Race 6 - RAY WHITE GREERTON HANDICAP (1400 metres)

CHAMPAGNE LOLA (L Satherley) - Trainer K Hawtin reported that the filly had undergone treatment for muscle soreness after returning to the stable, further advising that CHAMPANGE LOLA will now be spelled.

Race 7 - HAUNUI FARM 2100

SHEZATHINKA (J Kamaruddin) – Trainer J Richards advised Stewards SHEZATHINKA has now been retired from racing.

WHEAO (L Satherley) – Co-trainer Mrs M Carter reported to Stewards WHEAO underwent a veterinary examination on Wednesday 2 February which revealed the gelding to have jarred up and minor bruising to both front feet. M Carter further advised WHEAO will be rested for the remainder of the week.

Auckland Thoroughbred Racing at Ellerslie – Sunday, 30 January 2022 Race 6 – EAGLE TECHNOLOGY 1600

J Fawcett (PEPPERELLO) - Admitted a breach of careless riding in that she permitted PEPPERELLO to shift in approaching the 1200 metres when insufficiently clear of LADY MAK, EXTORTION and WITHALLMYHEART which was hampered losing ground.

Race 10 - DUNSTAN RECOVERY MASH 1200

J Fawcett (OVER THE MOON) - Admitted a breach of careless riding in that she permitted OVER THE MOON to shift in near the 1100 metres when insufficiently clear of DOVES BAY which was hampered when contacted shifting in and hampering NOVAK which became unbalanced.

After considering submissions for both charges, the Adjudicative Committee suspended J Fawcett's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 2 February 2022 up to and including racing on Friday 25 February 2022, 14 national riding days.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 SVS STARTING GATES DASH (1000 metres)

ELUSIVE EMPIRE (N Parmar) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Had to be steadied near the 900 metres after improving onto heels. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 200 metres.

EUPOLIA (M Cameron) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

VALETTI (J Kamaruddin) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

INDUSTRIALIST (V Colgan) - Raced greenly when placed in restricted room near the 600 metres. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding had been outpaced in the early stages after beginning well.

I'M BUZZ (S Weatherley) - Lost the right hind plate during the running.

Race 2 JOIN TEAM TE AKAU – SHARES AVAILABLE MAIDEN MILE (1600 metres)

SAVASILK (J Kamaruddin) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection at the barrier before being late scratched at 2:11 pm.

RUACH (J Riddell) - Knuckled at the start.

PERIGEE (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly. Held up for a distance passing the 150 metres.

YELLOW JERSEY (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly.

GOLDIE'S REVENGE (T Yanagida) - Slow to begin.

POLLY POWER (B Grylls) - Slow to begin.

DIVINE SAVA (M McNab) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that in his opinion the filly would benefit from a step up in distance.

CONNEMARA (D Danis) – Raced three wide without cover from near the 1000 metres.

AMATERASU (C Barnes) - Placed in restricted room over the concluding stages having to be steadied.

W Pinn (ROCKET LAD) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards over the concluding stages when not sufficiently clear of AMATERASU which had to be steadied when placed in restricted room.

Race 3 BCD GROUP MAIDEN MILE (1600 metres)

ASTERIX (L Innes) - Slow to begin.

THE GAMBLERS HAND (J Kamaruddin) - Crowded shortly after the start for some distance.

ELUSIVE CAPITAL (N Parmar) – Crowded shortly after the start.

UPLAND COURT (M McNab) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

PRINCEOFCAMBRIDGE (K Asano) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

LA FLORA BELLE (S Weatherley) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that after settling towards the rear of the field in a slowly run race the mare had run on well.

BEBELECHE (M Cameron) - Connections advised that the filly would now be sent for a spell.

FIERCE FLIGHT (O Bosson) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding had received an unfavourable run in the early and middle stages after being caught wide which had been detrimental to its chances.

Race 4 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1400 metres)

ENDEAN AFFAIR (C Barnes) - Slow to begin.

LAVAGLO (S Weatherley) - Began awkwardly. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which did not reveal any abnormality.

CATWALK GIRL (M Hashizume) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

MINI MINER (C Burdan) - The saddle slipped backwards near the 500 metres.

Race 5 PHILL CATALDO BLOODSTOCK 3YO MAIDEN (1200 metres)

HASSTOBEPERFECT (V Colgan) - Slow to begin. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the filly raced greenly once placed under pressure in the final straight.

COMPOSURE (J Fawcett) - Began awkwardly.

SHADEZ (C Barnes) - Slow to begin.

ALPINO (K Asano) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

AYREON (A Goindasamy) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

CAMACHO (S Spratt) - Steadled when placed in restricted room passing the 100 metres when runners either side shifted ground.

Race 6 WAIKATO DRAUGHT MAIDEN 2100

ASPEN COLORADO (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin.

TE POROPITI (J Riddell) - Restrained at the start from its wide barrier.

KING MONDO (C Burdan) - Raced fiercely in the early stages and continued to over-race in the middle stages.

ALLBRIGHT (W Pinn) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Contacted and forced inwards passing the 300 metres.

OZARK (C Grylls) – Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight and shifted inwards passing the 300 metres making contact with ALLBRIGHT.

Race 7 DUNSTAN HORSEFEEDS MAIDEN 2100

SAVAGE KATIE (M Cameron) – Began awkwardly. Held up until near the 250 metres.

ESS VEE ARE (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin.

SMUG (T Thornton) - Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained. Commenced to race wide from the 1200 metres.

SHA CARRI (C Burdan) - Steadied when placed in restricted room between ILLICIT MISS which shifted in slightly, and SEARCHLIGHT which shifted outwards near the 450 metres. Both O Bosson & K Asano were advised to exercise care.

BURCHA (W Pinn) – Held up rounding the bend and early in the final straight.

C Burdan (SHA CARRI) - Reminded of her obligations in that she must ride her mounts out to the end of the race when circumstances permit her to do so.

Race 8 LEGACY LODGE WAIKATO GUINEAS (G2) (2000 metres)

REGAL LION (M Cameron) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

CRUISY LASS (A Goindasamy) - Raced wide in the early stages before improving to sit outside the leader approaching the 1400 metres.

THE NIGHT KING (C Grylls) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight when laying in onto the heels of the weakening CRUISY LASS.

Race 9 ED STAPLETON BLOODSTOCK MAIDEN 1300

ENDEAN MAGIC (T Yanagida) - Slow to begin.

LEAR JET (L Innes) - Began awkwardly.

GLORIFIED (C Grylls) - Slow to begin.

TIDAL RUSH (R Beemud) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

OUR SASSY CAT (S Weatherley) - Contacted and forced wider by BLUE SKY AT NIGHT which shifted outwards passing the 400 metres. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that after obtaining cover in the early

stages the mare had failed to respond once placed under pressure. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which did not reveal any abnormality.

BLUE SKY AT NIGHT (T Thornton) - Held up rounding the final bend before shifting outwards passing the 400 metres to obtain clear running making contact with OUR SASSY CAT which was forced wider.

JUSTUANDME (B Grylls) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 150 metres.

Race 10 LEGENDS DAY FEBRUARY 12 MAIDEN 1300

DAWNTING (J Riddell) - Slow to begin. Lay out passing the 450 metres making contact with the hindquarters of ROCASTANO with both runners becoming unbalanced. Held up early in the final straight before improving onto the heels of STREET KID which was forced inwards passing the 200 metres having to be firmly restrained.

FLOSSYROSYCANDY (B Grylls) - Crowded at the start. Crowded passing the 200 metres.

STREET KID (J Kamaruddin) - Crowded at the start. Crowded passing the 200 metres.

KELLY KEEPER (T Yanagida) - Slow to begin.

ILOVETHEMOONLIGHT (J Fawcett) - Improved onto the heels of STREET KID which was steadying near the 700 metres having to be restrained. Denied clear running passing the 300 metres after attempting to improve into a marginal run inside of JIMMY THUMPER which shifted in slightly and outside of DAWNTING which had shifted outwards in an attempt to obtain clear running.

KING ZAZU (M Hashizume) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Raced in restricted room passing the 200 metres.

ROCASTANO (T Thornton) - Contacted and unbalanced passing the 450 metres.

HALSTON (L Innes) - Lay in passing the 200 metres before being straightened by its rider.

JIMMY THUMPER (K Asano) - Steadied when placed in restricted room approaching the 200 metres when runners either side shifted ground.

PACKING TAVI (M Cameron) - Steadied when crowded passing the 200 metres to the inside of STREET KID which was crowded and FLOSSYROSYCANDY which had improved into a marginal run to the inside of KING ZAZU which shifted in and away from HALSTON which lay in. Also hampered as a result was DAWNTING and JIMMY THUMPER.

B Grylls (FLOSSYROSYCANDY) - Issued with a warning after improving into a marginal run to the inside of KING ZAZU resulting in crowding to STREET KID, DAWNTING and PACKING TAVI passing the 200 metres. Stewards took into account the inward movement from HALSTON which lay in before being corrected by its rider when assessing the incident.
