Race 1	ANDREA O'DONNELL PROPERTY BROKERS/MANAWATU SPREADERS 1400			
MISS RAINEY (S	Macnab) - Slow away.			
PRIORESS (W Pinn) - Held up rounding the home turn then unable to obtain clear running throughout the home straight and went to the line without being fully tested.				
Race 2	CHRIS GOMMANS CONTRACTING LTD MAIDEN 1400			
SOUTHERN CROWN (S Macnab) - Dwelt at the start.				

QUATORZE (C O'Beirne) - Slow away.

ALBUFEIRA (F Lazet) - Slow away. Made the final bend awkwardly.

KINGFISHER LAD (C Dell) - Held up rounding the turn.

SAILOR JACK (M Singh) - Hung outwards throughout.

ONCE BITTEN (K Hercock) - Made the final bend awkwardly.

TAVIFERN (C Grylls) - Finished well back. When questioned, rider advised that the gelding had raced greenly throughout.

Race 3 ASH DAIRIES/DAVE WAREHAM MEMORIAL MAIDEN 1400

PINSK (S Macnab) - Slow away.

SCRIPT (A Mudhoo) - Slow away.

BOWLIN BALL (D Turner) - Restrained to the rear from a wide draw.

STORMCAST (C Grylls) - Over-raced early and middle stages and hung outwards throughout the straight.

BIG FRANCK (J Parkes) - Rider reported the gelding would be better suited to a longer distance.

Race 4CARTERS ASHHURST POHANGINA CUP 1400SHADOWS CAST (C Dell) - Began awkwardly, slow away as a result.

GOLD BRACELET (W Pinn) - Held up in the early stages of the home straight and bumped near the 300 metres, gaining clear running when angled inwards approaching the 150 metres.

MORE WONDER (R Elliot) - Lay inwards near the 300 metres and bumped with AOTEA LAD (N Parmar) which in turn bumped with GOLD BRACELET.

AOTEA LAD (N Parmer) - Bumped near the 300 metres. Denied a narrow run approaching the 100 metres having to switch ground inwards to improve. N Parmar was of the opinion the gelding was now better suited to a longer distance

SUMMER PASSAGE (J Kamaruddin) - Lay outwards under pressure throughout the home straight and brushed with MORE WONDER near the finish.

Race 5 THE PAVEMASTERS 1200

TRANSITORY (S Macnab) - Knuckled as the start was made losing all chance and was not persevered with. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a superficial cut to its right hind pastern.

JUSTASKPERCY (K Hercock) - Bumped with HIGHBORN at the start.

ELUSIVE TEN (K Asano) - Began awkwardly.

GAME KNIGHT (R Elliot) - Slow away.

BRADMAN (N Parmar) - Raced ungenerously passing the 800 metres and made the bend awkwardly.

HIGHBORN (J Kamaruddin) - Bumped at start. Lay outwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

Race 6 MURRAY FREE CONTRACTING LTD 1300

KICK START (K Hercock) - Slow away. Crowded 150 metres. Rider reported that KICK START lost both front plates during the running.

MAHOE (D Bradley) - Tightened at the start when runners either side shifted ground.

SUMI (S Macnab) - Tightened at the start when runners either side shifted ground. Finished well back. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

FLYING SURF (F Lazet) - Tightened at the start when runners either side shifted ground.

IFNDOUBTGETOUT (J Mudhoo) - Raced wide throughout.

ZOEY SATIN (A Mudhoo) - Lay in under pressure passing the 150 metres, crowding KICK START.

D Bradley (MAHOE) - Spoken to regarding his use of the whip on a runner out of contention.

Race 7 PRO SLAB/MANAWATU SHEARING 1550

BLUEY'S CHANCE (M Hudson) - Raced wide throughout.

PERFECT SCENARIO (N Parmar) - Raced greenly over the concluding stages.

CHAMPAGNE SUNDAY (L Hemi) - Lay outwards over the concluding stages.

LANGKAWI (S McKay) - Raced keenly towards the end of the back straight. Lay out and away from CHAMPAGNE SUNDAY, bumping with ALHAMBRA LAD near the 100 metres, then continued to lay out over the final stages.

ALHAMBRA LAD (J Kamaruddin) - Bumped near the 100 metres.

HINEPARA (A Goindasamy) - When questioned, rider was of the opinion the mare was unsuited to dropping back from recent races over ground and would be better suited to a longer distance.

Race 8 POWERWORX TARANAKI CUP (G3) 2000

The start was delayed approximately 4 minutes due to **TE AKAU CALIBURN** having to be replated.

BEAUDZ WELL (S Macnab)- Slow away. Held up rounding the home turn.

HURRY CANE (L Hemi) - Restrained from its wide draw.

TE AKAU CALIBURN (N Parmar) - Raced in restricted room passing the 500 meters and was steadied abruptly off the heels of PEP TORQUE. After questioning riders, it was established that PAISLEY PARK lay inwards rounding the home turn dictating PEP TORQUE into the line of TE AKAU CALIBURN which was awkwardly placed on heels.

HE NO OPILIO (D Bradley) - Buffeted for several strides when PAISLEY PARK lay inwards rounding the home turn.

PAISLEY PARK (W Pinn) - Raced wide for the majority and lay inwards rounding the home turn.

OUR HAIL MARY (K Asano) - Trainer reported the mare had been galloped on during the running sustaining minor lacerations.

Race 9 DL TREE SPECIALIST/ROWDEN ELECTRICAL 1550

NEVERSTOPLAUGHING (J Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly settling at the rear. Dictated outwards home turn.

SHEZABELTER (C Dell) - Held up entering the home straight, then angled wide in order to improve and in doing so dictated SHOCKING BILL outwards, hampering AMAZON GODDESS, TUTIN CANS and NEVERSTOPLAUGHING. C Dell was issued with a warning.

AMAZON GODDESS (M Hudson) - Dictated outwards home turn.

TUTIN CANS (C Grylls) - Dictated outwards home turn.

SHOCKING BILL (S Macnab) - Dictated home turn.

RED JAKKAL (D Turner) - Denied a run near the 100 metres and was not persevered with over the final stages.

KING OF HEARTS (L Hemi) - Raced greenly over the final stages and on making the lead ducked inwards abruptly hampering DU'BLUES, which had to check off that runner's heals

DU'BLUES (K Hercock) - Hampered final stages.
