Race 5 PETER KELLY – BAYLEYS REAL ESTATE 1300

VERSTAPPEN (V Colgan) – Co-trainer P Williams advised Stewards the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of the filly, however, puts the disappointing performance down to VERSTAPPEN being unsuited to the Slow 7 track conditions. P Williams further advised it is the stables intention to continue on with the filly's current preparation.

Race 6 DAVID & KARYN ELLIS FILLIES CLASSIC (2000 metres) (G2)

PRINCESS LOWRY (L Satherley) – Co-trainer G Rogerson reported to Stewards PRINCESS LOWRY has been retired from racing.

BELLE EN ROUGE (O Bosson) – Trainer J Richards advised Stewards he was satisfied with the post-race condition of BELLE EN ROUGE and will continue on with the filly's current preparation with BELLE EN ROUGE next race being the Sunline Vase.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 MOUNT SHOP MAIDEN 2100

TRUST IN YOU (L Satherley) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination at the start before being declared a late scratching at 1.32 pm. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to the gelding racing next.

NOIFFSORBUTTS (D Danis) - Improved onto the heels of SWEET VIRGINIA passing the winning post on the first occasion. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to the mare racing next.

LOQUITA (V Colgan) - Made the first bend awkwardly hampering ROCKET LAD. Held up for clear running until passing the 400 metres. Lay out under pressure in the straight.

ROCKET LAD (J Riddell) - Hampered near the first bend. Lay out under pressure in the straight.

VADIABEEL (A Calder) - Forced wider rounding the first bend when hampered by NOIFFSORBUTTS.

SHIMMERING (T Yanagida) - Attempted to improve into a marginal run inside of GEE VEE KAYE passing the 400 metres with GIRLBOSS then shifting outwards dictating SHIMMERING onto GEE VEE KAYE for a distance.

GEE VEE KAYE (T Thornton) - Contacted and unbalanced for a distance passing the 400 metres.

Race 2 DUNSTAN HORSEFEEDS 2100

HAPPY REMARK (D Danis) - Slow to begin.

ASPIRING (T Newman) – Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover from a wide barrier.

LETZ'AV BUBBLES (A Goindasamy) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

FAST WILLIE (K Asano) - Lay in under pressure in the straight.

PEPPERELLO (N Parmar) - Shifted in abruptly approaching the 200 metres. Lay out under pressure over the concluding stages.

SALASSI (S Weatherley) - Forced wider on the track over the concluding stages when PEPPERELLO lay out.

N Parmar (PEPPERELLO) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount PEPPERELLO seven times prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee suspended N Parmar's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 5 March up to and including racing on Sunday 13 March, 5 national riding days.

Race 3 BADGEMAKERS MAIDEN 1200

NO AGENDA NIGEL (N Parmar) - Slow to begin.

FLOSSYROSYCANDY (B Grylls) – Began awkwardly, losing ground. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed on the mare's barrier manners after proving difficult to load.

COURAGEOUS STEP (A Goindasamy) - Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after.

MYLETT (T Thornton) - Restrained at the start from its wide barrier.

LEAR JET (C Burdan) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

SUPER DAISY (T Yanagida) - Improved onto heels having to be steadied passing the 800 metres.

INCHAARJ (M McNab) – Held up until passing the 300 metres.

LONG GAME (M Hashizume) - Held up until passing the 200 metres.

Race 4 FRANKLIN AUCTIONS MAIDEN 1200

SHEZAROCA (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin (5L). Connections were advised that a warning would be placed on the mare's barrier manners.

HARD NOSE (J Kamaruddin) - Began awkwardly. Raced three wide without cover throughout. Lay in under pressure in the straight.

SALENTO (J Riddell) - Held up until passing the 200 metres.

OUR SASSY CAT (S Weatherley) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

A Goindasamy (SHEZAROCA) - Spoken to in regards to his whip use prior to the start.

Race 5 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1400 metres)

GIMMEGOOSEBUMPS (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up for a majority of the straight.

DRAGON'S KISS (M Hashizume) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

VISTOWN (A Calder) - Connections were advised that a warning would be placed on the filly's barrier manners after proving difficult to load.

EXPLOSIVE MISS (S McKay) - Commenced to race ungenerously having to be restrained off heels approaching the 1000 metres when EYESONLYONME shifted in.

HASSTOBEPERFECT (V Colgan) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running for a majority of the straight.

SETTLE PETAL (K Asano) – Raced in restricted room passing the 350 metres to the outside of VISTOWN which shifted out. A Calder was advised to exercise care.

L Innes (EYESONLYONME) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift in when not sufficiently clear of EXPLOSIVE MISS which had to be steadied away from heels near the 1000 metres.

Race 6 MAJESTIC HORSE FLOATS MAIDEN 1400

DAWNTING (J Riddell) - Slow to begin (3L).

URBAN MYTH (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

POKURU TWISTER (L Satherley) - Began awkwardly. Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.

DESTINYS GIRL (B Grylls) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

DASHWOOD (M Hashizume) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

CULLINAN (V Colgan) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

Race 7 HAUNUI FARM 1400

SAINTE ELISABETH (T Yanagida) – Slow to begin.

BURGUNDY DANCER (T Thornton) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Contacted and unbalanced passing the 550 metres.

QUALITY PREVAILS (S McKay) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Inconvenienced passing the 550 metres.

VERSTAPPEN (A Goindasamy) - Shifted out and away from MIDNIGHT MASS passing the 550 metres making contact with BURGUNDY DANCER which was forced outwards, inconveniencing QUALITY PREVAILS with VERSTAPPEN becoming unbalanced. As a result VERSTAPPEN had to be steadied to avoid the heels of MIDNIGHT MASS which shifted outwards passing the 500 metres. L Innes was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

SEMPER FI (N Parmar) – Held up until near the 300 metres.

ROCCIA (V Colgan) - Steadled when placed in restricted room passing the 200 metres to the outside of FOOGAYZEE which shifted out slightly, and inside of SEMPER FI which was forced inwards slightly by SAINTE ELISABETH.

N Parmar (SEMPER FI) - Issued with a warning for raising his arm above shoulder height when using the whip in the final straight.

Race 8 GRANGEWILLIAM STUD "DERRYN" OAKS PRELUDE (1600 metres) (Listed Race)

THATSALLSHEWROTE (T Yanagida) - Slow to begin.

ANOTHER BELLA (J Kamaruddin) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

EVA CHIARA (L Innes) - Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover from a wide barrier. Held up early in the straight when denied clear running room passing the 300 metres when BLOOM shifted out and away from MISS MADISON, which was racing greenly. Rider L Innes reported that the filly felt indifferent in its action over the concluding stages. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

MISS MADISON (A Goindasamy) – Raced greenly when placed under pressure in the straight.

BLOOM (V Colgan) - Commenced to race ungenerously approaching the 1000 metres. Lay out under pressure in the straight.

GREAT PLAINS (T Newman) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

OUTFIT (O Bosson) - Held up for clear running until approaching the 200 metres.

Race 9 COUNTIES HOME LOANS MAIDEN 1600

MASTER ORTEGA (S Weatherley) - Slow to begin.

KIRRACONI (V Colgan) - Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages. When questioned regarding performance, rider V Colgan advised that the gelding had raced greenly throughout and was reluctant to improve between horses.

HALSTON (M McNab) - When questioned regarding performance, rider M McNab advised that in his opinion the gelding held its breath during the running.

DIVINE SAVA (K Asano) - Commenced to over-race in the early stages.

Race 10 FRANKLIN PRIVATE HOSPITAL GALLOP MAIDEN (1600 metres)

APERITIF (B Grylls) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

POLLY POWER (T Newman) - Slow to begin. Held up in the early part of the straight. Rider T Newman reported that the mare had felt indifferent in its action. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

ALTA BELLA (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin. Improved onto heels near the 1100 metres having to be firmly restrained.

JOLENE (L Satherley) - Crowded when weakening passing the 250 metres.

INCY WINCY SPIDER (M Sanson) - Lay in across the heels of MR HYDE having to be steadied near the 400 metres.
