Race 1 WAIRARAPA TIMES AGE MAIDEN 2100

NASSAK DIAMOND (C Grylls) – Co-trainer Mr S Ritchie advised Stewards, NASSAK DIAMOND, returned to the stable with a cough and underwent a veterinary examination on Friday 18 February which included an endoscopic examination, which revealed the filly to have a swollen throat. S Ritchie further advised NASSAK DIAMOND has been on anti-inflammatories and has not partaken in any exercise this week, however, will look to resume the filly with trackwork next week.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 WHANGANUI CHRONICLE 2YO 1200

SOPHMAZE (L Allpress) - Began awkwardly. Steadied away from heels approaching the 600 metres. Lay out under pressure over the concluding stages.

SEQUOIA STAR (L Hemi) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages. Improved on to heels, having to be restrained approaching the 600 metres.

NEIGHOMI CAMPBELL (R Hannam) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.

TAP DANCER (M Hudson) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

VINO BIANCA (A Goindasamy) - Rider reported the filly raced greenly throughout.

Race 2 LA NUOVA DRYCLEANERS MAIDEN 1200

THE WITCH (A Mudhoo) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

HEAVENLY BOUQUET (L Douglas) - Slow to begin. Raced greenly throughout the final straight.

MY TARNZ GIRL (L Hemi) - Slow to begin.

POROTENE DUNDEE (B Grylls) - Made the crossing awkwardly shortly after the start.

LINCOLN VALLEY (J Riddell) - Raced keenly in the early stages. Restrained off the heels of DAISY DAISY (M Hudson) which had shifted in near the 1000 metres. Hung outwards rounding the final bend having to be corrected by its rider.

BUSTER'S HABIT (K Hercock) - Restrained off the heels of DAISY DAISY which had shifted in near the 1000 metres. Commenced to race ungenerously when the pace eased near the 800 metres.

DAISY DAISY (M Hudson) - M Hudson was questioned into her ride and in particular the easing of the pace on leaving the back straight when leading, which resulted in BUSTER'S HABIT and IMA O'CEIRIN having to steady abruptly. M Hudson advised that when being steadied her mount had over-reacted more than she intended. The explanation from M Hudson was accepted by the RIB on this occasion.

SHEZ MALEFICENT (S Macnab) - Improved on to heels when the pace eased near the 800 metres.

BURITZ (A Goindasamy) - Raced in restricted room to the inside of IMA O'CEIRIN passing the 200 metres.

ROCKET SCIENCE (R Hannam) and **DAISY DAISY** (M Hudson) - Raced in restricted room for the majority of the home straight.

M Hudson (DAISY DAISY) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted DAISY DAISY to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of LINCOLN VALLEY and BUSTER'S HABIT, which were tightened near the 1000 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 26 February until the conclusion of racing on 10 March, 6 national riding days.

Race 3 WANGANUI-TARANAKI RACEHORSE OWNERS ASSN 1200

LEBANESE TRADER (M McNab) - Slow to begin.

GRACIE LEE (K Hercock) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages. Improved on to heels having to be steadied passing the 500 metres.

POWER OF THE KITTY (S Macnab) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

ELUSIVE TEN (L Allpress) - Lay out under pressure in the straight.

Race 4 WANGANUI MASTER PAINTERS ASSN MAIDEN 1340

SELLDOM (M Hudson) - Blundered at the start and was then bumped heavily when GREEN MACHINE shifted out abruptly. This resulted in M Hudson becoming unbalanced and SELLDOM settling some distance last.

RUSTY LANE (J Parkes) - Commenced to over-race near the 1100 metres so was angled outwards to avoid heels.

DEADLY PONY (J Kamaruddin) - Disappointed, finishing well back. J Kamaruddin advised the filly raced greenly throughout.

LOLLY POROTENE (B Grylls) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

Race 5 GUTHRIE BOWRON MAIDEN 1600

LEMON TREE LASS (C O'Beirne) - Began very awkwardly losing many lengths. Connections were advised the filly must trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

FRAULEIN (R Hannam) - Rider reported the filly had lost its footing in behind when making the first bend awkwardly.

HANAKIN (C Dell) - Steadied when entering the back straight.

MCCRAW (A Mudhoo) - Raced wide throughout.

CARESS (K Hercock) - Had to be angled outwards abruptly to avoid heels near the end of the back straight.

C O'Beirne (LEMON TREE LASS) - Spoken to regarding the manner in which she used her whip on a runner out of contention.

Race 6 TRIBUTE TO TERESA HUTCHINGS 1600

PINSK (S Macnab) - Slow to begin, then commenced to race ungenerously for a distance.

PODKAST (K Hercock) - Jumped the crossing near the 1100 metres.

PLATINUM ROAD (J Parkes) - Made the crossing awkwardly near the 1100 metres.

A Mudhoo (JUSTASKPERCY) - Spoken to regarding the manner in which he used his whip on a runner out of contention.

Race 7 BGP SALUTES THE GOAT HITTING 50 MAIDEN 2040

ALL IN BLACKBERRY (M Hudson) - Tightened at the start when runners either side shifted ground.

ITS MARGO (H Schofer) - Unbalanced at the start when shifting in.

ROADSTER (K Hercock) - Unbalanced at the start when shifting out.

FERN FLATS (S Macnab) - Had to be steadied near the 200 metres when there was simultaneous movement from ALL IN BLACKBERRY which shifted in and ROADSTER which shifted out.

Race 8 MAD BUTCHER WANGANUI MAIDEN 2040

ESME (L Allpress) - Restrained to the rear from its wide draw.

I'M RONALDO (J Parkes) - Steadied passing the 1800 metres when SNATCH shifted in, then commenced to over-race for a distance.

APACHE ANNE (L Hemi) - Raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages.

ZUMA ROCK (A Mudhoo) - Lay in under pressure in the straight.
