REINE D'AMOUR (W Pinn) – Trainer Ms L Latta advised Stewards, REINE D'AMOUR, has a virus and will now be sent for a freshen up.

Race 7 LITTLE AVONDALE LOWLAND STAKES (G2) 2100

SUPERETTE (L Innes) – Stable representative Mr R Mildon reported to Stewards, the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of SUPERETTE, however, has now been sent for a brief spell.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 | JCE CONSTRUCT MAIDEN 2200

SNATCH (K Asano) - Began awkwardly

BATTLE SECRET (D Turner) - Began awkwardly. Raced ungenerously when being steadied, losing ground, near the 1200 metres.

BLACK EYED SUE (L Douglas) - Struggled to maintain contact with the field throughout. L Douglas advised the mare was resuming from a jumping campaign and is better suited to more rain-affected footing.

EXTRAORDINAIRE (S Macnab) - Ran on only fairly. When questioned rider could offer no excuse. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slow recovery. Connections were advised a veterinary clearance is required prior to EXTRAORDINAIRE racing next.

DETONATE (T Allan) – lost a plate during the running.

L Allpress (ESME) was spoken to regarding easing the pace in the back straight resulting in T Allan (DETONATE) having to take a firm hold of his mount.

K Asano (SNATCH) - Stewards inquired into the manner in which K Asano used his whip in the home straight and could not be conclusively satisfied that he had contravened the rules.

Race 2 | THE TELE OTAKI MAIDEN 1200

OUR BIRDIE (M Singh) - Slow away. Raced wide throughout.

BIONDA (S Macnab) - Slow away.

LADY TELENA (D Bradley) - Held up early in the home straight. D Bradley was spoken to advisedly with regard to taking a marginal gap to the inside of runners near the winning post.

HEADLINE NEWS (L Allpress) - Incurred an injury when being galloped on shortly after the winning post, requiring veterinary attention.

D Bradley (LADY TELENA) - Admitted a charge of using the whip in 3 consecutive strides on his mount inside the final 100 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a fine of \$500.

Race 3 | HARCOURTS OTAKI HANDICAP 1200

PRECISION SHOOTER (L Allpress) - Slow away.

ROCKET SCIENCE (R Hannam) - Proved difficult to load. Connections were advised ROCKET SCIENCE must trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

Assistant Starter K Collins admitted a charge under Rule 340 in that he used a buggy whip excessively on ROCKET SCIENCE when that runner was proving very difficult to load away. K Collins was fined \$300 by the Adjudicator.

Track upgraded to Good 3 following Race 3.

<p>ROAD DIVA (C Burdan) - Tightened at the start when runners either side shifted ground.</p> <p>ZED EM (E Nicholas) - Restrained to the rear from a wide draw.</p> <p>E Nicholas (ZED EM) - Issued with a warning after using the whip in 2 consecutive strides on ZED EM inside the final 100 metre mark with Stewards taking into account her clear recent record.</p> <p>F Lazet (GALWAY BRO) - Issued with a warning after using the whip 6 times prior to 100 metre mark with Stewards taking into account her clear recent record.</p>	
Race 5	VETS ON RIVERBANK MAIDEN 1400
<p>SHEZ MALEFICENT (R Hannam) - Fractious in the barriers prior to the start.</p> <p>SOUND TRACK (L Allpress) - Slow away.</p> <p>DREAM MACHINE (L Douglas) - Jumped out abruptly at the start tightening PAY THE LADS and MASTER CHATTERBOX, which was shifted out into the line of SELLDOM, which was checked and lost ground. Hung throughout placing the rider at a disadvantage.</p> <p>PAY THE LADS (C Burdan) - Tightened at the start. Steadied near the 800 metres when PLATINUM ASSAULT (J Riddell) shifted in when not fully clear. Stewards issued J Riddell with a warning, taking into account outward movement from DREAM MACHINE, which made the corner awkwardly.</p> <p>MASTER CHATTERBOX (E Nicholas) - Tightened at the start.</p> <p>SELLDOM (A Mudhoo) - Checked and lost ground at the start.</p> <p>BURITZ (C O'Beirne) - Hampered at the start when runners either side shifted ground. Lay in under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
Race 6	CAVALLO FARM & CHRIS RUTTEN BLOODSTOCK HANDICAP 1400
<p>FIANO (A Mudhoo) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination at the start and was cleared to run. Ducked in abruptly having to be straightened when struck with the whip passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>QUAFF (L Douglas) - Struggled to maintain contact with the field throughout. L Douglas advised the gelding was resuming from a jumping campaign and is better suited to more rain-affected footing.</p> <p>J Mudhoo (HORLISTIC) - Issued with a warning after using the whip 6 times prior to 100 metre mark with Stewards taking into account his clear recent record.</p>	
Race 7	SPEEDY SIGNS KAPITI MAIDEN 1600
<p>MADAM SASS (L Douglas) - Began awkwardly, settling at the rear.</p> <p>RUSTY LANE (J Parkes) - Over-raced through the middle stages.</p> <p>LIVINONTHEDGE (A Mudhoo) - Placed in restricted room passing the 800 metres, having to be steadied. Lay in under pressure over the concluding stages.</p> <p>BELLA NOCHE (J Mudhoo) - Hung inwards passing the 800 metres placing LIVINONTHEDGE in restricted room. Lay in under pressure over the concluding stages.</p>	

SENZA LINGUA (R Elliot) - Finished well back. When questioned rider could offer no excuse.

TITLED (L Allpress) - Lost the near front plate during the running.
