throughout the run home having to be straightened.

Race 7 | **LIQUORLAND GORE GUINEAS (1335m)**

PALMETTO (S Muniandy) - Slow to begin.

BELASARD (K Chowdhoo) - Slow to begin.

AVITUS (J Laking) - Began awkwardly losing some ground. Raced three-wide without cover through the early stages.

BENNY HILL (B May) - Restrained after jumping from the outside barrier.

JUSTANACE (T Jonker) - Raced four-wide into the first bend before being ridden forward to lead.

MACKENZIE LAD (D Montes de Oca) - Raced wide throughout. Lay inwards throughout the run home. Faltered when pulling up and was immediately attended to by the on-course Veterinarian with the horse ambulance being deployed. A subsequent Veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have suffered a fracture to the near front fetlock and was humanely euthanised. There was a delay to the All-clear following the race due to the rider taking some time to return to weigh in.

SHAMELESS TART (T Moseley) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running through the middle stages of the run home.

BURGIE (C Barnes) - Rider reported that in her opinion the filly had not handled the slower nature of today's track conditions.

THE RADIANT ONE (T Comignaghi) - Rider could offer no tangible excuse for the disappointing performance.

Race 8 | **DB BREWERIES / HOKONUI CONTRACTING (1335m)**

HENLEY (T Moseley) - Slow to begin, getting back in the field. Held up in the early stages of the run home until gaining clear racing room inside the final 100 metres.

HE'S MI BROTHER (A Bohorun) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

T Moseley (HENLEY) - Admitted a charge of using the whip in two consecutive strides on his mount inside the final 100 metres. After considering penalty submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a fine of \$300.

Race 9 | **MLT GORE CUP (2000m)**

ASATHOUGHT (G Jogoo) - Slow to begin.

KILOWATT (S Khetoo) - Briefly restrained to avoid the heels of **GOLD'NGURU** (C Campbell) which shifted in passing the 1400 metres. C Campbell was advised to exercise care. Improved inside the heels of **GOLD'NGURU** passing the 800 metres contacting the rail and briefly going off stride.

FRANCIS DRAKE (R Mudhoo) - Tailed the field throughout. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormality. Connections were advised the gelding was on a racing manners warning and must be more competitive.

Race 10 | **GORE TOWN & COUNTRY CLUB (1800m)**

LARIPPA (K Williams) - Fractious in the barrier prior to the start.

OLAF (T Comignaghi) - Slow to begin. Obligated to improve wide rounding the final bend.

SITARIST (G Jogoo) - Slow to begin. Rider reported the mare had felt indifferent in its action over the concluding stages. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormality other than some soreness to the near front hoof. Stewards will follow up with connections in coming days.

NEVER QUITZ (T Moseley) - Over-raced and made the bend awkwardly near the 1700 metres, getting its head up when being restrained.

REDGUM (C Johnson) - Held up early in the run home.

PETE THE DRIVER (S Khetoo) - Lay outwards under pressure in the run home, having to be straightened.

WAIMATE BILL (A Bohorun) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout. Rider reported that the gelding had felt sore on pulling up. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have no obvious abnormality other than a minor laceration to a hind leg.

FAIRWAY FLIGHT (R Mudhoo) - When asked to comment on the performance rider advised that the mare did not handle the step up in distance today.
