RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 | **RUAKAKA – NZ'S BEST BET IN WINTER MAIDEN (2200 metres)**

GLORIFIED (C Grylls) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no excuse.

Race 2	LION RED PUNTERS CHALLENGE MAIDEN (1200 metres)
<p>MISS LAURETTA (L Satherley) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Lay out rounding the final bend.</p> <p>SALENTO (M Hashizume) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>ME LIBEREZ (J Chung) - Steadied when improving onto heels passing the 900 metres. Held up until passing the 200 metres then lay in onto heels passing the 100 metres having to be straightened by its rider.</p> <p>BELLA TIVACI (T Newman) - Raced wide without cover throughout. Forced outwards passing the 600 metres by TAZIMOTO which shifted out when racing keenly.</p> <p>SHIRAZELLE (T Thornton) – Held up throughout the final straight.</p> <p>LOOSE CHOICE (J Fawcett) – Held up for a distance passing the 400 metres.</p>	
Race 3	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES MAIDEN RACE (1400 metres)
<p>RISING ROYAL (T Newman) - Crowded at the start.</p> <p>NARINCE (L Satherley) - Raced keenly in the early stages. Held up until near the 300 metres then lay in when placed under pressure.</p> <p>TELERIN (A Calder) - Raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages. Steadied away from the heels of ON THE PROWL which had shifted in passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>EVE'S SONG (M Hashizume) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>DAADS EXPRESS (J Fawcett) – Lost contact with the body of the field passing the 800 metres.</p> <p>IFFIN DOUBT DANCE (M McNab) – Had to shift outwards approaching the 350 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p>A Goindasamy (ON THE PROWL) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift in when not sufficiently clear of TELERIN which had to be steadied passing the 1000 metres.</p>	
Race 4	HOMESTEAD SPORTSBAR REUBEN LEWIS MEMORIAL MAIDEN (1600 metres)
<p>PONTARDAWE (M McNab) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Inconvenienced passing the 400 metres. When questioned regarding his ride on the gelding M McNab explained that it was his intention to ride PONTARDAWE in a forward position however after slipping when jumping out of the barriers, had settled at the rear of the field. He had considered following SUPER GUNN forward three wide from near the 800 metres, however after it appeared FLOSSYROSYCANDY was going to improve inside him and force him wider, he had elected to improve inside that runner. Entering the final straight GRETA GHARBO shifted out slightly inconveniencing his run, when clear the gelding had run on fairly and lay in when placed under pressure. M McNab's comments were noted.</p> <p>FLOSSYROSYCANDY (D Danis) - Crowded at the start.</p> <p>SUPER GUNN (T Newman) - Crowded at the start.</p> <p>GRETA GHARBO (J Fawcett) - Lay out rounding the final bend inconveniencing PONTARDAWE.</p> <p>POZZI VIBE (A Goindasamy) - Lay out under pressure near the 250 metres.</p>	

CAERUS (R Elliot) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 200 metres then shifted inwards inconveniencing the weakening **POZZI VIBE**.

Race 5 | **PORTHOUSE BAR & EATERY MAIDEN (1600 metres)**

CHARLIE CHUCKLE (M McNab) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection at the barriers before being late scratched at 2.50 pm.

BLOOD DIAMOND (E Nicholas) - Slow to begin.

TIME AND AGAIN (R Elliot) - Restrained from its wide barrier at the start.

NEIGH KID (T Thornton) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Shifted out abruptly making firm contact with **TRUE NORTH** when racing ungenerously approaching the 1000 metres.

TRUE NORTH (D Danis) - Hampered and forced wider approaching the 1000 metres.

KUROMIES (J Fawcett) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

Race 6 | **BREAM BAY BUSINESS DAY – 11 JUNE (2100 metres)**

NOTHINSWEETABOUTME (A Lawson-Carroll) – Slow to begin. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

EMBER ATTACK (J Kamaruddin) - Restrained from its wide barrier at the start.

BURGUNDY DANCER (L Satherley) – Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained. Held up for clear racing room until passing the 200 metres. Lay in over the concluding stages placing **SELVA VERDE** in restricted room. Contributing was slight outward movement from **HAIL DAMAGE**.

HAIL DAMAGE (E Nicholas) – Raced wide in the early stages until improving forward to sit outside the leader near the 1400 metres.

SELVA VERDE (A Calder) - Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

MISS INTERPRET (T Newman) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight. Had to be steadied after becoming awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 150 metres.

PEPPERELLO (T Thornton) - Placed in restricted room approaching the 100 metres having to be steadied when to the inside of **EMBER ATTACK** which shifted in. J Kamaruddin was advised to exercise care.

L Satherley (**BURGUNDY DANCER**) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of **MISS INTERPRET** which had to be steadied approaching the 100 metres.

Race 7 | **THANK YOU BILL COLGAN – ALL THE VERY BEST (1400 metres)**

RUBYSHOWOFF (M Hashizume) - Slow to begin (5L).

CATHAY EMPRESS (A Goindasamy) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

RABADA (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that after settling further back than intended the gelding had failed to run on once placed under pressure in the straight.

C'EST UNE STAR (L Satherley) - Began awkwardly. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

A BOX OF TRICKS (T Thornton) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running for the majority of the straight.

Race 8

LION RED MAIDEN (1400 metres)

CIMARRON (M Hashizume) – Jumped away awkwardly shifting out hampering **VADAMOS STAR**.

VADAMOS STAR (A Calder) - Hampered at the start losing ground. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

MCFADDEN (C Grylls) - Restrained at the start from its wide barrier.

NO AGENDA NIGEL (T Newman) - Restrained at the start from its wide barrier.

MATAI BAY (J Fawcett) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

SAND CRAB (L Satherley) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

PINION (R Elliot) - Raced greenly when placed under pressure entering the final straight.
