RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 | **MARK FROST ELECTRICAL 2000**

TITLETATTLE (S Karnicnik) - Slow to begin, losing ground. Commenced to give ground passing the 1000 metres.

AIGNE (N Downs) - Raced wide from the 1000 metres.

TELL ME MORE (B Donoghue) - Commenced to give ground passing the 700 metres.

Track upgraded to Soft 7 retrospective to Race 1.

Race 2 | **ALL THINGS AUTOMOTIVE MAIDEN 1200**

BLUE ARROW (J Mudhoo) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

RIKKI RICARDO (M Hudson) - Slow to begin.

BIONDA (L Allpress) - Began awkwardly. L Allpress reported the filly would improve with maturity and benefit from a longer distance.

LUXURIANT (J Kamaruddin) - Shifted out under pressure over the final stages resulting in SCOTCH BONNET being forced wider on the track.

SUN ONE (D Turner) - Finished some distance last. Connections were advised that a warning is placed against the gelding with regard to its competitiveness.

Race 3 THE BOLD ONE @ GRANGEWILLIAM STUD 1200

HORLISTIC (R Hannam) - Slow away.

THOMAS AQUINAS (J Mudhoo) - Raced in restricted room near the 75 metres.

LOIS LANE (M Hudson) - Rider advised LOIS LANE would prefer more rain-affected footing.

ENCHANTING PEARL (L Allpress) - Had to be steadied when improving up on to heels near the 500 metres.

Race 4 CHILLCO REFRIGERATION MAIDEN 1400

QUATORZE (R Hannam) - Slow to begin.

SPANISH HARLEM (J Mudhoo) - Contacted at start, losing ground.

HOLYELL (D Turner) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages, making the turn awkwardly near the 800 metres.

MASAROVA (M Hudson) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

NO TEARS (F Lazet) - Raced keenly in the middle stages making the turn awkwardly near the 800 metres.

FINAL RETURN (J Kamaruddin) - Forced wider near the 400 metres when HOLYELL made the turn awkwardly.

PERFECT POSY (J Parkes) - Disappointed. Rider reported the mare was unsuited to the track conditions underfoot. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 5 SOUTH TARANAKI CLUB 1400

ZEEFA ZED (J Parkes) - Slow to begin.

INVISIBLE SPIRIT (L Allpress) - Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained.

KEEN TO RUN (R Hannam) - Briefly steadied passing the 1000 metres when the pace eased.

LIGHTNING FIELD (J Kamaruddin) - Briefly steadied passing the 1000 metres when the pace eased. Rider momentarily lost the use of his right stirrup iron near the 350 metres, becoming briefly unbalanced.

Race 6 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE MAIDEN 1600

SONGSUNGLU (J Parkes) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

PLAY A PART (L Allpress) - Held up near the 200 metres, having to change ground inwards to gain clear running.

BIG HEMA (C Dell) - Finished well back. Trainer was advised the mare must trial prior to its next start.

Race 7

NORWOOD HAWERA 1600

SWING LOW (J Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly, losing ground.

NEVERSTOPLAUGHING (A Mudhoo) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early stages.

ROAD DIVA (F Lazet) - Slow to begin.

ARJAYBEE (B Grylls) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

BRUNO MAGILE (L Sutherland) - Held up in the early part of the final straight.

GINGER SNAPZ (J Parkes) - Rider reported in his opinion the mare may be now better suited to a longer distance.
