RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 WANGANUI-TARANAKI RACEHORSE OWNERS ASSOCIATION 1200m

TIVACI PRINCESS (N Parmar) - Was steadied away from the heels of VALINOR which shifted inwards shortly after the start. Raced wide without cover throughout.

DUNCAN CREEK (K Hercock) - Began awkwardly. Steadied passing the 600 metres when improving on to heels. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until approaching the 200 metres.

MEDIA MISS (R Hannam) - Slow to begin. Made the home turn awkwardly.

MISS LILLY (A Mudhoo) - Raced ungenerously in the early stages when being restrained. Made the home turn awkwardly. Lay out under pressure in the straight.

BAILEYS ON ROCKS (T Taiaroa)– When questioned into the performance, rider T Taiaroa advised the filly raced greenly and over-raced throughout.

TAP DANCER (E Nicholas) - Subsequent to the race connections reported the filly to be coughing on cooling down. A veterinary examination revealed dirt in the lungs consistent with having swallowed a clod during the running.

Race 2 | **THANK YOU TO IAIN HYNDMAN & HELEN BROOME 1200m**

BELLACONTE (T Taiaroa) – Slow to begin. When questioned into the performance the rider was of the opinion the filly would be better suited to a more rain effected going.

ICONIC LASS (A Mudhoo) - Slow to begin. Was hampered near the 200 metres.

BOLD MAC (J Parkes) – Was crowded and steadied passing the 1000 metres when KAPINOS was dictated inwards by inward movement from MEGLIO DI FALCREST. Had difficulty in obtaining clear running until approaching the 200 metres.

DURHAM LAD (F Lazet) - Shifted in under pressure near the 200 metres tightening KAPINOS which then bumped with BOLD MAC.

RAFFLE (B Grylls) - Held up rounding the turn and was unable to obtain clear running until near the 200 metres and when shifted out tightened MI CAROL (R Hannam), GUCCI BELT (L Allpress) and ICONIC LASS (A Mudhoo) which were all unbalanced as a result.

KAPINOS (M Palmer) - Was tightened and steadied passing the 1000 metres when MEGLIO DE FALCREST shifted inwards.

GUCCI BELT (L Allpress) - Was hampered near the 200 metres when RAFFLE shifted out to obtain clear running.

B Grylls (RAFFLE) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she directed her mount outwards when insufficiently clear of MI CAROL, GUCCI BELT and ICONIC LASS which were tightened and unbalanced in the final straight. After considering submissions the adjudicative committee imposed a suspension of her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 8 May until the conclusion of racing on 14 May – four national riding days.

M Hudson (MEGLIO DE FALCREST) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she directed her mount inwards when insufficiently clear of KAPINOS and BOLD MAC which were crowded and steadied near the 1000 metres. After considering submissions the adjudicative committee imposed a suspension of her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 1 May until the conclusion of racing on 7 May – five national riding days.

D Turner (LINCOLN FALLS) - Was spoken to regarding his whip use on a runner out of contention.

Race 3 | **WANGANUI INSURANCE BROKERS MDN 1360m**

CHOISIA PRINCE (J Parkes) - Began awkwardly. Tightened near the winning post when KAREHANA BAY shifted out simultaneously as KRONENBOURG shifted in.

FABLUE (K Hercock) – Began awkwardly and shifted out bumping KRONENBOURG. Improved on to heels when passing the 400 metres.

KAREHANA BAY (F Lazet) - Raced greenly throughout and shifted out under pressure in the home straight.

Race 4 | **SPORTZ BAR 1360m**

KICK START (M Singh) - Slow to begin.

WINNIE ROSE (L Allpress) - Slow to begin. Raced wide throughout.

ABSOLUTELY MAYBE (S O'Malley) - Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover throughout.

WESTERN SPRINGS (S McKay) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

HOOKS (L Sutherland) - Raced wide without cover throughout. Lay in under pressure in the straight.

MISS SAILOR (E Nicholas) - Lay in under pressure in the final straight. Steadied away from heels approaching the 100m.

Race 5 | **G BRISTOL & SONS 1360m**

JUSTASKME (E Nicholas) - Slow to begin. When questioned into her ride when settling last after being slow away, E Nicholas advised her instructions were to ride the horse back and potentially run on over the final stages, but when shown footage of her ride agreed with the stewards' assessment that she had erred on this occasion by not maintaining contact with the body of the field. E Nicholas was of the opinion the gelding was better suited to more rain effected footing.

SECRET AMOUR (R Hannam) - Was restrained from its wide barrier at the start.

STUMPY (L Sutherland) - Made the back crossing awkwardly. Went amiss and fell free of interference inside the final 100 metres. Rider L Sutherland was attended to by paramedics and taken to Wanganui Base Hospital for further observation. STUMPY was humanely euthanised and the horse ambulance was deployed.

TIMES TICKING (D Turner) - Was steadied approaching the 1000 metres when improving on to heels. Was steadied approaching the 200 metres when attempting a marginal run to the inside of LINCOLN'S KRUZ.

Race 6 | **TRIBUTE TO STU MCGRAIL 1600m**

WAY ABOVE (M Hudson) - M Hudson replaced L Sutherland. Slow to begin.

CROSS ROADS (J Parkes) - Slow to begin.

FLYING SURF (F Lazet) - Raced wide without cover throughout. Hampered near the 100 metres when ST NANCY lay inwards.

ST NANCY (D Turner) - Lay in under pressure near the 100 metres.

MAHOE (B Grylls) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the event.

Race 7 | **FLOYD & TOY REAL ESTATE PROPERTY BROKERS 2060m**

KELLY COE (M Hudson) - Raced wide without cover throughout. Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained.

HUNTA PENCE (T Taiaroa) - Slow to begin.

PRINCE LEO (A Mudhoo) - Restrained from its wide barrier at the start.

FLYING MEG (B Grylls) - Steadied approaching the winning post on the first occasion when BECAUSE shifted inwards to obtain cover.

BECAUSE (L Allpress) - When questioned into the performance Rider L Allpress was of the opinion the gelding would benefit from today's run.

SIR NATE (D Bradley) - Finished well back. When questioned trainer L Latta advised that the racing future of the gelding would now be considered.

Race 8

BALANCE ACCOUNTING 2060m

ILLUSION OF PARIS (K Hercock) - Began awkwardly then crowded at the start. Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained.

ENCHANTED ELLE (E Nicholas) - Slow to begin.

LOCHWINNOCH (L Allpress) - Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained.

ALL IN BLACKBERRY (M Hudson) - Was dictated inwards shortly after the start when JUSTFIXIT WULDYA (S O'Malley) was angled inwards. S O'Malley was advised to exercise greater care. Had difficulty obtaining clear room until passing the 100 metres.

MADURO (T Taiaroa) - Steadied passing the 800 metres when improving onto heels.

JUSTFIXIT WULDYA (S O'Malley) – When questioned into the performance rider S O'Malley advised the gelding felt indifferent in its action. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer A Sharrock was advised to monitor the progress of the gelding over coming days and report any anomaly to the Stewards.
