#### GENERAL

**A Balloo** did not attend today's meeting due to suffering an injury in trackwork. A Balloo is now required to provide a medical clearance prior to riding next.

#### SUPPLEMENTARY

##### Southland Racing Club - Saturday 19 February 2022

##### Race 5 - CRUICKSHANK PRYDE HANDICAP (1200m)

**DESERT MAGIC** (S Muniandy) – Trainer Mr T Kennedy advised Stewards he was satisfied with the post-race condition of DESERT MAGIC, and it is his intention to continue on with the gelding's current preparation.

##### Race 6 - WHITE ROBE LODGE HANDICAP (2200m)

**VENETO** (C Barnes) – Trainer Mr P Harris reported to Stewards that VENETO has now been retired from racing.

##### Race 9 - ODT SOUTHERN MILE QUALIFIER – SUMMER CUP (1600m)

**ITS SO EASY** (K Mudhoo) – Trainer Ms C Spittles advised Stewards that on return to the stable ITS SO EASY was seen by the chiropractor and underwent a veterinary examination which included blood tests, with no abnormalities being detected. C Spittles further advised it is her intention to continue on with the mare's current preparation.

#### RACE COMMENTS

##### Race 1 | RICcarton Park Function Centre Maiden 1800m

**POSER** (B Murray) - Slow away. When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no excuse. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

**ALLASERA** (K Chowdhoo) - Slow away. Had to be steadied when improving onto heels near the 1500 metres. Again, had to be steadied off heels near the 1000 metres.

**ACQUITTAL** (W Pinn) - Over raced in the early to middle stages then raced wide without cover from near the 1100 metres.

**IDEAL WARRIOR** (C Campbell) - Raced wide without cover in the early stages before moving forward to lead near the 1100 metres.

**NO RIGMAROLE** (C Johnson) - Raced keenly in the middle stages. Held up approaching the 600 metres having to shift out to obtain clear running passing the 400 metres. Lay out under pressure throughout the final straight making brief contact with THEUNNAMEDFEELING (T Moseley) passing the 350 metres.

**ROYAL KHAN** (B May) - Held up entering the final straight having to shift out across heels to obtain clear running approaching the 250 metres.

**VISTOCK** (K Williams) - Briefly held up early in the final straight. When questioned regarding performance rider advised the mare did not travel well amongst other horses and would look to lead in future races.

**THE UNNAMEDFEELING** (T Moseley) - Contacted passing the 350 metres.

**B May** (ROYAL KHAN) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount ROYAL KHAN 6 times prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a fine of \$250.

**Race 2** | **SPEIGHT'S MAIDEN 1600m**

**HEADS UP** (B Murray) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

**SNITZEL VANCUMB** (C Johnson) - Slow away. Over raced in the middle stages having to be firmly restrained when improving onto heels passing the 1000 metres. Lay in under pressure in the straight.

**BODYGUARD** (J Kamaruddin) - Raced three wide without cover.

**BEALEY INN** (K Mudhoo) - Over raced in the early and middle stages. Hampered near the 400 metres when TAIMATE DIVA (T Comignaghi) shifted outwards to obtain clear running. Contributing was some outward movement from GRANDILOQUENT (K Williams) which lay out rounding the final turn. T Comignaghi was advised to exercise greater care.

**GRANDILOQUENT** (K Williams) - Lay out rounding the final turn.

**PROSERVE** (W Pinn) - Briefly held up entering the final straight.

**TOMYTURBO** (K Chowdhoo) - Lay in under pressure throughout the final straight.

**Race 3** | **KARAKA 2022 7-12 MARCH MAIDEN 1400m**

Trainers **B & R Wilson** (VICTOR ROUGE) - Issued with a warning after presenting VICTOR ROUGE without notified gear (side winkers).

**BENTLEY** (T Comignaghi) - Late scratched at 1.02pm after refusing to load and delaying the start. The connections were advised the gelding must barrier trial prior to racing next.

**ITS ALL OVER ROVER** (T Moseley) - Slow to begin. Hampered 1000 metres. Rider dropped his whip near the 75 metres.

**ON MY SHOULDERS** (B May) - Slow to begin.

**STAN WITH ME** (K Chowdhoo) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start. Hampered 1000 metres. Briefly held up having to shift out to obtain clear running early in the straight.

**VICTOR ROUGE** (R Mudhoo) - Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.

**KOPUTAROA** (K Mudhoo) - Improved into restricted room becoming awkwardly placed and blundering passing the 1000 metres hampering **WHILE YOU'RE THERE** (J Kamaruddin), **ITS ALL OVER ROVER** (T Moseley) and **STAN WITH ME** (K Chowdhoo). Briefly crowded between **STAN WITH ME** (K Chowdhoo) and **SO AMUSED** (W Pinn) which both shifted ground near the 150 metres. Prior to the authorisation of dividends rider K Mudhoo viewed films before electing not to protest.

**WHILE YOU'RE THERE** (J Kamaruddin) – Hampered 1000 metres.

**Race 4** | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1200m**

**MARION MERLE** (C Campbell) - Jumped away awkwardly.

**FAH SAI** (K Chowdhoo) - Jumped away awkwardly.

**TADITA** (C Johnson) - Crowded and checked when **DUBAI LADY** (K Williams) shifted in when not clear, with **TADITA** having to be firmly restrained shifting out making firm contact with **RULZTHENIGHT** (K Mudhoo) which was dictated wider and **TRUTHBETOLD** (J Kamaruddin) being placed in restricted room having to be steadied passing the 1100 metres.

**RULZTHENIGHT** (K Mudhoo) - Contacted and dictated wider passing the 1100 metres.

**TRUTHBETOLD** (J Kamaruddin) – Raced in restricted room having to be steadied passing the 1100 metres. Checked passing the 400 metres.

**AREYOUOKAY** (B May) - Shifted in when not sufficiently clear of **TRUTHBETOLD** (J Kamaruddin) which was checked passing the 400 metres.

**K Williams** (**DUBAI LADY**) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount **DUBAI LADY** to shift inwards after the start when not sufficiently clear of **TADITA** and **TRUTHBETOLD** which were crowded and checked near the 1100 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a fine of K Williams' licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 5 March until the conclusion of racing on 12 March, 4 national riding days.

**B May** (**AREYOUOKAY**) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of **TRUTHBETOLD** which was checked passing the 400 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a fine of B May's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 5 March until the conclusion of racing on 13 March, 5 national riding days.

**Race 5** | **MOORE WALKER DAVEY SEARELLS ACCOUNTANTS 1200m**

**FINAL SAVINGS** (J Laking) - Slow away.

**CLOONEY** (K Mudhoo) - Slow away.

**HE'S READY** (K Chowdhoo) - Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 300 metres.

**SASSY SUSAN** (B Murray) - Became tailed off approaching the 600 metres and was not persevered with in the straight finishing a distant last. Rider B Murray advised that the mare felt indifferent in its action. A post race veterinary inspection revealed the mare to be lame in both front legs. The connections were advised that a veterinary clearance is required prior to racing next.

**O'JESSICA** (C Johnson) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that when placed under pressure the mare had failed to respond.

**Race 6** | **CANTERBURY EQUINE CLINIC 1200m**

**IHU** (K Williams) - Began awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had been making abnormal breathing noises during the running and she would be recommending a change of gear. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

**GELATO** (R Mudhoo) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Held up passing the 500 metres and was unable to obtain clear running until the 350 metres.

**Race 7** | **KEVIN DALY MOWERS 1400m**

**HOLY LOCH** (C Johnson) - Slow to begin.

**LORD DARCI** (J Laking) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

**O'JUDE** (T Comignaghi) – Became awkwardly placed onto heels having to be steadied and shifting out, was then obliged to race three wide without cover approaching the 1000 metres. Forced inwards passing the 100 metres.

**LLOVIZNA** (T Jonker) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

**EL BEE JACK** (K Mudhoo) - Commenced to give ground passing the 200 metres with the saddle having shifted with the rider unable to ride his mount out fully.

**SHE'S RECOMMENDED** (BB Hong) – Shifted in over the final 100 metres forcing O'JUDE (T Comignaghi) inwards causing crowding to SACRED GIANT (W Pinn) and CEDDY SMITH (K Chowdhoo) with both runners being checked over the concluding stages.

**SACRED GIANT** (W Pinn) - Crowded and checked over the concluding stages.

**CEDDY SMITH** (K Chowdhoo) - Crowded and checked over the concluding stages.

Following the running of the race the rider of the third placed horse O'JUDE, Ms T Comignaghi, lodged a protest with the Adjudicator alleging interference in the final 100 metres by the second placed horse SHE'S RECOMMENDED. After considering submissions the Adjudicator upheld the protest with the placings amended to 1<sup>st</sup> THE BUFFER, 2<sup>nd</sup> O'JUDE, 3<sup>rd</sup> SHE'S RECOMMENDED, 4<sup>th</sup> LORD DARCI.

**BB Hong** (SHE'S RECOMMENDED) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount SHE'S RECOMMENDED to shift inwards over the final 100 metres forcing O'JUDE inwards causing crowding to SACRED GIANT and CEDDY SMITH which were both checked over the concluding stages. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of BB Hong's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 25 February until the conclusion of racing on 16 March, 10 national riding days.

**BB Hong** (SHE'S RECOMMENDED) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount SHE'S RECOMMENDED 6 times prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a fine of \$500. After fully reviewing all available films, Stewards were satisfied that BB Hong had not used his whip in consecutive strides.

**Race 8** | **ODT SOUTHERN MILE QUALIFIER 1600m**

**HUNTER VILLAIN** – Late scratched at 2.03 pm due to the unavailability of a rider.

**SITARIST** (T Jonker) - Slow away.

**REDFORD** (B May) - Slow away.

**FRANKIE THE FOX** (R Mudhoo) - Steadied when contacted passing the 1400 metres. Improved onto heels having to be steadied passing the 500 metres.

**PULLYOURSOCKSUP** (C Johnson) - Raced three wide without cover.

**ARE YOU CEREAL** (T Comignaghi) - Held up entering the final straight shifting out across heels to obtain clear running passing the 350 metres.

**VEE TWELVE** (T Moseley) - Held up in the final straight and was unable to obtain clear running until passing the 350 metres.

**EASY ON THE EYE** (B Murray) – Commence to give ground passing the 350 metres and was eased down by its rider. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

**HEE'S OUR SECRET** (BB Hong) - Failed to respond when placed under pressure entering the straight and was not persevered with, dropping out to finish a distant last. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. Following a veterinary inspection HEE'S OUR SECRET was confirmed to have bled. HEE'S OUR SECRET shall not be ridden in exercise for a period of two months or start in any race or trial for a period of three months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Veterinarian. Trainer A Carston advised that HEE'S OUR SECRET will now be retired.

**C Campbell** (ST ANDRE) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount ST ANDRE 6 times prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of C Campbell's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 5 March until the conclusion of racing on 16 March, 6 national riding days.

**K Kwo** (LARPOWER) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount LARPOWER 6 times prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a fine of \$250.

**B May** (REDFORD) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount REDFORD 6 times prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a fine of \$500.

**COLORADO MISS** (BB Hong) - Slow away.

**TOO FERLAXED** (K Chowdhoo) - Slow away. Steadied off heels near the 1500 metres.

**BELINDABELLA** (C Johnson) - Over raced in the early and middle stages.

**FLOAT** (J Kamaruddin) - Raced wide without cover.

**JUST TICKETY BOO** (K Kwo) - Had to be firmly restrained when improving onto the heels of YOUNEVERKNOW (R Mudhoo) near the 1500 metres going back onto TOO FERLAXED (K Chowdhoo).

**FINAL LOT** (T Comignaghi) – Commence to give ground passing the 400 metres and was not persevered finishing a distant last. A post race veterinary inspection revealed lameness in the left hind leg. The connections were advised that a veterinary clearance is required prior to racing again.

**RED RUFUS** (C Campbell) – When questioned regarding the performance rider reported the gelding had hung out during the running and was unable to be fully ridden out. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

**K Chowdhooory** (TOO FERLAXED) - Was charged in that he struck his mount TOO FERLAXED 6 times prior to the 100 metre mark. As K Chowdhooory had left the course the matter was adjourned until Saturday, 5 March at Wingatui.
