Race 7 EL CHEAPO CARS WFA CLASSIC (G1) 1600

MARKUS AURELIUS (L Allpress) – Trainer Mr J Richards reported to Stewards, MARKUS AURELIUS, jarred up and has now been sent for a spell.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 MILTON PARK STABLES 2YO MAIDEN 1200

ZACI (D Turner) - Began awkwardly. Forced wider passing the 700 metres. Shifted in abruptly passing the 200 metres when struck with the whip.

TRAV (S Macnab) - Raced greenly passing the 600 metres. Made the final bend awkwardly.

SHEEZ DOMINANT (M Singh) - Held up rounding the final bend when lugging out.

MISS BONNY ROSE (T Allan) - Over-raced passing the 700 metres making the bend awkwardly and had to be shifted out off heels, inconveniencing ZACI, which was forced wide.

WISDOM WONDER (J Kamaruddin) - Lay in over the concluding stages having to be straightened.

MISS BELLE (L Allpress) - Finished well back. When questioned rider advised the filly raced greenly throughout. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Track upgraded to Good 3 following Race 1.

Race 2 HR JONES & CO LTD 3YO 1200

TRIGGER HAPPY (C O'Beirne) - Slow away. Over-raced passing the 800 metres having to be steadied.

REIGN IT IN (L Allpress) - Slow away. Over-raced in the early stages.

Race 3 BJW MOTORS MAIDEN 1200

PENTARA (R Hannam) - Slow away.

CHARMANDER (J Kamaruddin) - Slow away. Over-raced passing the 800 metres, having to be steadied.

ASAHI (L Allpress) - Over-raced passing the 900 metres having to be steadied.

Race 4 RICHARD SIMPSON CONTRACTING 1550

NOSSENKO (J Kamaruddin) - Began awkwardly, settling at the rear. Raced ungenerously through the middle stages.

POWER 'N' PASSION (K Hercock) - Slow away.

Race 5 BAYLEYS MAIDEN 1400

The start was delayed approximately 11 minutes after the barriers opened prematurely and several runners broke through resulting in **FLEETWOOD BAY** and **SOUND TRACK** being late scratched. Other runners affected were subjected to pre-race veterinary examinations and cleared to start.

FLEETWOOD BAY (C O'Beirne) - Late scratching after dislodging rider C O'Beirne when the barriers opened prematurely and galloping a full circuit of the track.

SOUND TRACK (L Allpress) - Late scratching after dislodging rider L Allpress when the barriers opened prematurely and galloping a full circuit of the track.

ORIGIN (F Lazet) - Slow away. Over-raced through the middle sages.

HEMI RIDAPEST (W Pinn) - Dislodged rider W Pinn behind the barrier and cantered a short distance before being caught; underwent a veterinary examination and was cleared to start. Lay out and away from SAILOR over the final stages making contact with BELLES BIG BOY, which was improving to its outside.

FERMANAGH (S Macnab) - Reared in its gate which initiated the barriers opening resulting in several runners breaking through. Finished last. When questioned, S Macnab advised the filly had held its breath throughout. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

BELLES BIG BOY (D Turner) - Contacted final stages.

SAILOR (J Mudhoo) - Lay outwards over the concluding stages. J Mudhoo was shown footage of his ride in the presence of the Riding Master and reminded that he is expected to straighten his mount sooner than he did on this occasion.

Race 6 H&T CRUCIAL 1400

RONI (D Turner) - Knuckled on jumping away.

BEAN A PLEASURE (R Hannam) - Slow away. Held up over the concluding stages

IRISH ODDS (S Macnab) - Slow away. Lay out under pressure passing the 200 metres bumping with OWEN MOORE.

OWEN MOORE (L Allpress) - Slow away. Bumped 200 metres. Finished towards the rear. When questioned rider advised the gelding had been disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

TOWN BELT (A Mudhoo) - Held up early in the home straight gaining clear racing room inside the final 100 metres.

SAVASILK (J Kamaruddin) - Raced wide throughout.

Race 7 MCVERRY CRAWFORD 2100

THE SEAGULL (D Bradley) - Began awkwardly and settled towards the rear.

MADURO (L Allpress) - Raced wide for the majority of the race.

THE BLIKSEM (A Mudhoo) - Finished well back. A Mudhoo was of the opinion the mare was better suited to more rain-affected footing.

SEE WHATA PRINCESS (W Pinn) - Hung throughout, placing the rider at a disadvantage and could not be ridden out fully in the home straight. When questioned rider confirmed SEE WHATA PRINCESS had hung throughout and he was of the opinion the mare was better suited to more rain-affected footing. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 8 WHISKER FORESTRY LTD MAIDEN 1550

THE RATTLIN' BOG (S Macnab) - Hampered at the start when runners either side shifted ground.

ZACKERY (J Kamaruddin) - Steadied off the heels of LAZY passing the 700 metres.

LAZY (F Lazet) - Hung outwards throughout, losing ground at the 700 metres and placing the rider at a disadvantage. LAZY was not persevered with in the home straight.
