RACE COMMENTS

KEN DUNCAN FACING STEEPLECHASE 3800 Race 1 **ZINZAN** (H McNeill) - Began awkwardly, hampering outside runners. **LOCHARBURN** (S Fanin) - Hampered shortly after the start, losing ground. Hit the second last fence, landing awkwardly. **TITTLETATTLE** (E Farr) - Hampered shortly after the start, losing ground. ALFIE DEE (S Karnicnik) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Hit the fence near the 1000 metres. HE'S RIC (D Parker) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Race 2 WANGANUI FUNCTION CENTRE HURDLE 3000 MIZZENA (S Fannin) - Slow to begin. Over-raced for a distance in the back straight on the first occasion. Placed in restricted room, having to shift outwards across near the 1100 metres when AIGNE made the jump awkwardly, with THE ANARCHIST being hampered and steadied. QUAFF (S O'Malley) - Slow to begin. BEAU GESTE (D Parker) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages. AIGNE (E Farr) - Made the jump awkwardly near the 600 metres on the first occasion and as a result IZYMYDAAD was hampered having to be briefly steadied off heels. Jumped indifferently throughout the running and was inclined to run its fences down. Landed awkwardly at the second last fence, dislodging rider E Farr, who was attended to by paramedics and cleared to ride. AIGNE underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality. IZYMYDAAD (S Karnicnik) - Hampered having to be steadied off heels near the 600 metres on the first occasion. THE ANARCHIST (H McNeill) - Hampered having to be steadied off heels near the 1100 metres. Landed awkwardly after jumping the last fence. Race 3 **JOLT COFFEE HOUSE MAIDEN 1360** WOTARIPPER (J Riddell) - Slow away. GINO (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin then taken back behind runners to obtain cover. MAEBHS RAZEEL (K Hercock) - Raced ungenerously for a distance, getting its head up in the early stages. Steadied after improving on to heels approaching the 800 metres. BLACKCOMB (H Schofer) - Held up final bend and bumped with STAYINYALANE when attempting to improve near the 400 metres. **STAYINYALANE** (C Dell) - Lay in under pressure in the final straight. **DARWIN** (L Allpress) - Lay in under pressure in the home straight. **RUSTY LANE** (S O'Malley) - Finished well back. When questioned rider could offer no excuse. **WANGANUI INSURANCE BROKERS 1200** Race 4

HOT SHOCKOLATE (H Schofer) - Slow away, settled at the rear. Held up and unable to gain clear racing room over the concluding stages.

THOMAS AQUINAS (S O'Malley) - Raced in restricted room inside the final 50 metres.

RAINBOW DUNDEE (K Hercock) - Gave ground on entering the home straight, finishing last. When questioned rider advised the gelding was making a respiratory noise on pulling up. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

SHARKY (J Mudhoo) - Trainer advised the saddle had slipped near the 800 metres.

Race 5 CARPET MAINTENANCE & CLEANING MAIDEN 1200

BELCAMINA (J Parkes) - Slow away. Had to steady off the heels of CHA DES (J Riddell) near the 300 metres when attempting to improve. J Riddell was advised to exercise care.

CHA DES (J Riddell) - Shied at the crossing in the back straight.

ISLA GRACE (A Mudhoo) - Over-raced and had to be steadied passing the 1000 metres.

MISS RAINEY (T Taiaroa) - Held up early in the home straight, gaining clear running inside the final 100 metres.

LIKE A RIVER (M Hudson) - Hung outwards and made the final bend awkwardly hampering MADIRAN, which was improving to its outside, resulting in MADIRAN having to steady for some distance. When questioned rider advised the filly had hung rounding the final bend and was unable to ridden out fully in the straight. Connections were advised that a warning has been placed on the racing manners of LIKE A RIVER.

MADIRAN (E Nicholas) - Hampered final bend.

SHEZ MALEFICENT (F Lazet) - Lay in and had to be straightened on several occasion in the home straight.

Race 6 BRIAN FM MAIDEN 1200

INDULGE ME (A Mudhoo) - Crowded at the start when runners either side shifted ground, with the rider becoming unbalanced, losing considerable ground.

RECOMMENDHER (K Hercock) - Began awkwardly shifting inwards, crowding INDULGE ME.

LORD DONOVAN (H Schofer) - Began awkwardly shifting outwards, crowding INDULGE ME.

LEON ROUGE (J Parkes) - Slow to begin.

FLOWER OF WANAKA (F Lazet) - Checked having to be steadied near the 250 metres when SPIRIT OF BEXLEY (M Sanson) shifted outwards when not fully clear.

M Sanson (SPIRIT OF BEXLEY) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted SPIRIT OF BEXLEY to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of FLOWER OF WANAKA which was checked near the 250 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of her license to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Friday, 13 May until the conclusion of racing on Thursday, 19 May, 4 national riding days.

Race 7FLAIR (AMATEUR RIDERS SERIES) MAIDEN 2060

NIGHTFALL (L Kennedy) - Began awkwardly.

ESCALADE (O Dalton) - Began awkwardly.

GRAND PROSPECT (S MacNab) - Began awkwardly.

MAYONAKA (K Singh) - Raced ungenerously in the early stages and when becoming placed in restricted room shifted out across heels near the 1800 metres.

RETURN SERVE (S Malki) - Raced wide without cover through the early and middle stages.

Race 8 RIVERCITY GOLF 2060

OBRIGADO (F Lazet) - Slow away.

KINGFISHER LAD (S O'Malley) - Awkwardly placed on heels shortly after the start having to be steadied.

DR HANK (E Nicholas) - After jumping well from the inside barrier was restrained behind runners to gain cover before improving wide in the back straight.

Race 9PALAMOUNTAINS NUTRITION MAIDEN 1600HARMONIOUS (J Parkes) - Slow away. Held up in the home straight until gaining clear running over the final stages.

THE FINNSTER (H Schofer) - In restricted room near the 350 metres and unable to obtain clear racing room until inside the final 100 metres.

ZEDTAC (L Allpress) - Was not persevered after L Allpress was of the opinion something may be amiss as the mare felt uncomfortable in its action. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 10 PACIFIC DIVE NZ 1600

SWING LOW (M Sanson) - Slow away, settling at the rear.

ALMERAKI (J Mudhoo) - Slow away. Improved onto the heels of the tiring ILLUSION OF PARIS having to shift outwards near the 350 metres.

WINNIE ROSE (L Allpress) - Slow away.

LITTLE WING (T Taiaroa) - Lay out under pressure over the concluding stages.

J Mudhoo (ALMERAKI) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount ALMERAKI 6 times prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a fine of \$250.
