Race 9 - NORTHLAND BUSINESS SYSTEMS (1600 metres)

VERNAZZA (V Colgan) – Trainer L Noble advised Stewards VERNAZZA has now been retired from racing and will be sent to stud.

Race 10 - WHANGAREI LOVE IT HERE MAIDEN (1600 metres)

TIGER FIRE (C Grylls) – Co-trainer A Forsman reported to Stewards the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of the gelding and it is their intention to continue on with his current preparation.

Race 1	CHEERS TAVERN BAYFAIR MAIDEN 1200
<p>KAI (J Kamaruddin) - Jumped away awkwardly making contact with SUGAR DUNE losing ground. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 100 metres.</p> <p>SUGAR DUNE (C Grylls) – Unbalanced when contacted leaving the barriers. Raced three wide without cover. Hampered near the 200 metres when ESPIONAGE shifted in under pressure.</p> <p>ESPIONAGE (O Bosson) - Jumped away awkwardly. Lay in under pressure in the straight.</p> <p>THE CHARGING (S Spratt) - Over-raced when being restrained in the early to middle stages making the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly.</p> <p>HASSTOBEFAST (M McNab) - Made the final bend awkwardly.</p> <p>ABLE WHITE (V Colgan) - Held up for a majority of the straight.</p> <p>POPULAR FAVOUR (L Satherley) – Hampered when weakening near the 200 metres when SYMPHONY OF LOVE shifted out for clear running.</p> <p>SYMPHONY OF LOVE (T Yanagida) - Held up for clear running until shifting out near the 200 metres.</p> <p>O Bosson (ESPIONAGE) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of SUGAR DUNE which was hampered near the 200 metres.</p> <p>T Yanagida (SYMPHONY OF LOVE) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of POPULAR FAVOUR which was hampered near the 200 metres.</p>	
Race 2	VOSPER REALTY PROPERTY SALES MAIDEN 1200
<p>BELLE OF THE BALL (J Kamaruddin) - Jumped away awkwardly making firm contact with CORNWALLIS, losing ground.</p> <p>CORNWALLIS (C Grylls) - Contacted leaving the barrier. Raced three wide without cover throughout. Hung out rounding the final bend and continued to hang out in the straight. Rider C Grylls reported that the colt raced greenly and would derive benefit from today's race.</p> <p>CLASSIC BEETHOVEN (S Weatherley) - Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages after jumping from a wide barrier.</p> <p>SUPER DALE (D Danis) - Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages after jumping from a wide barrier.</p>	
Race 3	EMAC ELECTRICAL MAIDEN 2100
<p>TAVI WITH ME (M McNab) - Slow away.</p> <p>LEVIATHAN (S Spratt) - Jumped away awkwardly. Was retired from the race near the 800 metres after failing to respond to its rider's urgings with rider S Spratt reporting that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which did not reveal any obvious abnormality. LEVIATHAN is now required to barrier trial prior to racing next.</p> <p>TE POROPITI (L Satherley) – Restrained to obtain cover after jumping from the outside barrier.</p> <p>PEARL HART (M Cameron) - Made the first turn awkwardly hampering EKSTRA GHIA.</p>	

EKSTRA GHIA (N Parmar) - Hampered being forced over extra ground rounding the first bend and was then inclined to over-race being allowed to improve forward to the lead near the 1200 metres.

ASTERIX (O Bosson) - Got its head up and raced ungenerously when being steadied approaching the 1400 metres when the pace eased, going back onto SMUG which was hampered.

SMUG (T Thornton) - Hampered approaching the 1400 metres when the pace eased. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 200 metres.

STALLONE (S Weatherley) - When questioned regarding the performance rider S Weatherley could offer no excuse other than possibly feeling the effects of its recent run. Trainer advised that the gelding would now be spelled.

FIREBUG (J Kamaruddin) - Was shown footage of his ride in the presence of the riding master in relation to easing of the pace near the 1400 metres.

Race 4	TRITON PACIFIC MAIDEN 1600
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KEEP IT CASUAL (M Hashizume) - Slow away.

RACONTEUSE (T Yanagida) - Steadied and shifted outwards when becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 200 metres.

JIMMY THUMPER (B Grylls) – Lay out under pressure in the straight.

THE BIG SHOW (C Grylls) – Lay out under pressure in the straight.

GOLDEN KIWI (S Weatherley) - When questioned regarding performance the rider was unable to offer any excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 5	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1600
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ENDEAN AFAIR (S Weatherley) - Slow to begin.

GLORIFIED (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly. Hampered when crowded for a distance passing the 200 metres. Following this race the rider of the 5th placed horse GLORIFIED (C Grylls) viewed Stewards films with a view to a possible protest against the 4th placed horse TIDAL RUSH (R Beemud) before electing not to proceed with a protest.

BELLATRIX BLACK (T Yanagida) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

JABELLA (J Kamaruddin) - Shifted outwards away from TIDAL RUSH when that runner shifted ground approaching the 200 metres resulting in GLORIFIED being hampered and crowded for a distance.

TIDAL RUSH (R Beemud) - Lay out under pressure in the final straight.

R Beemud (TIDAL RUSH) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount TIDAL RUSH six times prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee suspended R Beemud's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 16 February up to and including racing on Thursday 24 February, 5 national riding days.

O Bosson (STERNLAND) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount STERNLAND six times prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee suspended O Bosson's licence to ride in races from

the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 23 February up to and including racing on Thursday 3 March, 5 national riding days.

R Beemud (TIDAL RUSH) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift outwards approaching the 200 metres when not sufficiently clear.

Race 6 | **QUICK COUNT MAIDEN 1400**

SPHINX (T Yanagida) – Slow to begin.

DANCE MONKEY (T Thornton) - Slow to begin.

CIVIL UNREST (S Spratt) – Raced wide without cover throughout. When questioned regarding performance rider S Spratt advised that the gelding would be better suited to a firmer surface. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

TURNMEON (L Satherley) - Had to shift outwards abruptly after improving onto heels passing the 400 metres.

NO MYTH (N Parmar) – Lay out under pressure in the straight.

SUPER CENTIE (M Hashizume) – Lay in under pressure in the straight.

Race 7 | **VOSPER REALTY PROPERTY MANAGEMENT 1400**

THATCHER (T Yanagida) - Blundered leaving the barriers before being further hampered by MARMELLOS which jumped outwards. Made contact with I'M CAPABLE when trying to obtain clear running near the 350 metres.

HIBERNIA SEA (A Goindasamy) – Hampered leaving the barriers, losing ground.

QUICK PREVIEW (S Spratt) - Commenced to over-race shortly after the start continuing to do so through the middle stages.

ROCHMIE RAY (V Colgan) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

LOCK UP (T Thornton) - Held up rounding the final bend until approaching the 200 metres.

I'M CAPABLE (N Parmar) - Contacted and unbalanced near the 350 metres by THATCHER which had attempted to shift out to obtain clear running. T Yanagida was advised to exercise care when shifting out in similar circumstances.

LAVAGLO (S Weatherley) - When questioned regarding performance rider S Weatherley could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which did not reveal any obvious abnormality

CALL ME EVIE (Y Kumagai) - Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 8 | **JUDEA TAVERN MAIDEN 1400**

TUSCAN HOLIDAY (T Yanagida) - Hampered when crowded leaving the barriers losing ground.

ENDEAN MAGIC (D Danis) - Slow away.

STRICTLY DANCING (C Grylls) – Raced wide throughout.

SO GRACEFUL (S Spratt) - Hung out making the final bend.

RAMIREZ (S Weatherley) - Raced very greenly in the final straight and was unable to be fully ridden out.

DIOSA LUNA (M Cameron) – Lay out under pressure in the straight.

SUPER SIX (C Barnes) - When questioned regarding the performance rider C Barnes could offer no excuse.
